

Ladybugs are beetles. In Europe and some parts of the USA, they're called ladybirds. Farmers and gardeners love ladybugs because they eat aphids, which are pesky insects that destroy plants and crops. Ladybugs are best known for their black spots. They can have as many as 24!

MATERIALS 2 paper plates 2 black pipe cleaners string or yarn scissors hole puncher black construction paper red and black paint glue

INSTRUCTIONS

- Paint one plate black. Paint the other red with black spots.

Cut the red plate in half

to make the ladybug's

Cut a small circle from the black construction paper. Glue the pipe cleaners on to make antennae.



- Punch holes in the tops of the red plates.
- Punch another hole into the body of your ladybug to attach the wings using string.

Glue your ladybug head

onto the black plate.
