



















Let's Draw Sam & Sofia's Scooter

Fun Fact: There is a secret compartment under the scooter's seat where Sofia and Sam store souvenirs and supplies.

<p>1</p>  <p>Start with two half circles. Tilt the one on the left just a tad.</p>	<p>2</p>  <p>Add two more half circles that are slightly smaller.</p>	<p>3</p>  <p>Draw a small oval over the left wheel and a wonky rectangle shape above the right wheel.</p>
<p>4</p>  <p>Draw curvy lines attached to the seat like so. This will form the back end of the scooter.</p>	<p>5</p>  <p>Add a straight line connecting the two wheels. Then, draw two arched lines connecting the oval shape to the rest of the scooter.</p>	<p>6</p>  <p>Add a handle, a headlight, and some fun details on the wheels.</p>
<p>7</p>  <p>Add a small rectangle to create the navigation screen.</p>	<p>8</p>  <p>All done! Whiz... Zoom... FOOP!</p>	 <p>Add some color if you'd like!</p>









Let's Draw a Sloth!

Fun Fact: The maned sloth is a three-toed sloth that can only be found in Brazil.

<p>1</p>  <p>Start with a long branch for the sloth to hang from.</p>	<p>2</p>  <p>Lightly draw one large circle and one small circle below the branch.</p>	<p>3</p>  <p>Add two curved lines connecting the circles to the branch.</p>
<p>4</p>  <p>Draw a curved V-shape to create the sloth's arm and leg.</p>	<p>5</p>  <p>Add in the other arm and leg. Then, draw a slightly curved line to connect the head and body.</p>	<p>6</p>  <p>Draw two eyes, a nose, and a peaceful grin. Don't forget the claws!</p>
<p>7</p>  <p>Add some fur and a few leaves.</p>	<p>8</p>  <p>Trace over the lines you want to keep.</p>	 <p>Color it in if you'd like!</p>









Let's Draw a Crocodile!

Fun Fact: The Everglades is the only place in the world with both alligators and crocodiles.

<p>1</p>  <p>Lightly draw a large oval. Then, add an upside-down V-shape that will be the tip of the tail.</p>	<p>2</p>  <p>Draw curved lines to form the neck and snout of the crocodile.</p>	<p>3</p>  <p>Add a wavy V-shape to form the mouth, and two half circles for eyes.</p>
<p>4</p>  <p>Draw two long, curved lines to create the tail. Then add the arms and legs.</p>	<p>5</p>  <p>Give the crocodile some feet by drawing star-like shapes.</p>	<p>6</p>  <p>Add an eye, a tongue, and sharp teeth.</p>
<p>7</p>  <p>Trace over your lines. Add some bumps for more detail!</p>	<p>Add some color if you'd like!</p> 	









Let's Draw a Kangaroo!

Fun Fact: The red kangaroo can travel 25 feet in one leap!

<p>1</p>  <p>Lightly draw four circles. They will form the shape of the head and body.</p>	<p>2</p>  <p>Connect the circles with four curved lines.</p>	<p>3</p>  <p>Add two ovals for paws, and two hot-dog shapes for feet.</p>
<p>4</p>  <p>Add curvy lines to form the arms and legs.</p>	<p>5</p>  <p>Add pointy ears and a long swooping tail.</p>	<p>Color it in if you'd like!</p> 
<p>6</p>  <p>Add an eye and nose.</p>	<p>7</p>  <p>Trace over your light lines. Try adding zigzag lines for a furry look.</p>	

Let's Draw a Volcanic Eruption!

Fun Fact: Most of the volcanoes found on earth today are in the Ring of Fire, a horseshoe-shaped area in the Pacific Ocean.

<p>1</p>  <p>Start with a small, imperfect oval shape for the mouth of the volcano.</p>	<p>2</p>  <p>Add two diagonal lines to form the cone shape of the volcano.</p>	<p>3</p>  <p>Connect the two diagonal lines and add two arched lines coming out of the top.</p>
<p>4</p>  <p>Add a squiggly line near the top of the volcano to show lava oozing out.</p>	<p>5</p>  <p>Draw a puffy cloud of smoke. Then add two lines to the lava's sides to give it dimension.</p>	<p>Add some color to really make it pop!</p> 
<p>6</p>  <p>Add some lava splashes, more puffy clouds, and details to the base of the volcano.</p>	<p>7</p>  <p>Trace over your lines.</p>
