#### Gymnastics Competes for Fourth-Straight SEC Title

The fourth-ranked LSU gymnastics team (5-3, 4-3 SEC) will compete for the program's fourth-straight SEC Championship and fourth overall at 7 p.m. CT Friday at the Von Braun Center in Huntsville, Alabama. The meet will be televised live on SEC Network with Bart Conner and Kathy Johnson Clarke on the call. There will also be event-specific streams available on WatchESPN.com and the app. The Tigers will face off against six teams for the top spot in the league. The squad will begin the night on bars and go in Olympic order to beam, floor and end the night on vault. LSU is ranked fourth in the nation with an NQS of 197.700. This will be the final meet for the team to improve its NQS before preseason competition. LSU boasts two of the top all-around performers in the nation in Haleigh Bryant and Kiya Johnson. This will mark the first SEC Championship for the underclassmen and they are sure to compete for event titles and the all-around. The duo is an intimidating 1-2 punch of LSU's lineup on vault and floor. The senior class boast SEC Championship experience and five of the six will compete on Saturday night. LSU will also compete Alyona Shchennikova in at least three events. Bryant and the other four members of the freshman class will also be relied upon for strong routines on all four events.

### STORYLINES

- LSU has finished in the top two at SEC Championships nine times with four victories in the program's history.
- LSU has an extremely balanced team between underclassmen and upperclassmen. The Tigers projected lineup features 15 underclassmen with eight of those coming from freshmen.
- Twenty-two LSU gymnasts have combined to win 44 SEC titles since 1981. A total of 94 All-SEC honors have been earned over the years and 14 SEC All-Freshman team honors have been awarded since 2009.
- LSU ranks in the top-five nationally on all four events. The Tigers are ranked third on vault and floor and fifth on bars and beam.
- Christina Desiderio and Sarah Edwards have earned All-SEC honors at the league meets. Johnson was named to the All-SEC team after finishing in the top-10 of the league on vault, floor and all-around a year ago.
- at the 2019 SEC Championships in New Orleans, LSU scored the second-highest team score in school history at the event along with the best bars score.



# JAY CLARK

## HEAD COACH • 1ST SEASON

Jay Clark, a 30-year veteran of college gymnastics and one of the best recruiters in the sport, is in his first season as the head coach of the LSU gymnastics program.

Clark was tabbed as the third head coach in program history in August 2020 following the retirement of D-D Breaux. Clark is in his ninth season overall at LSU following his hiring as the Tigers' associate head coach in 2012.

Clark is regarded as one of the best recruiters in the sport and the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. The Tigers' associate head coach for eight seasons and co-head coach for one, Clark's leadership and expertise has helped bring unprecedented success on the recruiting trail and in the gym.

During the time since Clark's arrival, LSU has earned the best performances in school history as the NCAA Runner-Up in 2016, 2017 and 2019, appearances in the NCAA Championship Finals in six of seven seasons, numerous school records, produced seven NCAA individual national champions, and five SEC meet and regular season championships.

His work with the Fighting Tigers of LSU has not gone unnoticed. Clark has been named the Central Region Co-Assistant Coach of the Year along with fellow LSU assistant Bob Moore five times.

Clark also earned the 2014 and 2017 National Co-Assistant Coach of the Year award with Moore. It marked the third time in his distinguished coaching career he has garnered the nation's top award. He was inducted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame in 2018. Because of his recruiting success, ESPN and ESPN the Magazine selected Clark as the ninth-best recruiter in all of collegiate athletics in 2011.

In the gym, Clark is viewed as the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. Clark has coached the Tigers to 30 All-America honors on bars, four of the five highest bars team scores in school history and the top two bars title winners in LSU history. In his illustrious career, Clark has coached nine NCAA bars champions and two during his time in Baton Rouge.

Clark tutored Sarah Finnegan, who ended her career in April 2019 as one of the greatest gymnasts in LSU history. Finnegan became the first NCAA bars champion in school history in 2017 and earned the title once again in 2019. Finnegan and Lexie Priessman won SEC bars champions in 2019 and 2017 respectively, scored perfect scores in 2019 and led the squad that finished fourth in the nation.

The 2018 season on bars under Clark marked the best lineup in LSU history and one of the best in the history of the NCAA. The group posted a school record score of 49.725 and once again went on to break the record against Arizona with a 49.750 for the second-highest in all of NCAA Gymnastics since 1988.

