










Let's Draw a Sphinx!

Fun Fact: Remnants of vivid-colored paint have been found on the Sphinx's face and body.

<p>1</p>  <p>Start with a large "U" shape for the face. Then add three half circles toward the bottom of your page.</p>	<p>2</p>  <p>Draw four lines connected to the face like so. Add three bumpy lines to form the shape of the paws.</p>	<p>3</p>  <p>Connect the lines to create the headdress. Add a few details and two ears.</p>
<p>4</p>  <p>Draw five lines to form the arms.</p>	<p>5</p>  <p>Draw a long curved line to form the back end. Connect the bottom of the arms and add details to the paws.</p>	<p>6</p>  <p>Draw a long tail overlapping the body.</p>
<p>7</p>  <p>Add a face and detail lines to the headdress.</p>	<p>8</p>  <p>Trace over the lines you want to keep. Great work!</p>	 <p>↑ Add some color if you'd like!</p>
