TENNESSEE COACH BILL BATTLE:

I am proud of our entire football squad, but especially of a great group of seniors who measured up athletically, scholastically and in character.. This was the kind of exciting football game that was befitting two schools ^q who enjoy the excellent relationship of Tennessee and LSU. Momentum is a crazy thing, and I can't explain what made it swing from Tennessee to LSU. We kept things under control for the first quarter and executed our offense about as well as I have seen Tennessee do. Our offensive coaches--Jim Wright, Ray Trail and Lide ^Huggins--came up with a good game plan. Maybe we tried to play it a little too conservatively in the second half. That is sort of a natural inclination with me. I felt good about things at the half, but I warned our players that we could expect LSU to make the same kind of comeback against us that Penn State did early in the season when we had a good lead over them.. Holloway ran more than he had in the past. He had a lot of opportunities to scramble and took advantage of the situation. Incidentally, our second touchdown, when Holloway carried in from the 15, was on a broken play. It was supposed to be a pitchout to the tailback, but Stanback slipped down, and Holloway scored. That showed what quickness can do for you.. I felt that Condredge's running was the difference in the game offensively."

NOTE: Tennessee receiver David Searville, not dressed out for the game, suffered a broken leg on the sideline and was taken to St. Luke's Hospital. UT Trainer reported no other injuries.

LSU COACH CHARLES McGLENDON...

You gotta admit, that was almost two separate ball games out there tonight.

I made a statement a few days ago that pride is the hallmark of a good football team and that's what you people saw out there. You saw two teams with pride, and I can't express how proud I am of this LSU team. They made up their minds that when they went out for the second half they were going to roll up their sleeves and get to work and they did that.

We came to win, don't ever think we didn't, but what we did in that second half sorta makes you appreciate what football is all about. There wasn't anybody in this stadium tonight that thought we had a chance at the end of the first half, but one group did and that was this LSU football team. They were ready and when that second half started they proved something to a lot of people, not only in this stadium, but throughout the nation watching it on TV.

That first half I never saw us miss as many tackles. I felt we had to contain Holloway and we did as far as ~~xxxxxx~~ sweeps were concerned, but he went up the middle of us. And believe me that's a fast track out there for him to run on.

We were too cautious in the first half, then we tried to throw and that got us in trouble. We decided we'd play our own game in the second half, just a run from that strong set and take the ball game right to them. We succeeded, but we ran out of time. What old clock just can't be beat.

This is ~~xxxx~~ a game of emotions and that that was what fired us into a great second half. Look at those stats. We topped them in first downs and total offense and they just nosed out in passing by a four yards. And how about that third quarter. They only had 10 yards and one first down.

I'll tell you something else. That story that we were lousy in the first half was because our kids really didn't want to play. Gentlemen, they proved they wanted to play, they proved they have pride by what they accomplished. These boys wanted to play and they showed people that.

I don't mean to take anything away from Tennessee, they have got a fine ball club. We play great football in the SEC and we like to show off our ~~xxxxxxxx~~ product to the nation.

Yes sir, if we had scored there at the end we would have gone for two points. We already had the play set up.
