COACHES QUOTES

Kentucky head coach John RAY: I felt our young men played with a great deal of enthusiasm. On the third down pass play, the receiver ~~was~~ bumped our defensive man and ~~knocked~~ him offstride and Jones just threw the ball up there for the throw touchdown. LSU got another break on the fumble recovery, but we held them and they had to kick a field goal.

LSU certainly wasn't down for us. It was a vicious, aggressive game; you should have heard the hitting from the sideline.

McKay threw well most of the time and Alvarez and Parga caught the ball well. We tried to get outside and to throw more, because we knew how tough they would be up the middle.

We designed a couple new blitzes for them and had our line jumping around a bit. Ken Fuller played well in his first start; we put him in a position where he could come free, moving him out on the tackle and moving ~~Sanieri~~ on the head of the guard. ~~right defense is strong, quick and reacts well to blocks. We had to sweep,~~

LSU's defense is strong, quick and reacts well to blocks. We had to sweep, option, run outside or pass.

We felt our players had to have this kind of game to show themselves that they are a good football team. I like to play here. I'm used to the big crowds and pageantry of major college football.

LSU COACH CHARLES McLENDON:

That last touchdown that was nullified would have dressed up the score. I don't like the way we played on offense tonight, but the big thing was that we won and that's what counts. Kentucky came up with some big defensive plays to stop us on a number of occasions.

This was our first shutout and the defense was magnificent. They were really Tigers in that second half.

We didn't play our second unit as much as we would have liked to, but we had to play without two men, fullback Ken Addy, nursing a bruised arm, and defensive tackle Tommy Bataud who is still hobbled with a leg injury. Then when Dantin twisted his knee and Rogers got a gash in his left shin, that really handicapped us, but Kadi and Davis picked up and helped us. Bert Jones got buzzed on that last pass play, but he's alright.

I want to say this when we had a second and goal from the four and tried to pass it in for the touchdown that was plain dumb coaching on my part. It was the silliest thing I have ever done and I told the squad that. I'll promise you one thing that I'll never do that again. When you're in that spot, you do what you do best, run it to them and that's what we should have done.
