

SCIENCE DON'T CROSS THE WIRES

Circuit boards are plates with trails of metal that conduct electricity in electronic devices. A short circuit is a problem that happens when two wires accidentally cross, which can cause a spark or even a fire. Electrical engineers prevent short circuits from happening by wrapping wires in non-conductive insulation that keeps the wires protected even if they accidentally touch.
