

Rich Content Editor



How can I embed media into Canvas?

- HTML editor
 - Not everything can be embedded through the rich content editor and if that is the case you can use the HTML editor but it does increase the difficulty.



 - Copy the URL (fast and easy)

It opens right in the browser without any clicks so if you don't want to add click for the end user you could export your PPT to Google slides and then embed the Google product.








