NESTLED IN A TRANQUIL SPOT CLOSE to the Anjuna Beach is the sprawling and luxurious Villa Branco. Developed by Isprava, the space showcases a harmonious blend of Goan-Portuguese and European architectural designs. So, you have the internal courtyard, typical of Goan homes, juxtaposed with Roman arch windows and a Spanish cupola. Interesting fittings include handmade floor tiles, and doors, windows, furniture and antiques (eg: a oyster shell bed from a maharaja's personal collection) sourced from palaces in Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan as well as from mansions in the south of France and Italy.

Fully furnished, the villa comes with a G4S security (free one-year contract), a dedicated property manager, (free one-year facilities management contract) who along with his team of workers, take care of the day to day needs.
