

# Will Wade

**Head Coach**

4th Year at LSU • 8th Year as a Head Coach

The buzz word when Will Wade arrived at LSU was consistency.

He wanted to make LSU basketball, a program which has had ultimate highs followed by periods of lows, be a consistent player on the college basketball scene.

A team with good players that produces consistent winning, regular post-season tournament appearances and playing an exciting brand of basketball that would see the Tigers contend for a top spot yearly in the Southeastern Conference.

His players would represent the University in a positive way both on and off the court.

Completing his third season as the head coach of the LSU Fighting Tiger basketball program, Coach Will Wade has been able to check all the boxes of program building and program stability that he set out to accomplish when he was named the 22nd head coach of the LSU program prior to the 2017-18 season.

In three years, the Tigers have won 67 games with two post-season appearances (and what would have been a third before post-season was canceled) with an SEC Championship in 2019 and a tie for second in 2020. The Tigers advanced to the round of 16 in the NIT in 2018 and to the Sweet 16 in the 2019 NCAA Championships.

In 2019, Coach Wade, his staff and players put together a team that posted a 16-2 record in the Southeastern Conference, winning the 11th regular season title in school history. In three seasons, the Tigers have won 36 games in league play.

It was all part of the vision the coach has for the program. It's a vision to have "unwavering commitment to put the team first, to put the state first, to put our school first to represent all of these folks in a first-class fashion. We are going to be a hard-working team that represents this great university that represents this great state."

Frank William "Will" Wade said those words on March 20, 2017 when he was named the head coach at LSU. He came to LSU after a stellar two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University and two years at UT-Chattanooga.

He was the first LSU mentor to get the Tigers to post-season play in both of the first two seasons on the job. He is one of just five LSU coaches to lead his team to an SEC Championship and one of just four to take a team to the NCAA Sweet 16.

Wade has also brought analytics and trends to his coaching practices at LSU and his ability to know situations and tendencies has proven beneficial to the Tigers in his first three seasons.

Coach Wade has shown LSU followers that he looks to prepare his team for league play by producing a non-conference schedule that is competitive and among the best in the country. His schedule ranked fifth in the country in 2019 and eighth in the country in 2020.

This past season that non-conference schedule helped LSU open with eight straight conference wins as LSU tied for second place in the league one season after winning the league championship.

LSU was 8-1 in league play at the Maravich Center with a two-point win over Arkansas, a one-point win over Mississippi State (on a Skylar Mays buzzer beating jump shot) and a two-point win over Florida. LSU also won by four points at Texas A&M in overtime after rallying from six down in the final two minutes of regulation.

It was a season in which offense dominated the nights when LSU had success, averaging 80.5 points a game, marking the second straight year LSU averaged 80 points a game (80.4 in 2019) and the first time LSU has averaged over 80 points a game since the 1991 and 1992 seasons.

Four-year star Skylar Mays earned first-team All-SEC honors and showed his ability off the court earning his third College Sports Information Directors Association of America (CoSIDA) Academic All-America honor in 2020. He

was a second-team Academic A-A in 2018 and a first-team Academic A-A in both 2019 and 2020. The Baton Rouge native was named the CoSIDA Academic All-America of the Year for D1 men's basketball.

The highlight of Wade's three years came in 2019 when the Tigers won their first SEC title in 10 years and won two games in the NCAA Tournament to advance to the Sweet 16 for the first time since 2006. But it was also a year in which a coach and a team had to handle the worst possible tragedy, the death of a teammate.

Junior Wayde Sims was killed in the early morning of Sept. 28, 2018 just hours before what was to be the first team workout in preparation for the 2018-19 season.

It was a season in which time after time, the Tigers appeared to need a spark to stay alive for a win and things would turn around. LSU would go a perfect 9-0 in the league on the road, winning four overtime games and another at the buzzer.

As good as the players were in November when the season started, the team showed improvement from start to finish and that was all due to Coach Wade and his staff and the work that was put in on the court, in the video room, in scouting reports and so much more.

So far in three seasons, LSU under Wade has posted 18 wins in the Quadrant I rankings in the NCAA RPI/now NET rankings.

