



Buoyancy describes an object's ability to float or rise when submerged in a liquid. If the object floats, it's considered buoyant. If the object sinks, it is not buoyant. Fill a large bowl or bucket with water, collect water-safe items from around your home and experiment to see which items float and which items sink. Use the chart below to record the results.
