


Let's Draw a Weddell Seal! 🗧



Fun Fact: Grown Weddell seals can swim as deep as 2,000 feet.





Start with a long oval in the middle of your page. Then, add a smaller circle to the right, above the oval.





Connect the head to the body with two curved lines.





Add a sideways "M" shape to create the seal's tail.





Draw two curvy "V" shapes to form the seal's flippers.





Add two eyes and a snout.





Draw a mouth and whiskers.

Add lines around the head and tail for a wrinkly look.





Trace over the lines you want to keep. Very cute!