Between 2019 and 2020, the Tigers ran off 12 straight SEC road wins, the third longest streak in school history.

In the first three years, the Tigers have drawn five crowds that are in the top 12 single game attendances in the present seating configuration of the Pete Maravich Assembly Center. Fans are caring about LSU basketball, not just because of wins, but because of what they have seen on the court.

The fans have seen the things that Coach Wade promised when he took the job – an energized staff that was integrated in the game making coaching decisions and alterations as needed; player that were working hard to enact a game plan and making big plays.

Three member of the 2019 championship team – Tremont Waters, Naz Reid and Kavell Bigby-Williams – played in the NBA and G-Leagues in 2020.

Waters was a first-team All-SEC selection and the co-SEC Defensive Player of the Year while Reid made the league all-freshman team.

Wade, one of the younger coaches in Division I at 36, has also proven to be one of the most energetic both in practices and games, and his players have responded.

## PROTIO TO LSU

The native of Nashville, Tennessee, directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances in 2015-2016 and 2016-2017. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating seventh-seed Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. Wade was the youngest head coach in the NCAA Tournament in 2016. In 2017, VCU lost to St. Mary's in the first round of the NCAA tourney.

The Rams were 28-8 over his two years in the Atlantic 10 Conference, posting 14-4 records both years. The team was 25-11 in 2016 and earned a share of the 2Atlantic 10 Conference regular season crown. The 2017 team won 26

games and finished second in the league.

Wade previously served at VCU as an assistant with the Rams under Shaka Smart from 2009-13. He was part of the staff in 2011 when VCU advanced from the NCAA "First Four" all the way to the Final Four in Houston.

Wade is credited with being a key figure in four top non-power five recruiting classes in his four seasons at VCU.

Prior to becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

His first Mocs squad went 18-15 in 2014, finishing 12-6 and second in regular season Southern Conference play. The team made the school's first postseason appearance since 2009 in the CIT.

The Mocs won 22 games in 2015 (15-3 in league) as Wade guided UTC to its first 20-win season since 2004-05.

In his seven years as a head coach, he has a combined record of 155-75 and 90-33 in conference play with five post-season appearances.

Wade's reputation, where ever he has coached, is a person who is a tireless worker and relentless recruiter. Wade was VCU Head Coach Shaka Smart's first hire upon being named the head VCU coach in 2009.

He served as an assistant to Tommy Amaker at Harvard in 2007-08 and 2008-09. Wade's coaching start came at Clemson where he served as Director of Basketball Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05). There he worked for coaches Larry Shyatt (2002-03) and Oliver Purnell (2004-07).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth (3).

### LAST GAME: LSU 86, NICHOLLS 80 (Baton Rouge, Dec. 26, 2020)

The Tigers finally got back on the court for the first time since Dec. 14, holding off a stubborn Nicholls squad for the second straight year. In many ways, the game was similar to last year when LSU scored an 85-75 win. LSU build an 11-point lead in the first half but Nicholls cut the game to five points at the break.

LSU opened up a double-digit lead in the second half, but Nicholls cut the lead to three points four times in the first 10 minutes of the second half. The Tigers were troubled by turnovers in the second half, committing 10 miscues.

Cam Thomas, Trendon Watford and Darius Days combined for 66 points with Thomas scoring 29 points, Watford 22 and Days 15. Watford also had nine rebounds and six assists.

LSU shot over 50 percent for the fifth time in six games, hitting 31-of-56 field goals (55.4 percent), with four treys and 20-of-28 at the line. LSU was 27-of-41 from inside the arc (65.8%).

The Tigers were outrebounded by the Colonels, 37-34, and 17-10 on the offensive boards as Nicholls had a 42-34 advantage in points in the paint and 18-12 on second chance points.

### SO HOW WE GOT TO THIS POINT IN THE SEASON

With the SEC schedule about to get started, a refresher course on how the schedule looked at the start and all the changes that got us to Dec. 29:

1 -- LSU was scheduled to play San Fran, Western Kentucky and Saint Louis in Lincoln, Nebraska in the Golden Window Classic, Nov. 25, 26 and 28.

