



## Pair of QB's Lead To 22-21 OT Win

JaMarcus Russell started the comeback and then Marcus Randall finished it as the Tigers rallied from an eight point deficit with less than two minutes remaining to force overtime and eventually beat Oregon State, 22-21, in Tiger Stadium in the season-opener for both teams. Trailing 9-0 at halftime, Russell replaced an ineffective Randall and pulled the Tigers to within 9-7 late in the third quarter on a 16-yard TD pass to Skyler Green. OSU answered with a 9-play, 65-yard drive to extend its margin to 15-7. The score remained that way until Russell rallied the Tigers on a 4-play, 64-yard drive capped with a 38-yard TD strike to Dwayne Bowe. Russell then converted the two-point conversion to tie the score at 15-15 with more than a minute left. In overtime and with Russell out with cramps, Randall returned to the field and scored on a 5-yard run to give LSU its first lead at 22-15. OSU followed with a TD of its own, however the extra-point attempt sailed wide right, the third missed PAT for the Beavers, and the Tigers escaped with a 22-21 win. For the game, Russell completed 9-of-26 passes for 145 yards and 2 TDs, while Randall was 7of-18 for 66 yards and 1 interception. Justin Vincent led the Tigers with 48 yards rushing, while Bowe caught 5 passes for 103 yards and a score.

## **Tigers Overpower Arkansas State**

Justin Vincent rushed for 102 yards and 2 TDs and three LSU quarterbacks combined to hit on 12-of-20 passes for 210 yards and 3 scores as the Tigers rolled to a 53-3 win over Arkansas State in Tiger Stadium. LSU wasted little time in establishing itself as the dominant team as the Tigers took the opening kickoff and marched 54 yards in six plays for a 7-0 lead following a 5-yard TD run by Vincent just two minutes into the contest. The Indians fumbled the ensuing kickoff and three plays later, Marcus Randall found Corey Webster for a 6yard TD pass running the score to 13-0. From there, the rout was on as the Tigers extended their lead to 23-0 after the first quarter and 37-0 at halftime. Arkansas State got on the board midway through the third quarter with a 34yard field goal. LSU responded with a pair of touchdowns in a 3-minute span to stretch the lead to 50-3. Ryan Gaudet added a 33-yard field goal in the fourth quarter for the final margin. For the game, the Tigers limited ASU to just 54 yards rushing and only 201 yards of offense. JaMarcus Russell led all LSU quarterbacks by connecting on 7-of-11 passes for 151 yards and 2 TDs, while Randall hit on 5-of-7 for 59 yards and one score. Craig Davis led the Tigers with 4 catches for 73 yards, while Dwayne Bowe caught a pair of TD passes.

## Auburn Scores Late to Hand LSU a Defeat

Jason Campbell connected with Courtney Taylor on a 16-yard TD pass with just more than a minute left to lift 14th-ranked Auburn to a 10-9 win over No. 4 LSU. The victory by Auburn snapped LSU's 10-game winning streak, one that dated back to a 33-7 win over South Carolina last October. The Auburn TD capped a contest that saw the LSU defense hold Auburn in check, limiting the Tigers to just 301 yards of offense, including only 131 yards on the ground. The LSU defense held Auburn's running back tandem of Carnell Williams (75 yards) and Ronnie Brown (67 yards) to 142 combined yards, 70 yards below their season average. LSU appeared to be in good shape early in the contest, taking the opening kickoff and marching 80 yards on 14 plays for a 6-0 lead following a Marcus Randall 9-yard TD pass to Dwayne Bowe. LSU's Ryan Gaudet pushed the PAT wide right, a point that would come back to haunt LSU. Auburn responded with a 14-play drive of its own that ended with a field goal. LSU, with JaMarcus Russell at QB, answered right back, going 55 yards on eight plays, capped with a 42-yard Chris Jackson field goal. That's all the scoring either team would get until the final minutes of the contest. LSU did have its chances in the second half, getting inside the Auburn 35-yard line twice, but the Tigers failed to capitalize on the opportunity. Alley Broussard led all running back with 84 yards on 10 carries, while Randall and Russell combined to hit on 12-of-28 passes for 168 yards and a TD.

