

Architecture Experiment Tips

Read below for extra tips to help you complete your science experiments.



Build a House

- Keep small parts out of reach of young children.
- Punch the individual pieces out of their frames as you complete the steps, so you don't lose track of the letter labels.
- Pay attention to the letter placement on the pieces to help you fit the pieces together.
- If pieces are tricky to fit together, ask an adult for help.
- Apply the glue as a thin strip. A little goes a long way!



Draw a Floor Plan

- Try to draw your floor plan to scale. If your scale is 2 feet=4 graph boxes, and you'd like to make a wall 10 feet wide, draw a line 20 graph boxes long.
- Use scrap paper to plan out where your rooms will go before drawing on the graph paper.