2 -- Saint Louis elected to stay in Saint Louis and invited LSU to join them for the Billiken Classic where LSU played SIUE and Saint Louis, Nov. 26 and 28.

3 -- To replace the third game that would have been played in Nebraska, LSU scheduled Southeastern for a game played, Nov. 30.

4 -- LSU plays a scheduled game on Dec. 6 in Baton Rouge against Louisiana Tech. The two teams were originally supposed to meet in Bossier City, Nov. 24, but the promoter and the teams elected to move the game in Bossier City to Dec. 31.

5 -- LSU pulls out of a game with South Florida in Atlanta at Holiday Hoopsgiving Dec. 12 because of SEC and NCAA Covid protocols involving the LSU team.

6 -- LSU quickly schedules Sam Houston State for an 11 a.m. game on Dec. 14. Associate Head Coach Bill Armstrong coaches the game as Coach Will Wade announced earlier in the day he had tested positive for Covid-19.

7 -- LSU announces postponements against UNO (Dec. 16), North Texas (Dec. 19) and VCU (Dec. 22) because of SEC and NCAA protocols regarding Covid.

8 -- LSU on Dec. 21 schedules Texas Southern for a Dec. 26, 4 p.m. game.

9 -- On Dec. 24, Texas Southern has to withdraw because of NCAA Covid-19 protocols. That evening, Nicholls signs a contract to come to Baton Rouge for a 1 p.m. game on Dec. 26.

#### 9 GAMES OF 20 OR MORE POINTS FOR TIGERS

Through six games, LSU has had players record nine games of 20 points or more this season -- 4 by Cam Thomas, 2 by Trendon Watford and 1 each by Javonte Smart and Darius Days. The breakdown:

**Thomas -- 27 vs. SIUE, 25 at Saint Louis, 21 vs. Southeastern, 29 vs Nicholls**

**Watford -- 24 at Saint Louis, 22 vs. Nicholls**

**Smart -- 25 vs. Sam Houston State**

**Days -- 24 vs. SIUE**

Last year, in 31 LSU games there were 22 games of 20 points or more by the Tigers.

#### THOMAS AND 10 FIELD GOALS LEADS TO BIG GAMES

It appears the magic number for Thomas so far has been 10 field goals for the freshman to have a big night:

**SIUE -- 10-of-21 FGs, 4-9 3FGs, 3-4 FT, 2 assists (27 points)**

**SAINT LOUIS -- 10-of-18 FGs, 4-10 3FGs, 1-1 FT, 2 assists (25 points)**

**NICHOLLS -- 10-of-21 FGs, 2-8 3FGs, 7-7 FT, 2 assists (29 points)**

That makes him the first freshman this season in Division I to have three games of 25 or more points.

Thomas, also scored 21 points against Southeastern but only hit four field goals, all treys and 9-of-10 at the free throw line.

In six games, Thomas is averaging 22.8 points per game and he is in the top 10 in scoring average entering the week in the NCAA statistics.

The games against SIUE and Saint Louis to open the season earned him the SEC Freshman of the Week honor and the Nicholls game earned him on Monday his second SEC Freshman of the Week honor.

Besides the scoring, Thomas is averaging 2.8 rebounds and 1.8 assists. He is shooting 44.9 percent overall and made 16 three pointers. Thomas has drawn 24 fouls in the six games and is 33-of-38 at the line for 86.8 percent.

#### SMART'S SIXTH GAME OVER 20

Although Javonte Smart didn't play against Nicholls, his last game was a good one against Sam Houston (Dec. 14). Smart had 25 points in that game, four points away from his 29 points against Tennessee (Feb. 23, 2019) as a freshman and his sixth game of 20 points or more:

**25 -- vs. Sam Houston, 12/14/20**

**21 -- vs. Ole Miss, 2/1/20**

Smart is third on the team in scoring at 15.8 points a game and in his 70 career games has scored 842 points. He has a current streak of eight straight double figure scoring games dating back to the last three games of last year.

LSU is 95-9 since the start of the 2007-08 season when shooting 50 percent or more in a game. LSU is 15th in the country entering the week in the NCAA in field goal percentage. Opponents are shooting just 39.6 percent (33.7 percent in the last four games). LSU has made 31 more field goals than opponents on 29 less attempts.

