



Spin the Dreidel

The dreidel has four symbols, and each one means something different. When you spin the dreidel, the symbol it lands on tells you how many prizes you win. You can play for all kinds of prizes, but the most traditional prizes are chocolate coins. One day, Sam and Sofia put 10 chocolate coins up for grabs and took turns spinning the dreidel. The dreidel symbols told them how many coins they won.

Using the symbol key below, figure out how many of the 10 coins Sam and Sofia each won.