The lineup, anchored by Finnegan, led the nation on bars for the first time in school history. Finnegan became the first gymnast in school history to finish the season ranked No. 1 on the event and joined Sharene Mamby (2001) and Syreeta Barnett (1997) as the only gymnasts at LSU to score a perfect 10.0 on the event.

In 2017, Clark coached Finnegan to the first NCAA Uneven Bars Championship in school history. Clark set the record for the most individual national champions on the event in NCAA gymnastics history.

Clark's bars squad finished ranked third in the nation for a fourth-consecutive top-5 finish in 2017. The team's average score of 49.367 broke the previous record set in 2015. Finnegan and Priessman combined for three All-America honors. Priessman also took home the program's first SEC Uneven Bars championship in more than 20 seasons at the league meet.

LSU earned another Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2016 with an average score of 49.252. Finnegan, Priessman and Myia Hambrick combined to tally four All-America honors during the historic season.

The Tigers posted a Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2015, and the team totaled the second-highest bars total in school history with a 49.600 against Iowa. The Tigers also accumulated the second-best season average on bars in school history with a 49.288 average.

As a team LSU produced four All-America honors on bars in 2015 with three gymnasts (Rheagan Courville, Randii Wyrick and Shae Zamardi) earning First-Team All-America honors at the NCAA Championships. It marked the first time in program history that three gymnasts secured First-Team All-America honors on bars in one season.

Under Clark's direction, LSU shattered the school record with a 49.330 average on bars and finished the 2014 season ranked No. 5 nationally in the event. In addition, the Tigers tallied three of the top-10 bars scores in school history, including a 49.600 that ranks as the second best, and LSU produced three All-America honors on bars.

Clark coached Courville to a First-Team All-America honor at the 2014 NCAA Championships, and Courville went on to finish fifth in the event at the NCAA Individual Finals.

LSU reached the Super Six in the 2013 season, and under Clark's guidance the Tigers finished the season with a 49.260 regional qualifying score on bars, the highest final RQS in that event since the 2009 season.

Clark coached Morrison and Wyrick to First-Team All-America honors on bars in his first season with the Tigers, and it marked the first season LSU produced at least two All-Americans on bars since 2010.

Before Clark joined LSU after he spent 20 seasons at the University of Georgia where he helped guide the Gym Dogs to seven NCAA National Titles and 14 Southeastern Conference Championships.

Clark primarily coached bars at Georgia, and he coached the Gym Dogs to 64 All-America honors and seven NCAA individual national titles on bars, including two-time champions Courtney Kupets and Kat Ding.

From 2009-12, Clark served as the head coach at Georgia, and during that time the Gym Dogs captured three NCAA individual national championships, won the 2012 NCAA Auburn Regional, and produced 23 All-America honors. In 2012, his Georgia team won the Bulldog Cup, which recognizes the UGA team that excels academically, supports their peers in athletics and consistently serves the community.

Prior to his stint as head coach, Clark was the recruiting coordinator at Georgia from 1999-2009 while serving as assistant coach from 1999-2004 and associate head coach from 2005-09 when Georgia won a NCAA record five-straight national titles.

Clark also coached at the club level for 13 years from 1992-2005 as the founder, owner and head coach of Classic City Gymnastics in Athens, Georgia. He coached several Classic City gymnasts to state, regional, national championships and to the Junior Olympic National Team, and eight gymnasts went on to compete at the NCAA Division I level.

A native of Roswell, Georgia, Clark earned his undergraduate degree in exercise science from Georgia.

Clark is married to the former Julie Ballard, an All-American Georgia gymnast from 1994-98 and a native of Mandeville, Louisiana. The couple has two children – a son, Cole, and a daughter, Kinsey.

### LSU Draws No. 2 Seed for SEC Championships

- The draw for the SEC Championships is determined by each team's national qualifying score (NQS) ranking. As the second-ranked team in the SEC and No. 4 team in the nation, LSU will start on bars. No. 1 Florida will start on vault, No. 8 Alabama will start on beam and No. 9 Arkansas will start on beam.