### LOTS OF REBOUNDS, BUT COACH WANTS MORE IN ONE CATEGORY

The Tigers were able to pull down 53 rebounds against Southeastern and 46 against Louisiana Tech but the numbers for the opponents on the offensive side have caused some consternation for the LSU coach staff.

Southeastern pulled down 14 offensive rebounds to 13 for the Tigers, but in the LA Tech game, the difference was more pronounced with a 14-4 advantage for the Bulldogs that led to a 13-5 second chance points advantage.

The inability to clear the boards again caused problems for LSU against Nicholls as the Tigers were not only rebounded by the Colonels, but Nicholls had a 17-10 advantage on the offensive boards. That resulted in an 18-12 advantage for Nicholls in second chance points.

### JOSH LEBLANC FINALLY PLAYS

He's been at LSU since last January chomping at the bit for the chance to play college basketball again. Finally, against Sam Houston State (12/14), Josh LeBlanc got that chance again, this time in his hometown.

The Baton Rouge native spent a season and a half at Georgetown playing for the Hoyas before returning to Baton Rouge and enrolling at LSU in time for the second semester of the 2019-20 school year.

LeBlanc practiced with the Tigers during the conference part of the 2019-20 season and early on this year before becoming eligible for LSU at the end of the fall semester.

He played 14 minutes against the Bearkats, making both field goal attempts, one free throw for five points to go with eight rebounds, including four offensive boards.

Against Nicholls, LeBlanc played 12 minutes with two rebounds and a steal.

### THOMAS ONE OF 13 PLAYERS WITH 21-POINT START

Cam Thomas became the 13th player at LSU since the 1976-77 season to score at least 21 points in his first varsity game when he scored 27 in the contest. Freshman Tremont Waters scored 27 in his debut on Nov. 10, 2017 against Alcorn State and junior college transfer Marcus Thornton hit for 27 against Southeastern on Nov. 12, 2007.

Others who had 21 or more in their first LSU game are: Lester Earl, Duop Reath, Antonio Blakeney, Randy Livingston, Jose Vargas, Ralston Turner, Andre Stringer, Ronald Dupree, Ronnie Henderson and John Williams.

For the record, in his first game in 1967, Pete Maravich scored 49 points.

### THREE STRAIGHT 20 POINT GAMES TO START AN LSU CAREER

Cam Thomas became the first LSU player to have three 20 or more in his first three varsity LSU games since JC transfer Marcus Thornton did in Nov. 2007 – games of 27, 24 and 20.

As freshmen go in recent times – Tremont Waters as a freshman had 20-plus in his first and third games in 2017-18; In 2015-16, Ben Simmons, who went on to be national freshman of the year, had 20-plus in his second and third games; and, high school All-America Randy Livingston, returned after knee surgery for his redshirt freshman season and had 20-plus in his 1st and 3rd games in 1994-95.

In another example, Mahmoud Abdul-Rauf opened his two-time All-American campaign at LSU with 13, 25 and 48. Pete Maravich, who played at a time freshmen weren't eligible, had 48, 42 and 51 in his first three sophomore games as a Tiger. It should be said he topped 20 plus in his first three games on the LSU freshman team.

### WATFORD SCORING AND DISHING

After a strong freshman campaign in which he averaged 13.6 points and 7.2 rebounds, Trendon Watford's sophomore campaign has started well, although he missed the Sam Houston game (12/14) with a minor ankle injury.

Not only has Watford scored well early, but he is leading the team and second in the SEC at 4.8 assists per game. He is averaging 19.4 points per game and 6.8 rebounds. More importantly, he is posting an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.40 which is third in the league.

Against Nicholls (12/26), Watford equaled his third best scoring game with 22 points on 9-of-12 shooting with nine rebounds and six assists. It was his third game of six or more assists this season.

Watford is first in the league in field goal percentage at 65.2 percent (25th in the NCAA) making 30-of-46 attempts. Watford was 157-of-321 as a freshman (48.9 percent).

Dating back to the final two games of the 2019-20 season, Watford has been in double figures in the last seven games he has played in.

### WATFORD LOOKING GOOD AT THE LINE

It is well documented the improvement that Trendon Watford made at the free throw line in his freshman season.

