



Scarab Search



In ancient Egypt, scarab beetle designs were often used on jewelry, good luck charms and even stamped on official documents. The scarab was a symbol of protection and good fortune. Ancient Egyptians believed that a figure named Khepera (who was half human and half scarab beetle) moved the Sun across the sky. For this reason, the scarab in Egyptian art is sometimes shown holding an orange ball.
