

2020-2021 ACES Program Information

Welcome to the new season! We are coming off of a successful summer, and we want to build on that and grow. All of the below practices, skills and tournaments are offered as part of our core package. If COVID-19 restrictions are imposed, Aces will work to maintain this schedule, or programming similar to it. All athletes will pay \$270 at the time of registration. This will cover the apparel package, and is separate and apart from tuition. Tuition will be broken out into a payment plan for all athletes given the uncertainty of COVID-19. PAYMENT OF TUITION: 50% of tuition will be due by October 1, 2020. 25% of tuition will be due by February 1, 2021. 25% of tuition will be due by June 1, 2021. This will allow for any potential price adjustments due to COVID 19 restrictions; however, core programming tuition will not exceed the below figures. Tournaments are subject to change, change dates, or change locations.

APPAREL PACKAGE

With the growth of Aces Lacrosse and its partnership with 3Step Sports, the opportunity for bigger and broader partnerships are already presenting themselves. One example is the lacrosse divisions move to work with New Balance. Aces will be representing New Balance on the field with uniforms and base layer gear. As you may have already seen, we're not going to be short on opportunities for gear. Aces is always on the lookout for the latest and greatest for the players on the field and anyone cheering on the sideline. Aces will have multiple stores annually and lots of pop-up opportunities. This mandatory apparel package is \$270 and is paid at registration.

Commitment Expectations:

Fall and winter schedules are structured to allow (and encourage) other sports taking priority. We schedule events and training so players have more flexibility to come to what fits your schedule. The spring and summer seasons are our primary season and the team practices and events are considered mandatory at the high school level to allow teams to develop and

promote players for recruiting purposes. We do understand that conflicts may come up, but please accept this invitation with the understanding that a full spring and summer commitment is expected (mid-June through mid/late-July).