In non-conference games last season (with all but one in November and December 2019), Watford was 33-of-58 at the line, 56.9 percent. After the Christmas holidays, Coach Wade and Trendon would go to the free throw line after every practice and shootaround and begin free throw drills with him having to make a certain amount or the drill would start over.

In the 18 conference games, Watford would make 56-of-74 or 75.7 percent. That gave him a season mark of 67.4 percent.

Watford, first of all has been getting fouled and to the line a good bit in the early part of the season, leads the team with 29 fouls drawn. That has led to a strong 34-of-43 free throw effort (79.1%).

### DARIUS DAYS ON THE BOARDS

For the second time this year, Darius Days pulled down double figure rebounds as he grabbed 10 against Sam Houston State (12/14). It was his first double double of the year with 16 points and 10 boards and the ninth of his career.

So far in six games, the junior from Raleigh, Florida is averaging 14.5 points and 8.3 rebounds a game. He is sixth in the SEC in rebounding.

### TIGERS INSIDE THE ARC

LSU has been good the last few years shooting inside the arc but this year the Tigers have one of the nation's top percentages inside the arc for two points. LSU in its last game against Nicholls (12/26), made 27-of-41 shots inside the arc (65.9%). For the season, LSU is 124-of-197 shooting for two points and the 62.9% is seventh best in the country entering league play.

Last season, LSU was 54.7 percent inside the arc, which was 17th in the nation. In 2018-19, LSU was 52.9 percent inside the arc.

## LSU BETTER OUTSIDE THE ARC

The Nicholls game was the first game, LSU's outside shooting numbers tumbled, hitting only 4-of-15 attempts (26.7%). However, LSU has hit double figures twice and no less than eight in any of the other five games to post 54-of-145 for the six total games of 37.2 percent. That is 4.5 points better than last season when LSU was just 32.7 percent for the season.

LSU's 54 attempts are five more than the opponents who have taken 31 more three-point attempts than LSU.

## FREE THROWS COUNTING WELL

LSU is third in the league at the line, making 121-of-156 free throws in six games, not shooting below 70 percent this season. LSU is at 77.6 percent for the season.

The Tigers have made 54 more free throws than opponents and have attempted 52 more free throws than opponents early in the season.

## LSU'S OFFENSIVE POWER NUMBERS

Kenpom.com has LSU sixth in the list of top 10 offenses so far in the early part of the year. Gonzaga is tops followed by Iowa, Baylor, Villanova and Illinois in front of LSU. After LSU comes Creighton, Ohio State, Wisconsin and Michigan.

## SOME OF THE NUMBERS

LSU returns three starters from a season ago and each started 30-of-the-31 games:

### Sophomore Trendon Watford – 13.6 points and 7.2 rebounds

### Junior Javonte Smart – 12.5 points, 3.5 rebounds and 4.2 assists

### Junior Darius Days – 11.1 points and 6.8 rebounds

LSU returns 45.7 percent of its offensive production (45.1 points of an 80.5 season average); 20.7 rebounds of a 39.7 team rebound average (53.1%) and 57.0 percent of assists (227 of 398 total).

Offensively, LSU had one of the most efficient offenses in February and March at 1.13 points per possession. According to NCAA.com, only Gonzaga (1.19) and Creighton (1.15) had higher points per possession levels during February/March when the season was called.

## FATHERS AND SONS

UCLA transfer Shareef O'Neal brings an addition to the list of Fathers and Sons who have been a part of the LSU men's basketball program over the years.

O'Neal will wear 32 this year and there are a number of things to consider with this number choice – 1) His dad wore No. 32 when he was the center for the Orlando Magic in the first stop on his NBA career and later with the Miami Heat and Phoenix Suns; 2) The younger O'Neal was very close to the late Kobe Bryant and of course Kobe's two NBA numbers were 8 and 24 which also add up to 32.

Shareef and father Shaquille O'Neal will become the latest in a line of father-son combinations that have played for the LSU Purple and Gold:

So far this season, O'Neal has averaged 15 minutes a game, 3.0 points and 5.0 rebounds a game. O'Neal had nine rebounds in the win over Southeastern.

