From our President

2018 was a year of transformation for LifeSpire of Virginia. Construction at The Culpeper and Lakewood continued. Renovations were ongoing at The Chesapeake, and The Glebe broke ground on a new memory neighborhood, called The Chaplick Center.

In late 2018, the State of Virginia approved “Lakewood at Home,” a membership-based program that allows healthy, active adults living at home to age in place. Affiliated with Lakewood, Lakewood at Home is the first continuing care at home program in the Richmond area.

In 2018, we also launched the 30/40 program for Certified Nursing Assistants at The Glebe. CNAs in The Glebe’s skilled nursing area work six hours and get paid for eight. As a result of this program, the clinical outcomes for our residents have improved dramatically.

The VBH Foundation continues to provide traditional benevolence for residents and strengthen programs for our staff, such as our employee education fund and employee crisis fund.

Financially, we again finished 2018 “in the black,” allowing us to look for more ways we can give back to residents and staff.

Again, thank you for your patience in 2018 as the process of transforming our communities continued. We continue to look forward to a future filled with promise and hope.

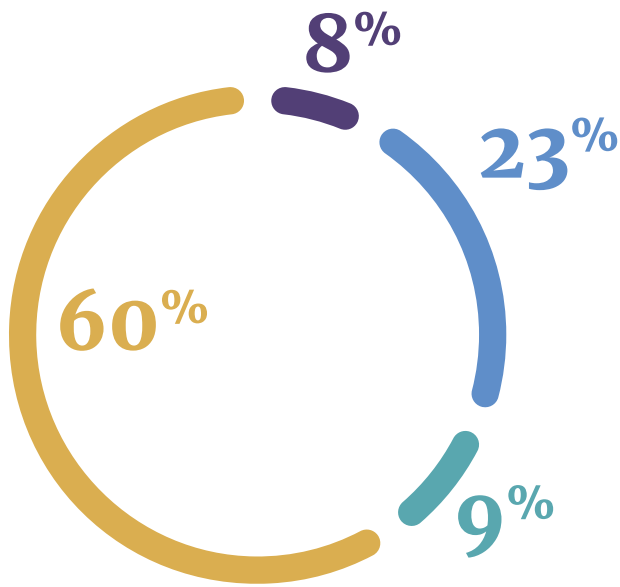

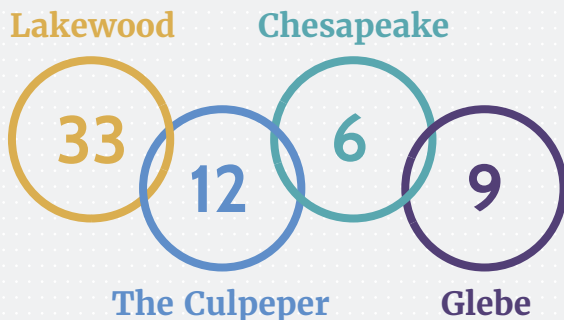

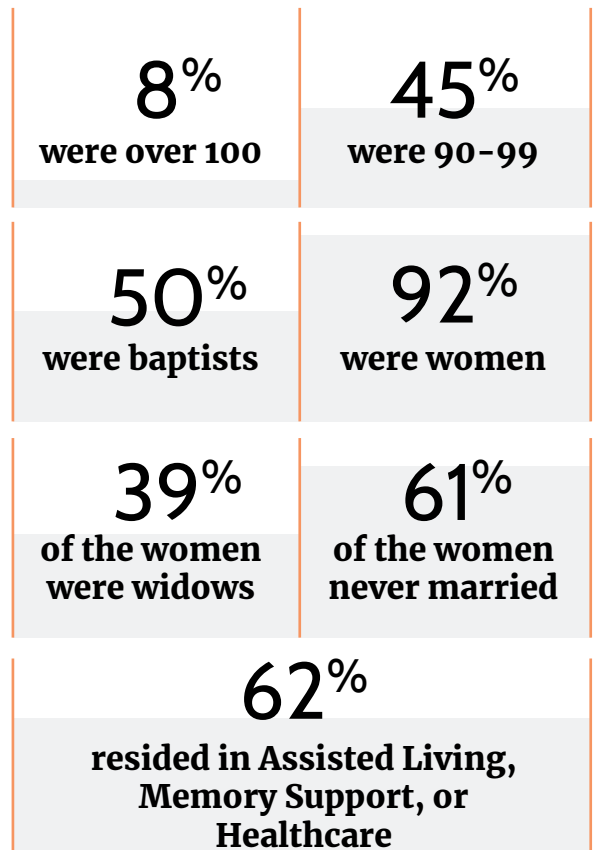

LifeSpire Employee Crisis Fund

LifeSpire understands that employees are sometimes faced with an unexpected crisis that can result in an immediate financial need.

