How to shoot your own video using your smartphone.

Shooting high-quality videos with your smartphone has never been easier. Let's see how!

Follow these tips before you start filming:

- Check the battery life on your phone.
- Check that you have enough storage available.
- Switch to flight mode when recording so that you are not interrupted with a phone call or notification during your shoot.
- Make sure your camera lens is clean.

Open your camera app and select the **"video"** option.

Specify the **recording settings** for the front camera.

- We recommend shooting in 4K, but FHD 1920x1080 (30 fps) works great as well.
- If you are not using a tripod or mount and your phone has a stabilising function, activate the stabiliser for smoother footage.

STEP 3 Lock down your **camera settings** by tapping or holding your screen.

- A yellow box will appear, confirming that the Auto Focus/AF and Auto Exposure/AE are locked at that point. Not all smartphones have this ability, so make sure your objects are in focus.
- Some smartphones offer a Pro video mode, which gives you more control over a variety of features, including the white balance, focus, shutter speed and ISO.



Turn your phone to the horizontal position (landscape) and **press the record button** to start filming.

And that's it!

Now you're all set up and ready to start shooting.
