





- D1 = End of Sophomore Year into the beginning of Junior Fall
- D2 = Junior Year into Summer between Junior and Senior Year
- D3 = End of Junior year into beginning of Senior Fall
- By the end of June or your Junior Year we want to have completed & identified your Academic & Athletic Profile
- Be as prepared as possible when your Cycle begins

# It's a Math Equation

- The College People you won't meet.....the actuaries
- Incoming UMass Freshman Class potential worth:
  - In-State students = 4,287
  - Out of State students = 1,211
- Tuition/Room & Board
  - In State = \$30,000
  - Out of State = \$50,000
- $4,287 \text{ incoming In State Students} \times \$30,000 = \$128,610,000 \text{ million}$
- $1,211 \text{ incoming Out of State Students} \times \$50,000 = \$60,550,000 \text{ million}$
- Total annual gross worth of incoming Freshman class = \$189,160,000 million
- Potential 4 year gross worth of a Class = \$756,640,000 million
- This is a big business.....they are betting on smart people to extract/see the most monies possible
- Smart people want to bet on other smart people
- The higher you are on the RIGOR, GPA & SAT/ACT chart the better bet you are!