Natural disasters like house fires or floods, life threatening illnesses or injuries, or any unforeseen catastrophic occurrence can cause financial hardship. The Employee Crisis Fund is intended to assist full time employees who are facing one of these circumstances. It can provide immediate assistance to help the employee cope with the financial aspects of the crisis situation.

During 2018, the VBH Foundation awarded \$9,500 in financial assistance to staff in crisis.

LifeSpire Employee Education Fund

LifeSpire's mantra of "Faith. Wellness. Community." represents an unwavering commitment to residents' well-being and health, contentment, independence, and safety. The same principles apply to LifeSpire employees through the Employee Education Fund. The Fund provides financial assistance for higher education and updated training or certification for specialized skillsets. Tuition reimbursement toward a degree or certification is awarded to staff and college scholarships are awarded to staff or their children or grandchildren.

During 2018, the VBH Foundation awarded \$14,000 in education fund support to 13 individuals.



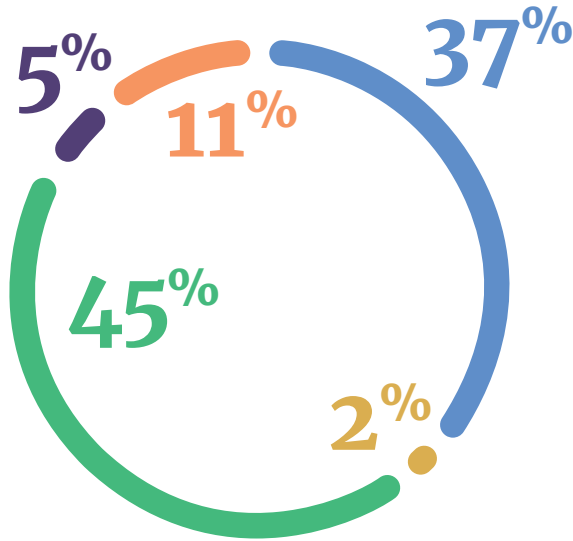
Overcoming a Difficult Beginning

Social Accountability

Social accountability is the extent to which a non-profit organization responds to the needs of the community surrounding it. In 2018, LifeSpire communities provided more than \$140,000 in financial support or fees waived to a variety of charitable causes and public interests. Staff provided approximately 3,500 hours, and residents donated nearly 4,000 hours to community outreach initiatives.



The Culpeper donated 405 staff hours, 1,421 resident hours, and \$10,269 to charitable causes and public interests in 2018, doubling the amount of support they provided in 2017.



The Chesapeake donated 650 staff hours, 440 resident hours, and \$20,760 to charitable causes and public interests in 2018, up from 495 staff hours, 430 resident hours, and \$14,225 in 2017.

LifeSpire's home office and the VBH Foundation gave 376 staff hours and \$22,405 to various causes. Notably, the home office and Foundation staff gave one day to serve at the Central Virginia Foodbank. Members of the home office team also provided mentoring and transportation to ReEstablish Richmond, an organization that helps refugees in the Richmond area establish roots, build community, and become self-sufficient.

The Glebe donated 1,808 staff hours, 406 resident hours and \$55,765 to causes and public interests in 2018, up from 1,500 staff hours, 303 resident hours and \$49,064 in 2017.



Lakewood donated 302 staff hours, 1,730 resident hours, and \$31,788 to social accountability projects.

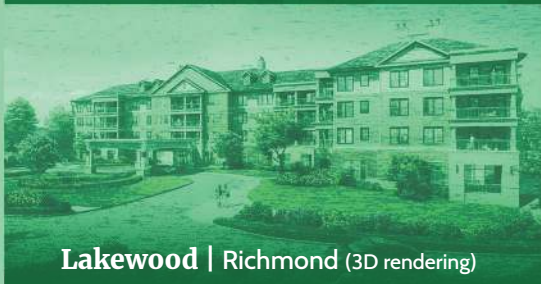
