**Nominee for Player of the Week**

Ryan Patterson, Sr., OF, Rowlett, Texas

Patterson enjoyed another superb week, leading LSU to a three-game SEC sweep at No. 17 Georgia. Patterson batted .545 (6-for-11) in the series with three homers, four RBI and four runs scored. He also walked three times, recording an on-base percentage of .643, and his slugging percentage was 1.364. Patterson, who is riding a 10-game hitting streak, has homered seven times in LSU's last five games. He has three two-homer games in that span, including a pair of blasts in Saturday's 5-3 victory over Georgia. In his last five games, Patterson is hitting .600 (12-for-20) with seven homers, 10 RBI and 11 runs. On the year, he is batting a team-high .423 (33-for-78) with seven doubles, nine homers, 20 RBI and 33 runs.

**Nominee for Pitcher of the Week**

Lane Mestepey, Sr., LHP, Zachary, La.

Mestepey moved into second place on the all-time LSU wins list Friday with a complete-game effort at Georgia. He earned his 34th career victory by limiting the Bulldogs to two runs on seven hits with two walks and three strikeouts. The complete game was the 16th of Mestepey's career, and he is now four wins shy of the LSU all-time wins record (38) held by Scott Schultz (1992-95).

**Notes on the Tigers**

LSU increased its win streak to six games with a three-game sweep at No. 17 Georgia ... the Tigers have won 22 of their last 23 regular-season series (dating back to the 2003 season), including the last 12 in a row ... LSU's sweep at UGA was its first SEC sweep since April of 2003, when the Tigers won three straight over Tennessee in Baton Rouge ... last weekend marked the Tigers' first SEC road sweep since March, 2003, when LSU also won three straight at Georgia ... senior outfielder Ryan Patterson batted .545 (6-for-11) in the UGA series with three homers, four RBI and four runs scored ... he also walked three times, recording an on-base percentage of .643, and his slugging percentage was 1.364 ...