### LSU Goes for Four-Peat at SEC Championships in Huntsville

- The LSU Gymnastics program has won the last three SEC Championships as the premier team in the most difficult conference in the country.
- LSU won its second league title in school history and the first since the inaugural championship at the 2017 championships in Jacksonville. At that meet, Ashleigh Gnat won the vault, beam and floor titles, McKenna Kelley won the floor exercise, and Lexie Priessman won LSU's first bars title in 20 years.
- The squad then defended its crown in 2018 in St. Louis. Sarah Finnegan won the all-around title to help the Tigers outlast Florida in a tight contest.
- The Tigers completed the three peat at SEC Championships in New Orleans in 2019. Finnegan dominated the meet with wins on bars, beam, floor and all-around. The Tigers three championships marked the fifth time in league history a team has won three in a row.
- The 2020 SEC Championships were canceled a week prior to competition due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- With a win on Saturday night, it would mark the fourth time in SEC history that a team has won four league titles in a row: Georgia (2004-07); Georgia (1991-94); Florida (1982-85)

### LSU's History at the SEC Championship

- LSU captured the SEC title when the Tigers hosted the first championship in 1981. Here is a breakdown of LSU's finishes at the SEC Championship: 1st Place - 4 times (1981, 2017, 2018, 2019); 2nd Place - 5 (1990, 1995, 2000, 2005, 2015); 3rd Place - 10 (1982, 1983, 1991, 1994, 1997, 1998, 2004, 2013, 2014, 2016); 4th Place - 17 (1984, 1985, 1986, 1987, 1988, 1989, 1993, 1999, 2001, 2002, 2003, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2012); 5th Place - 3 (1992, 1996, 2011); 6th Place - 0; 7th Place - 0; 8th Place - 0

### Last Time Out

- LSU scored a 197.875 to finish the regular season with a victory over Missouri.
- Freshman Haleigh Bryant opened the night with a perfect 10 on vault, her first career 10.
- Sophomore Kiya Johnson punctuated the night with a 10 on floor. It marked her fourth career 10, second on floor and second this season.
- Johnson and Bryant shared the all-around title with a 39.625.
- Senior Sami Durante and sophomore Alyona Shchennikova also took home the bar title.
- Bryant was honored with SEC Freshman of the Week honors after her performance.

### Tigers in the Rankings

- The LSU gymnastics team is fourth in the final week of National Qualifying Score (NQS) rankings before NCAA postseason, according to Road To Nationals.
- The Tigers own an NQS of 197.700 this season, which is fourth behind Florida and Oklahoma (197.944) and Michigan (197.788)
- LSU's NQS ranking is an average of the top two home scores of 198.050 and 197.200 and away scores of 197.550 and 197.325. The Tigers will have an opportunity to jump Michigan to take the third spot with a strong away score at SEC Championships.
- As a team, LSU ranks third in the nation on vault and floor and fifth on bars and beam. The Tigers'

floor score of 49.650 against Missouri is the highest in the nation in 2021.

- Individually, freshman Haleigh Bryant ranks third on floor, sixth on vault and eighth in the all-around. Sophomore Kiya Johnson is 11th on vault and Alyona Shchennikova is 11th on bars and 19th on vault. Senior Sami Durante is also 11th on bars for the squad.

## Johnson and Bryant Own Perfect Scores

- Kiya Johnson opened the 2021 season with a perfect score on floor, marking the third 10.0 of her career. She then scored a 10 on floor in the final meet of the regular season.
- Bryant joined Johnson as the only LSU gymnasts with a 10 after doing it against Missouri on vault.
- It was the first 10 for Bryant in her career. She became the fourth LSU freshman to score a perfect 10 in school history.
- Bryant is only the second freshman in the country to earn a 10 this year. She is the sixth gymnast in the country to earn a 10 on vault in 2021. The anchor performance in the opening rotation pushed LSU to a 49.550 on vault.
- Johnson scored a 10.0 on vault and beam in her debut season.
- The sophomore joined April Burkholder and Sarah Finnegan as the only gymnasts in school history with a 10.0 on three events.
- Johnson's 10.0 in the opening tied Ashleigh Clare-Kearney (1/5/07) for the earliest by an LSU gymnast in school history.

## Bryant and Johnson Are Nation's Top All-Around Performers

- Once in the lineup at the same time, LSU's Haleigh Bryant and Kiya Johnson are one of the best all-around duos in the country.
- Head Coach Jay Clark put the trio together in the all-around for the first time against Missouri.
- Johnson proved herself as one of the best all-around gymnasts in the country a year ago and owns a career high of 39.700.
- Bryant has been in the all-around in five meets and earned the win four times. She owns a career high of 39.625.
- Alyona Shchennikova also has an opportunity to be in the all-around. She has been one of the biggest surprises for people around the country. She only competed bars a year ago after suffering a torn Achilles before arriving to LSU. In her all-around debut against Auburn, Shchennikova scored a 39.525.

