- 3. Quiz question about the 5 essentials that will be based in a scenario

## Section 3 – How to prepare a space for baby chicks

This section will detail all the things a baby chick owner needs to properly prepare a space for their new chicks.

- 1. Provide a shopping list for download of all the things needed for the chick brooder
- 2. Use an interactive clickable photo of a brooder that the learner can click through to see all the things needed for the brooder and any specifics that they need.

## Section 4 - Daily Care

This section will describe the daily care needed to keep chicks happy and healthy. It will be a scenario-based section, the learner will walk through the daily steps of taking care of their chicks, doing little activities and quiz questions along the way.

- 2. Daily care
- 3. Outdoor field trips!

# **Section 5 – Troubleshooting Issues**

This section will use the flip cards to showcase some of the issues that baby chick owners can face.
