Roberts, who operated an insurance agency in Baton Rouge, began the award in 1927 and presented each year's MVP with a wristwatch, in recognition of the athlete's accomplishments. In 1965, the award was split to include an offensive and a defensive player. Wristwatches are still presented each year to the offensive and defensive most valuable players.