## Gymnastics Leads Nation in Attendance

- Despite limited capacity numbers, the Pete Maravich Center was home to the best average attendance number in the nation in 2021.
- LSU averaged 2,520 fans a meet, including a high of 2,565 against No. 1 Florida in February.
- The LSU Gymnastics program totaled 10,080 fans through the doors of the PMAC in 2021.
- The Tigers have been in the top three in the country over the years in attendance, finishing second in the nation in 2020 and 2018 and third in 2019 and 2017.

## Durante Named LSU's Nominee for AAI Award

- Sami Durante was selected as LSU's nominee for the AAI Award, which goes to the top senior gymnast in the nation.
- A native of Athens, Georgia, Durante has been an integral part of LSU's success over the last four years as a specialist on bars, beam and vault.
- Since starting her career as LSU's bars leadoff performer, she has missed just two performances on the event and served as the team's anchor the last two seasons.
- Durante is a two-time member of the SEC Academic Honor Roll and pursuing her bachelor's degree in kinesiology. The daughter of former collegiate coach Dana Durante, Sami wants to pursue a career in coaching following her time at LSU.

## Bryant Adds Another SEC Weekly Honor Following Alabama

- Haleigh Bryant has been named the SEC Freshman of the Week following her 39.600 all-around performance at Alabama.
- The North Carolina native matched her career high in the all-around and anchored floor with a 9.95. Bryant also scored a 9.90 on vault and a 9.875 on bars and beam.
- It marks the fifth honor for Bryant by the league office. She was named the best freshman in the league in weeks one, three and five. She also was named the top gymnast after the Tigers' road meet against Arkansas.

## Shchennikova Named SEC Specialist of the Week

- Sophomore Alyona Shchennikova put together a career night on Friday against No. 1 Florida and was named the SEC Specialist of the Week.
- She set or matched career highs on all three events she competed. Shchennikova set a new high on vault with a 9.925. The sophomore matched career highs on bars and floor with a 9.95 and 9.925.
- It marked the second honor for Shchennikova. She was named the SEC Gymnast of the Week following her all-around debut against Auburn.

## Bryant, Shchennikova Each Earn Top League Honors

- Alyona Shchennikova was named the SEC Gymnast of the Week following her all-around debut at Auburn.
- The sophomore set four career highs on the way to a 39.525 all-around score. Shchennikova scored career highs of 9.90 on vault and 9.925 on floor. She made her beam debut and scored a 9.875.
- Bryant was named the SEC Freshman of the Week after her all-around and vault win against Auburn. Bryant has won the all-around in all three appearances this season.

## Bryant Adds Another SEC Freshman of the Week Honor

- Haleigh Bryant was named the SEC Freshman of the Week after her performance against the Bulldogs.
- It marked the third honor for Bryant in as many weeks. She was named the top freshman the first week and gymnast of the week after the Tigers' meet at Arkansas.
- Against the Bulldogs, Bryant won her second all-around title and vault title of 2021. The Cornelius, North Carolina, native scored a 9.90 on vault and 39.475 in the all-around. She was steady throughout the meet with a 9.85 on bars and floor and 9.875 on beam.

## Bryant Named SEC Gymnast of the Week

- LSU freshman Haleigh Bryant was named the SEC Gymnast of the Week after her outstanding all-around debut against Arkansas.
- Bryant captured the all-around title with a 39.600 against the Razorbacks. It marked the third highest score of 2021 and the best by a freshman.
- The all-around score is the highest for any LSU freshman in their debut, and she is the fifth gymnast to score a 39.600 or higher in their first season.
- The Cornelius, North Carolina, native also picked up the win on floor with a 9.95. Her average score of 9.975 ranks second in the nation. Bryant scored a career high 9.90 on bars and also scored a 9.90 in her first collegiate performance on beam.
- She was named the SEC Freshman of the Week after the season opener.

- The 2021 schedule will be unique and one of the most difficult in the nation with just eight meets against SEC teams.
- It will be comprised of eight meets per school over 10 weeks, with the regular season concluding with the SEC Gymnastics Championships on March 20.
- The schedule will include two open dates for all schools in Week 5 and Week 10 to allow for rescheduling of postponed events.