The younger O'Neal has made two three-pointers which is two more than his dad made in his three years at LSU. He has been first sub or co-sub in the game in all five of the games he has played in.

## EARLY SEASON WATCH LISTS

Two Tigers were named to two of the watch lists as put out by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and for the Wooden Award – Javonte Smart and Trendon Watford.

Smart was named to the watch list for the Bob Cousy Award for point guards and Watford is on the watch list for the Karl Malone Award for forwards.

The two were also on the first team All-SEC coaches' preseason squad.

### SERIES AGAINST TEXAS A&M

The Tigers have a 24-18 lead in the overall series with LSU winning the last six meetings of the series over the last three years. Prior to that, over the previous three years (2015-17), the Aggies had won 6-of-7 contests. LSU leads 16-3 in games played in Baton Rouge. The teams first met way back in 1917 and have been playing at least twice a year since 2013.

The Aggies are 5-1 as LSU is with wins over New Orleans, Tarleton State, UTRGV, Southeastern and in their most recent game (Dec. 21), Wofford (70-52).

Emanuel Miller leads Texas A&M with an 18.0 points per game average and 9.4 rebounds. Miller is shooting 25-of-41 from the field (61.0%). Quenton Jackson is next at 11.7 points and Savion Flagg is at 10.0 points. The Aggies are averaging 71.7 points per game while surrendering 60.7 a game.

Buzz Williams is in his second season as the head coach at A&M.

### SEC OPENERS

LSU has won openers the last two years at home against Alabama in 2019 and at Tennessee in 2020. LSU is 50-38 overall in SEC opening games.

### WILL WADE IN CONFERENCE GAMES

Coach Will Wade in his eighth season as a head coach has had good success in conference games in all three of his head coaching stops, winning double figure games every year except his first year at LSU.

Wade won 27 league games in two years at Chattanooga, 28 in two years at VCU and 35 games in his first three years at LSU. In seven seasons, Wade is 90-33 in league games including 35-18 at LSU. Wade was 8-10 his first season in the league, 15-2 in a conference championship team in 2019 (He did not coach the final game of the 2019 season.) and, 12-6 and tying for second in 2020.

### JAVONTE SMART

Smart started 30-of-31 games a year ago and has played in 70-of-a-possible-71 games over his two plus years at LSU with 53 starts over that time ... Last year he averaged 12.5 points, 3.5 rebounds and had 129 assists.

He is on the watch list for the Bob Cousy Award and the Jersey Mike's Naismith Player of the Year list as well as the Wooden list. He was a second team selection on the media All-SEC team (two five-man teams) and is on the first team of the coaches' All-SEC selection (eight players).

Smart ended up with wonderful assist-to-turnover numbers and much of that came in league play. In his first five games last year, Smart had 25 assists and 26 turnovers. He finished the season with 129 total assists and 70 turnovers. For the last 26 games of the season, he posted a 2.93 assist-to-turnover ratio. For the entire 31 games season, Smart's 129-70 assist-to-turnover ratio was 1.84, fourth in the league.

In the 18 SEC games, Smart was equally as impressive with 65 assists and 31 turnovers (2.10 ratio) which was tops in the league. Smart has had no turnovers in three-of-the-last-four SEC games.

Compared to last year, in his first five games this season, Smart has 19 assists and 10 turnovers, a 1.9 assist to turnover ratio.

### SMART TOPS 100 THREE-POINTERS

It was at the 6:01 mark of the first half against Sam Houston (12/14) when Javonte Smart made his first three-pointer of the game and that gave him 100 for his LSU career. He became the 23rd player in LSU history with 100 career treys. Darrel Mitchell, who played for the 2006 Final Four team, is the team's all-time leader in three-pointers at 258, while Tremont Waters (2017-19) was the one prior to Smart to cross the 100 threshold, finishing at 128.

### DARIUS DAYS

Days also was among the league leaders in rebounds last year, averaging 6.8 boards overall (8th in the SEC) and 6.4 in conference games for No. 11 in the league games rankings.

Days averaged 11.1 points last year for the Tigers, hitting 48.6 percent of his field goal attempts (125-of-257) with 39 three-pointers.

