CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. Entries close Friday, 6th September 2024 and must be lodged at the Bribie Island Golf Club Ltd. by 5pm on that date. Entry Fees must accompany Entry Form.
2. The Rules of Golf adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club, and local rules of the Bribie Island Golf Club shall be the Rules of Play for this event. Local Rules are on the back of the card as well as on the board outside the Pro Shop.
3. The 4BBB Stableford Event is a day event and presentations for this will be held after completion of play.
4. Bribie Island Golf Club **Red** Course Slope Rating is 124.
5. There will be **no** handicap limit for 4BBB Stableford event.
6. Rule 5.6 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position in the field. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered out of position; penalties may be issued to the individual/s in the group who, by their pace, are deemed to be contributing to the delay.
7. The players must report to the Starter at least **20 minutes** before the appointed start time. A player in breach of this condition may be disqualified.
8. Dress regulations apply. Soft spikes only.
9. Distance (only) Measuring Devices may be used – players are advised NOT to use applications that also provide, inter alia, temperatures, wind speed, forecasts etc. Use of such applications will entail disqualification under Rule 4.3.
10. Mobile phones taken onto the course MUST be placed in Silent Mode and may be used as a distance measuring device or with use of the MiScore App. Disqualification under rule 4.3 may be applied.
11. Motorised buggies are permitted, and carts **must** be booked through the Pro Shop 3408 1457
12. **NO** refunds will be given after the closing date.
13. Draw will be available in Calendar of Events on www.scbdwg.com.au & www.bribiegolf.com.au.
14. The Match Committee reserves the right to alter or vary the conditions of play should they deem it necessary. Please check the Local Rules notice board before play.
15. In the event of a tie in any competition, the recognised Golf Australia count back system will apply.
16. Any dispute or protest must be lodged, in writing, with the Match Committee no later than 15 minutes after the end of the player's round on the day. The decision of the Match Committee will be final.
