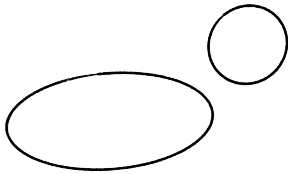


Let's Draw a Weddell Seal!

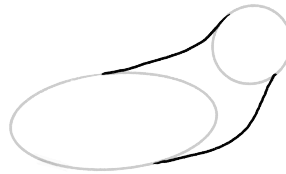
Fun Fact: Grown Weddell seals can swim as deep as 2,000 feet.

1



Start with a long oval in the middle of your page. Then, add a smaller circle to the right, above the oval.

2



Connect the head to the body with two curved lines.

3



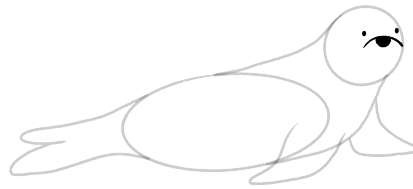
Add a sideways "M" shape to create the seal's tail.

4



Draw two curvy "V" shapes to form the seal's flippers.

5



Add two eyes and a snout.

6



Draw a mouth and whiskers. Add lines around the head and tail for a wrinkly look.

7



Trace over the lines you want to keep. Very cute!

Color it in and add some spots!
