TIME	ACTIVITY	DESCRIPTION
8:45-9:00	SET UP CAMP	Open the package for the day, lay out the pieces, and review the schedule. Place the suitcase, map, and passport stickers where they go. (Day 1 only has suitcase stickers.)
9:00-9:15	MORNING MAIL	Read the letter from pen pals Sam & Sofia.
9:15-10:00	SOUVENIR SOCIAL	Unpack the souvenir and play.
10:00-10:15	CAMP SNACK SHACK	Time for a healthy snack!
10:15-10:45	INDOOR EXPLORE & COIN COLLECTION	Complete the pencil-to-paper activities in the activity sheet. Open the coin package, read the card, and add the coin to your board.
10:45-11:00	BODY BREAK	Move your body: stretch, dance, or run around.
11:00-11:30	PRINT & PLAY	Go online to explore the country pages. Print and complete the activities there. Print and color in the country flag to add to your flag garland.
11:30-12:00	LUNCH	Head on over to the Mess Hall (your kitchen) and eat some lunch.
12:00-12:20	CAMP BOOK CLUB	Read <i>A Recipe for Adventure</i> and share questions with the camp counselor (grown-up). Don't worry if you only finish a few pages. You can read more tomorrow.
12:20-12:30	CLEAN UP CAMP	Clean up materials. Check in with your camp counselor.
12:30-1:15	BUNK TIME	Time for an afternoon rest in your bunk.
1:15-1:45	AFTERNOON HIKE	Go on a walk with your camp counselor and see the sights of the campground (your backyard, neighborhood, local park). If you were a tourist in your own town, what details would you notice?
1:45-2:00	DRAW IT OUT	Print today's How-to-Draw lesson and follow the steps to make your own art. Add the stickers if you'd like!
2:00-2:30	MAKE BELIEVE ADVENTURE	Be inspired by Sam & Sofia's adventures and create a make-believe adventure of your own!
