

# Headdresses of Ancient Egypt

Masks and headdresses were worn in Ancient Egypt by different members of the Royal Court. Read the descriptions to label the illustrations below.

The **Nemes Headdress** was worn by pharaohs and was made of gold and blue striped cloth.

The **Crown of the Royal Woman** was worn by Egyptian queens and was shaped to look like a vulture.

The **Mask of Anubis** was worn by priests during funeral services and looked like the head of a jackal.

The **Blue Crown** was worn by male rulers and included gold patterns and designs.
