The Zulu people in South Africa have traditionally made artistic baskets woven from ilala palm fronds. Some of these baskets are woven so tightly, they can hold water. The beautiful patterns are woven so tightly, they can hold water. The beautiful patterns we see today were introduced over time as weavers began to dye palm fronds.