## Clark Begins New Chapter as Head Coach

- Jay Clark, who served on staff for eight seasons on staff, was elevated to head coach of the Fighting Tigers.
- Clark took over for legendary coach D-D Breaux, who served as head coach for 43 seasons.
- Clark owns 30 years of NCAA Gymnastics experience and is one of the most respected coaches in the country.
- In his time at LSU, Clark has elevated the Tigers' bars teams to one of the best in the nation.
- He takes over in 2021 as the third coach in program history.
- Clark previously served for more than 20 years as an assistant coach and head coach at the University of Georgia.

## Gnat Makes Her Return to Baton Rouge

- Ashleigh Gnat, a 17-time All-American, four-time Southeastern Conference event champion and 2017 NCAA Floor Champion, was named as the squad's assistant coach in August after Clark's promotion to head coach.
- A two-time graduate of LSU, Gnat's primary responsibility is as the Tigers' beam coach.
- After her gymnastics career, Gnat served as a student coach for two years. She landed her first full-time position in 2019 as an assistant coach at Penn State.
- During her six years in Baton Rouge, Gnat was a part of the most successful stretch of the program's history. The Tigers set the three highest finishes in school history during Gnat's time and won five SEC Championships.
- She brings a wealth of experience as one of the best gymnasts in school history. Gnat led the Tigers inside and outside of the gym as LSU's nominee for the NCAA Woman of the Year Award and a finalist for the Honda Award.
- Gnat set multiple records during her career in Baton Rouge, including the most floor titles in a single season and perfect scores in a career with nine. Gnat was the 2016 and 2017 SEC Specialist of the Year and Central Region Gymnast of the Year.

## **Gymnastics Owns Last Three SEC Meet Titles**

- The LSU Gymnastics team has claimed the last three SEC Championships titles and been the most accomplished team in the league during that span.
- The Tigers have claimed back-to-back-to-back SEC meet championships in Jacksonville, Florida, St. Louis, Missouri and New Orleans, Louisiana.
- The three-peat marked the fifth time in SEC history a team has won three or more SEC titles in a row.

## **Seniors Return Ten Routines to 2021**

- The senior class of Reagan Campbell, Bridget Dean, Christina Desiderio, Sami Durante, Sarah Edwards and Olivia Gunter provide a wealth of experience and routines for the Tigers in their fourth year.
- Campbell and Desiderio are beam and floor specialists who have earned All-America honors before.
- Dean is a three-event specialist with experience at NCAA Championships. Durante is the Tigers' anchor on beam and has delivered crucial performances on beam in the last two seasons.
- Edwards was sidelined for a majority of 2020 with an injury but returns to the team with her high energy floor routine and 10.0 vault.
- Gunter rounds out the class with a strong floor routine and crucial energy for the team. She could enter the floor lineup at any time in 2021.

## **Johnson is One of Nation's Top Gymnasts**

- LSU's Kiya Johnson has made her name known as the top freshman in the nation and one of the top all-around performers a year ago.
- Prior to the season being canceled due to COVID-19, Johnson was on pace to break every LSU record and compete for SEC and NCAA Championships.
- Johnson won 22 individual titles in 2020 with seven in the all-around, six on floor, five on vault, three on beam and one on bars.
- The Dallas, Texas, native was named the SEC Gymnast of the Week following her performance against Auburn and was named the SEC Freshman of the Week the following four weeks.
- Johnson owns career highs of 39.75 in the all-around, 10 on beam and vault, 9.975 on floor and 9.90 on bars.
- She earned All-America honors on vault, floor and in the all-around after finishing fourth, sixth and second respectively in the final rankings.

## **Freshman Class Brings Big Routines**

- LSU's freshman class of Elena Arenas, Sierra Ballard, Chase Brock, Haleigh Bryant and Olivia Dunne are poised to bring big performances and will be relied on heavily.
- Arenas, Brock, Bryant and Dunne made their debuts in week one.
- Bryant won vault and scored a 9.975 on floor. Dunne scored a 9.875 on bars. Arenas and Brock each delivered strong performances.

## **Rivers Out for 2021**

- Sophomore Kai Rivers will miss the 2021 season after suffering an Achilles injury during training this fall.
- The LSU coaching staff was anticipating training at full health for the all-around.
- In her freshman season, Rivers competed on vault and bars with career highs of 9.90. She competed beam early in the season in three events and earned a 9.95 for a career high.
- Rivers will miss most of the regular season but has the potential to return during postseason competition on bars based on her recovery.