## **Tigers Score Early and Often**

Alley Broussard scored a career-best 3 TDs, all in the first 17 minutes of the game, as the Tigers racked up 599 yards of offense in rolling to a 51-0 win over Mississippi State in Tiger Stadium. LSU set the tone early in the contest going 74 yards on seven plays, five of which were runs, for a 7-0 lead just three minutes into the game. Following a MSU fumble on its first possession, the Tigers needed only six plays to go 18 yards for a 14-0 lead midway through the first quarter. From there, the rout was on as the Tigers built a 27-0 lead early in the second quarter following a 35yard interception return for a TD by Marcus Spears. LSU led 34-0 at halftime. In the second half, the Tigers stretched the margin to 41-0 on an 8yard run by QB JaMarcus Russell and then 48-0 on a 67-yard TD reception by Xavier Carter. For the contest, LSU picked up 31 first downs, while limiting MSU to just 7. LSU also held MSU to only 130 yards of offense, while intercepting a season-high 4 passes. The 51-point margin of victory was the biggest by LSU in an SEC game since a 61-6 win over Mississippi State in 1969. It was also LSU's first shutout since a 42-0 win over Mississippi State in 2001.



## Greene Passes Georgia Past LSU

David Greene threw five touchdown passes as third-ranked Georgia, behind a pair of first half LSU turnovers, raced out to a 24-0 lead midway through the second quarter and never looked back in a 45-16 win over the Tigers in Athens. Trailing 24-0, LSU mounted a rally that pulled the Tigers to within 24-10 at halftime. First, JaMarcus Russell guided the Tigers on a 7-play, 80-yard drive, capped with an 18-yard TD strike to Dwayne Bowe with 1:23 left before halftime. After holding Georgia to three plays and out on its next series, the Tigers quickly moved 24 yards in two plays setting up a 31-yard field goal by Chris Jackson as time expired in the first half pulling LSU to within 24-10. With an apparent momentum swing towards LSU, the Tigers got the ball to start the second half and moved all the way to the UGA 34-yard line before the drive stalled out. From there, LSU could muster little offense as the Bulldogs stretched their lead to 31-10 at the 5:12 mark on a Greene-to-Fred Gibson pass. LSU wouldn't get any closer the rest of the way. The Tigers did close the contest with an 8-play, 80-yard TD drive engineered by QB Marcus Randall. For the contest, LSU managed only 314 yards of offense, compared to 430 for the Bulldogs. Russell led LSU by hitting on 9-of-17 passes for 131 yards and 1 TD, while Alley Broussard rushed for 45 yards in his first career start.

## Randall, Addai Lead Tigers Past Florida

Marcus Randall came off the bench to rally LSU from a 14-0 first quarter deficit to beat 12th-ranked Florida, 24-21, in Gainesville. Down 21-17 with just over two minutes left in the contest, Randall guided the Tigers on a 6-play, 50-yard drive, capped with a 10-yard scoring pass to Joseph Addai, for the come-from-behind win for the Tigers. Trailing 14-0 following a pair of first quarter interceptions that led to Florida scoring drives of 5 and 3-yards, Randall took over for an injured JaMarcus Russell. Randall pulled the Tigers to within 21-14 at halftime after engineering a pair of 80-yard scoring drives. Alley Broussard got the Tigers to within 14-7 on a 1-yard plunge early in the second quarter. Florida extended its lead to 21-7 with just over a minute left in the first half, before Randall engineered a 7-play, 80-yard drive, capped with a 15-yard TD pass to Early Doucet with 12 seconds left in the first half. Chris Jackson kicked a 47-yard field goal in the third quarter to get the Tigers to within 21-17 before a fourth quarter defensive struggle paved the way for LSU's last-minute comeback against the Gators. For the game, Randall connected on 18-of-27 passes for 198 and 2 TDs, while Addai led the Tigers with 93 yards rushing. Addai also caught 4 passes for 26 yards, including the game-winner. Offensively, the Tigers put up 464 yards (210 rushing, 254 passing) compared to just 236 (94 rushing, 142 passing) for the Gators.

