CONDITIONS OF PLAY

This event will be conducted under the R&A/USGA Rules of Golf and the Bribie Island GC Local Rules.

QUALIFICATIONS:

All golfers must hold a current Golf Australia Handicap or equivalent international status.

To qualify for senior events, players must be 55 years of age or older on the day of the event and must advise the starter when registering that they are eligible for the senior event.

To qualify for junior events, players must be 17 years of age or younger on the day of the event and must advise the starter when registering that they are eligible for the junior event.

REGISTRATION:

CALL THE GOLF SHOP ON 3408 1457 ext 1 TO REGISTER. Entry fee of \$25 paid on the day. Players must register with the Golf Shop at least 20 minutes prior to tee time.

CONTROL:

The Match Committee shall control all Competitions and reserve the right to make any changes deemed necessary. Any protest must be lodged with the Match Committee within 15 minutes of the completion of a round. In the event of a dispute the Tournament Director/Match Committee's decision will be final.

HANDICAPS:

Maximum Daily handicap of 36 will apply.

LOCAL RULES:

Local rules appear on the back of score cards and should be read in conjunction with Local Rules board outside the Golf Shop.

COMPETITION SCHEDULE:

The event is a stroke event with a shotgun start at 09:15 am

TIES:

In the case of ties for the OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP, SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIP AND JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP, there will be a sudden death play-off on the 18th hole. This will be repeated subject to sufficient light until we have a winner. If no result is determined in the play-off, the ties will be named joint winners.

In the case of ties, all other event divisions will be determined by the standard count back system.
