

DON'T CROSS THE WIRES

A short circuit happens when two wires in an electric circuit accidentally cross. It can cause a spark or even a fire. Electrical engineers prevent short circuits from happening by wrapping wires in non-conductive insulation that keeps the wires protected even if they accidentally touch.