## Randall's Fourth Quarter Heroics Lift Tigers

Marcus Randall hit David Jones with a 30-yard TD pass with just over two minutes left, lifting LSU to a 24-20 come-from-behind win over Troy in Tiger Stadium. The Randall-to-Jones TD marked the third time this year that LSU has come from behind in the fourth quarter to win a game. The game-winning TD came less than two minutes after Troy had taken a 20-17 lead on a 24-yard FG by Greg Whibbs. LSU's Xavier Carter setup the Tigers' game-winning scoring drive with a 37-yard kickoff return to the LSU 47-yard line. LSU appeared to have picked up where they left off against Florida, taking the opening kickoff and going 79 yards on nine plays for the game's first points, a 1-yard run by Alley Broussard. However, three first half turnovers by the Tigers kept Troy in the game as the Trojans had to only go 20 yards for their first TD and then went backwards a yard for a FG following another LSU turnover. Despite the first half miscues, LSU led 17-10 at halftime. Troy tied the game at 17-17 midway through the third quarter after another LSU turnover resulted in a just a 2-play, 2yard scoring drive for the Trojans. The score remained that way until Whibbs' go-ahead field goal late in the fourth quarter. Randall led the Tigers by connecting on 24-of-37 passes for a career-best 328 yards and 1 TD. Defensively, Marcus Spears had 9 tackles, including 6 for losses and a pair of sacks as LSU limited Troy to only 150 yards of offense.

## Tigers Defense Comes Up Big with Win

Skyler Green returned a punt 65 yards for a touchdown and the LSU defense held Vanderbilt scoreless in the second half as the Tigers won their third straight with a 24-7 victory over the Commodores. Outside of a 13-play, 83-yard drive late in the second quarter, the Vanderbilt offense did very little against the Tigers as LSU held the Commodores to 289 yards of offense and just 15 first downs. The Tigers lead 3-0 after the first quarter on a 26-yard Ryan Gaudet field goal and then increased the margin to 10-0 on a 1-yard run by **Alley Broussard** in the second quarter. Vanderbilt cut the lead to 10-7 just before halftime on a 1-yard run by Jay Cutler. The Tigers stretched their lead to 17-7 by taking the second half kickoff and going 81 yards on six plays, capped with a Marcus Randall 34-yard TD pass to Craig Davis. Green capped the LSU scoring with a 65-yard punt return for a TD midway through the third quarter. For the game, Broussard led the Tigers with 80 yards rushing on 9 carries, while Joseph Addai added 77 yards on 14 attempts and Randall 68 yards on eight carries. Randall led the Tigers through the air by completing 4-of-6 passes for 78 yards and 1 TD, while JaMarcus Russell hit on 2-of-5 passes for 24 yards.

## Tiger Defense, Running Game Beat Bama

LSU's defense scored for the third time in 2004 and the Tigers rushed for 192 yards against the nation's No. 1 rated defense in the 26-10 win over Alabama. Trailing 10-6 at halftime, DE Marcus Spears sacked Spencer Pennington deep in Alabama territory forcing a fumble that LB Cameron Vaughn picked up and ran 8 yards for the go-ahead score. Leading 13-10, the Tigers increased the margin to 20-10 on a 35-yard TD pass from JaMarcus Russell to Joseph Addai with 9:38 left in the contest. Addai capped the scoring with a 47-yard run with just over four minutes left in the contest. In what was projected as a defensive battle, the Tigers got the upper hand, holding the Crimson Tide to just 196 yards of offense, which included just 82 yards on the ground. The Tigers also intercepted a pass in the game, that coming by Corey Webster in the endzone that thwarted an Alabama drive that could have put the Crimson Tide up 11 early in the third quarter. Instead, Webster returned the interception 44 yards, switching both the momentum of the game as well as the field position into LSU's favor. For the game, Addai led the Tigers with 99 yards rushing, while Alley Broussard added 84 yards for LSU. Defensively, Spears paced a Tiger attack with 8 tackles, 2 sacks, 2 QB hurries and a forced fumble.