After averaging 5.3 points as a freshman, Days more than doubled his scoring average and increased his rebound average from 4.0 to 6.8.

So far this season, he is fourth on the team in scoring at 14.5 points and 8.3 boards. He has hit 12 treys and is shooting 31-of-53 from the field (58.5%). Days is T6 this year so far in rebound average.

### MANNING RETURNS

After a season in which he broke the fifth metatarsal bone in both feet at various times in SEC play last year, the team's long senior, Charles Manning Jr., finally was able to make his season debut against Louisiana Tech (12/6).

Manning played 13.5 minutes in the Tech game, scoring 2 points with two rebounds in his opening game while playing on a minutes restriction after coming back to practice.

With the Trendon Watford injury, he was elevated to the starting lineup against Sam Houston (12/14), playing 32 minutes and scoring four points with seven rebounds, two assists and three steals.

In three games, Manning is averaging 21.4 minutes, 4.0 points and 4.3 rebounds a game.

### WILKINSON GETS FIRST START

Freshman Mwani Wilkinson from Las Vegas got his first start of his LSU career on Dec. 6 against Louisiana Tech. Although he didn't score in the game, he played 17 minutes and had one block and two steals. His best game was against Southeastern Louisiana (11/30), scoring 12 points on 5-of-8 field goal attempts.

He scored six against Sam Houston hitting all three field goal attempts. For the year, Wilkinson is averaging 4.4 points, 2.8 rebounds and 1.2 steals per game.

Against Nicholls he played 20 minutes with a rebound and two steals, but a +/- number of +14. For the season, he is averaging 17.8 minutes, hitting 3.7 points and 2.5 rebounds. Of his 15 rebounds, 12 were offensive.

### JALEN COOK

The Walker, Louisiana product missed the Southeastern game with a minor injury but came back against Louisiana Tech (12/6) and played 13 minutes, scoring 10 points with two assists. Cook in three games is averaging 5.0 points per game and 1.3 rebounds for the year. Cook had nine in 11 minutes against Sam Houston and is averag-

ing 6.0 points and 1.3 rebounds (5th on the team in scoring).

Cook is fifth on the team in scoring at 6.4 points and 1.6 rebounds and assists. Cook played 25 minutes off the bench against Nicholls getting two field goals and 4-of-6 at the line to score eight points with four assists and two steals.

#### ERIC GAINES

Eric Gaines, the freshman from Lithonia, Georgia, got his first start against Nicholls (12/6) with Javonte Smart out and played 15 minutes. While he scored just one point, Gaines had two rebounds two assists, a block and a steal.

Gaines has struggled a bit from the field at 3-of-17, but he has been able to get fouled and get to the line, making 10-of-14. He is averaging 2.8 points and 1.7 rebounds.

#### BPJ AWAY FROM TEAM

Coach Wade announced in Saturday's post-game that transfer center Bryan Penn-Johnson has returned home to California.

"This is the farthest he's ever been away from home," Wade said. "He was a little homesick and has some family issues he's working through. So, we gave him some time. He won't be with us for the foreseeable future as he kind of works through those issues back home."

#### HOW YOUNG AND NEW IS THIS TEAM?

The Tigers are a bit on the new and young side based on research by Tom Gilbert of Kansas State prior to the season.

LSU's five returning letterman makes LSU one of 25 teams that will return five letter winners or less for the 20-21 season.

LSU's eight new players (three transfers, three signees) make it one of 37 teams to have at least eight players in their first year in Baton Rouge.

LSU is one of 23 basketball teams to have at least 10 underclassmen on the roster (freshmen, sophomores).

The Tigers are one of 17 teams to have four or less upperclassmen on the roster (junior, seniors).

Finally, LSU is one of just 12 teams to have one senior (Charles Manning Jr.) on the roster.

#### SEC PLAY FOR TIGERS NEXT ON THE ROAD

So, for the moment, we hope we are settling into games on either Tuesday or Wednesday and then on Saturday and this Saturday, the Tigers will go on the road to Gainesville to take on the University of Florida. The game is set for 1 p.m. CT and will be televised by CBS along with the broadcast of the LSU Sports Radio Network.
