### Tigers Face SLU in Wally Pontiff Jr. Baseball Classic

Seventh-ranked LSU travels to Metairie, La., Wednesday to face Southeastern Louisiana at Zephyr Field in the first Wally Pontiff Jr. Baseball Classic.

The game can be heard on the LSU Sports Radio Network, including flagship WDGL-FM 98.1 in Baton Rouge. The radio broadcast and live stats may be also be accessed at [www.LSUports.net](http://www.LSUports.net).

LSU (25-9) enters Wednesday's contest having lost four of its last five games. The Tigers broke a four-game losing skid on Tuesday with a 9-3 win over Nicholls State in Alex Box Stadium. The Tigers have a 6-6 SEC record and trail Ole Miss and Arkansas by two games in the Western Division standings. LSU resumes conference play this weekend when the Tigers play host to Georgia in a three-game series.

Southeastern Louisiana (11-20) has won three straight games, including a 5-3 victory over No. 12 Southern Mississippi Tuesday night in Hammond. The Lions are 5-7 in the Southland Conference, and they resume SLC play this weekend at McNeese State.

LSU coach Smoke Laval will send freshman right-hander Michael Bonura (3-0, 4.35 ERA) to the mound Wednesday, while SLU coach Dan Canevari will counter with sophomore right-hander Paul Garner (1-1, 8.66 ERA).

### The LSU-Southeastern Louisiana Series

LSU leads the all-time series with SLU, 51-16, including two wins earlier this season (7-1 on March 12 and 5-1 on March 13) in Alex Box Stadium. The teams will meet again on Wednesday, May 19, at 6:30 p.m. in Alex Box Stadium.

The Tigers have won 24 of the 26 meetings between the clubs since 1990; SLU's only wins in that span came in 1991 (15-2) and 2002 (4-3), both in Alex Box Stadium.

Smoke Laval is 14-5 against the Lions during his 10-year collegiate coaching career, including a 5-1 mark as LSU's coach. He is 37-9 against Louisiana teams since taking over the LSU program (14-5 in 2002, 14-3 in 2003, 9-1 in 2004).

SLU coach Dan Canevari, a member of the LSU staff from 1991-2002, helped lead the Tigers to all five of their NCAA championships under former coach Skip Bertman.

LSU is playing its second game this season at Zephyr Field, as the Tigers blanked Tulane, 6-0, at the Triple-A facility on March 2. LSU has a 10-7 all-time mark in Zephyr Field, where the Tigers have played at least one contest each season since 1998.

## Tonight's Game to Raise Funds for Wally Pontiff Foundation

Proceeds from tonight's game will benefit the Wally Pontiff Foundation, named in memory of the former LSU all-SEC third baseman who died in July, 2002, at the age of 21 due to a heart abnormality. The Wally Pontiff Foundation was created to assist youth camps and recreational centers for underprivileged children.

Pontiff, a Metairie native, helped lead LSU to the 2000 national championship as the Tigers' starting designated hitter. He was named the Most Outstanding Player of the 2002 SEC Tournament. Pontiff was LSU's starting third baseman in 2001 and 2002, earning all-SEC recognition in both seasons.

Pontiff was a member of the SEC Academic Honor Roll, and he was named to the 2002 District VI Academic all-America team with a 3.25 gpa in biological sciences.

## Tigers Start Week with 9-3 Victory Tuesday over Nicholls State

LSU erupted for seven runs in its final three at-bats to pull away from Nicholls State, 9-3, on an unseasonably cool night at Alex Box Stadium. The Tigers (No. 7 Baseball America, No. 9 ESPN/Sports Weekly, No. 12 Collegiate Baseball) snapped a four-game losing skid -- their longest since 2002 -- and improved to 25-9 on the season. LSU has now won 12 of its last 13 games versus in-state schools over the last two seasons. The only loss came at the hands of Tulane in a 1-0 setback last Tuesday.

Justin Meier (5-2) worked seven solid innings to pick up his fifth win of the season after registering two losses and two no decisions in his last four starts, dating back to March 19. The sophomore right-hander allowed three runs (two earned) on eight hits and struck out two.

LSU's top three in the order -- J.C. Holt, Ryan Patterson and Blake Gill -- combined to go 6-for-12 with five runs and five RBI.

The Colonels scratched across the game's first run in the second inning on Michael Roberts' RBI sacrifice fly, scoring Jake Ritchie, who had reached on a leadoff single.

The game remained 1-0 until the third when Patterson drove a 3-1 offering from NSU starter Mark Fernandez over the right field wall for a two-run homer -- his fifth of the year -- to give the Tigers a 2-1 advantage.

One inning later, the contest was knotted on Josh Thomas' RBI single that plated Tony Ruiz. Ruiz had connected for a leadoff single and advanced to second on Meier's error.

Meier surrendered a leadoff double to Roberts in the sixth before Jacob Naquin delivered a sacrifice fly to right field, breaking the 2-2 tie.

The teams battled back and forth as LSU regained the lead in the bottom of the sixth on the game's third lead change. The Tigers' Matt Liuzza crushed a 2-1 pitch the opposite way for his eighth homer of the season, bringing in Gill, who had singled to start the frame.

Fernandez (2-2) had set down nine straight hitters before allowing Gill to reach base in the sixth. He left the game in the sixth, allowing four runs on seven hits in 5.1 innings.

Gill delivered again in the seventh, ripping a two-run double down the right field line to give the Tigers a 6-3 lead. He finished the game with his first three-RBI contest of the season, going 2-for-4 with the double.

The Tigers put the game out of reach in the eighth with the big blow coming from Clay Harris, whose two-run single scored Holt and Matt Horwath.
