



Rattlers Spring 2019 Tryout Questionnaire

Character. Commitment. Family

Are players required to attend both tryouts on November 4th and 11th?

Players are highly encouraged to participate in both tryouts.

When will we know what team my son is on?

You will be contacted by Tuesday November 20th at the latest regarding the outcome of the tryout. Based on numbers your son may be placed on a team that does not have a complete roster yet. That roster will be filled up based on our final assessment in February. Players trying out for select teams may be asked to attend the makeup tryout in February in addition to the tryouts in November.

Will all players that come to try-outs be placed on a team?

All players who work hard and have a good attitude will make a team. Based on the number of participants we may not be able to know exactly which team until after our final assessment on February 10th. Once we get the appropriate number of players to fill a team we will notify all the players.

What gear do I need?

Full gear including: stick, helmet, gloves, elbow pads, shoulder pads, cleats, mouth guard, cup.

Will there be makeup tryouts?

Makeup Tryouts will be on February 10 @ Caroll Butts. Registration for makeup tryouts will open until December 1st, and registration payment will be due with your tryout registration.

How do we register for tryouts?

If you have not yet registered please do so at rmrattlerslax.com/events. Walk up players must register online to be placed on a team. By doing this you will be sure to get all club correspondence about team placement and other important announcements.

How much does the spring season cost and when is payment due?

Spring dues will be due one week after you receive a team invitation email. Payments that are not received on time will result in a late fee, and your player may be moved to a different team/lose their spot.

Player Registration: \$275.

Select Team Registration: \$375

The cost for a uniform is \$100 (in addition to spring dues). All players who do not have a Rattlers Custom New Balance Uniform (released Fall 2017) must purchase one.

Why are Select teams more expensive?

The extra \$100 per player covers tournament fees for an additional spring tournament, preference to indoor time, video/film analysis, etc.

When and where will practices be held?

The Rattlers are a recognized youth sports organization in the City of Broomfield. The City of Broomfield will be providing fields for the Rattlers. Locations have not yet been determined, but will be in the local Broomfield area. We will be practicing 3 days a week for 1 ½ hours per practice starting in March.

When/where are games?

Teams are guaranteed 8 regular season games, half of which, will be home games in Broomfield. The majority of games will be on Saturdays, with a few games being on Sundays. The CYLA tournament (guaranteed two games), will be the first weekend in June.

What is US Lacrosse?

US Lacrosse is the national governing body of men's and women's lacrosse. **All players must be current with their US Lacrosse Membership.** All lacrosse players and coaches are insured by US lacrosse while participating in a Covered Activity.
