

## CONDITIONS OF PLAY



### WOOD DUCK CHALLENGE - NETT MEDLEY STROKE EVENT

**ELIGIBILITY TO PLAY:** The Wood Duck challenge is open to all male and female golfers with a GolfLink number and GA (or equivalent overseas) registered handicap.

**WHEN:** Generally played the last Friday of each month.

**FORMAT:** Handicap stroke event with maximum men's handicap of 36 and maximum women's handicap of 45.

**PRIZES: Overall Winner** Best Net Score: \$150 for the best net score on the day.

Best men's net score and best woman's net score (excluding overall winner) \$75 each (conditional on a minimum of 10 players of the same gender playing on the day). If less than 10 of either gender playing, \$75 will be awarded to the outright runner-up only.)

Ball run down for 20% of total number of players on the day excluding the winners.

Any player who breaks their handicap will receive \$50 (excluding the 2or3 winners).

**YEARLY PLAY-OFF.** Each monthly men's and woman's winner will be eligible to play in the finals in November. The winner of both the men's and women's finals will be eligible to play in every Wood Duck Challenge for the following year free of charge.

**TIME SHEET:** The time sheet (Bribie island GC web site or bookings through the Golf Shop) is open 21 days prior to the event for both members and visitors.

**RULES:** The current rules of golf adopted by the R & A, USGA, the local Rules and Temporary Local Rules (TLR) of the Bribie Island Golf Club will be enforced.

**PLAY:** Men will play from the Black Tee markers and the Women will play from the Pink Tee markers.

Players must report to the starter 20 minutes prior to registered tee time.

**MOTORISED CARTS:** Motorised carts may be used provided they use cart paths and remain outside the blue lines in front of greens and 10 metres from greens and bunkers.

**MISCORE APP:** The MiScore app can be used.

**TIES:** In the event of a tie, the count back system will be used.

**DISPUTES AND PROTESTS:** Disputes and protests are to be in writing and lodged with the Match Committee not later than 15 minutes after the completion of the round. The Match Committee decision is final.