## **Broussard and Tigers Run Past Ole Miss**

Alley Broussard rushed for an LSU record 250 yards and 3 TDs, while Joseph Addai added a career-best 107 yards on the ground as the Tigers overcame another fourth quarter deficit to beat Ole Miss, 27-24. Trailing 24-20 early in the third quarter, Broussard and Addai went to work, combining for all 61 yards during LSU's game-winning drive, which was capped on a 7-yard TD run by Broussard with 10:51 left in the contest. The Tiger defense then kept Ole Miss in check, holding the Rebels to a three-and-out and on its next possession, followed by two series that were stopped by Jessie Daniels' interceptions in the final four minutes of the contest. LSU jumped out to a 14-3 lead in the first quarter on a pair of 1-yard TD runs by Broussard. Ole Miss pulled to within 17-16 on a 22-yard FG as time expired in the first half. The Rebels then grabbed their only lead of the game, 24-17, on a 48-yard interception return early in the third quarter. PK Chris Jackson pulled LSU to within 24-20 on 51-yard FG as time expired in the third quarter setting up the fourth quarter comeback for the Tigers. For the game, LSU held the Rebels to only 254 yards of offense, including just three first downs and 35 yards in the second half. LSU racked up 441 yards of offense - 360 on the ground and 81 through the



## Randall Runs and Passes LSU Past Hogs

Marcus Randall accounted for 4 touchdowns (2 rushing, 2 passing) as the Tigers rolled up 468 yards of offense in a 43-14 win over Arkansas in War Memorial Stadium in Little Rock. The win was the sixth straight for the Tigers and it snapped Arkansas' 17-game winning streak in Little Rock. Starting for the first time since the Troy game, Randall connected on 10of-14 passes for 173 yards and 2 scores and added another 79 yards rushing and 2 TDs in the Tiger win. Randall threw first half scoring passes of 20 and 29 yards to Joseph Addai before scoring on a 1-yard run just before half to give the Tigers a 27-14 lead at intermission. Randall extended the margin to 34-14 early in the third quarter with a 7-yard run. Chris Jackson added a 47-yard field goal and Shyrone Carey scored on a 9-yard run to cap the scoring for the Tigers. In all, LSU rolled up 25 first downs to Arkansas' 15, while the Tiger defensive held Razorback quarterback Matt Jones to minus-10 yards rushing and only 12-of-29 passing with 2 interceptions. Alley Broussard led the Tiger rushing attack with 81 yards, while Craig Davis caught 5 passes for 70 yards. Marcus Spears keyed an LSU defense with 9 tackles and 2 sacks.

## Iowa Scores Last-Second TD To Beat LSU, 30-25

The Nick Saban era at LSU came to an end in dramatic fashion as 11thranked Iowa scored on a 56-yard pass as time expired to beat the 12thranked Tigers, 30-25, in the Capital One Bowl in Orlando. The last-second play erased what would have been a tremendous fourth-quarter comeback win for the Tigers as LSU erased a 12-point deficit over the final eight minutes of the contest to take a 25-24 lead with just 46 seconds remaining. Inserted into the game early in the final quarter, JaMarcus Russell led the Tigers on a pair of TD drives, the second coming on a 3-yard pass to Skyler Green that put the Tigers up for the only time in the game, 25-24. However, the Hawkeyes responded with a 3-play, 71-yard drive, capped on a 56-yard pass from **Drew Tate** to **Warren Holloway** to record the dramatic finish. The game's final play overshadowed a pair of outstanding performances by LSU's Russell and running back Alley Broussard. Playing in only the fourth quarter, Russell connected on 12-of-15 passes for 128 yards and a pair of touchdowns. Broussard rushed for a game-high 109 yards, which included a 74-yard TD run just before halftime to bring the Tigers to within 14-12 at the break. Dwayne Bowe led all Tiger receivers with 8 catches for 122 yards, while Skyler Green had 6 receptions for 59 yards and a pair of scores, both of which came in the fourth quarter.
