


• 2002 Southeastern Conference All-Freshman Team (Coaches)

All-purpose running back who ranks second on the squad in rushing and third on the team in receiving ... Played in all 11 games in 2004 ... Rushed 90 times for 653 yards and 3 TDs and caught 22 passes for 280 yards and 4 scores ... The 4 receiving TDs were the most by an LSU running back since 1989 when Eddie Fuller caught 9 TD passes ... The 22 receptions and 280 receiving yards were the most for an LSU running back since Kevin Faulk had 22 catches for 287 yards in 1998 ... Rushed for a career-best 109 yards, including a 53-yard run, in win over Ole Miss ... A week earlier, had 99 yards rushing and 1 TD in 26-10 victory over Alabama ... Rushed for 90 or more yards 4 times in 2004 ... Had 95 yards and 1 TD in win over Arkansas State and then added 93 yards in road victory against Florida ... Scored game-winning TD with less than a minute remaining against Florida on a 10-yard catch-and-run ... Had a pair of receiving TDs in win over Arkansas... Scored on a 35-yard reception against Alabama ... Had one rushing TD against Arkansas State, Troy and Alabama ... Considered the best of LSU's running backs on third-down situations due to his blocking ability and passing catching skills.



Talented redshirt freshman who played in 8 games with 6 starts in 2004 ... Named First-Team Freshman All-America by the Sporting News and Second-Team All-America by Rivals.com ... Member of the Freshman All-SEC Team as selected by the league's coaches ... Started season-opener vs. Oregon State at right guard, but then missed the next 2 games with a knee injury ... Returned to action in a starting role, this time at left guard, against Mississippi State in the first of 4 straight starts ... Played backup role in wins over Alabama and Ole Miss before resuming his starting role at left guard against Arkansas ... In 9 games, recorded 13 knockdown blocks and 4 pancakes.



Tremendous talent who ranks second on the squad in receving ... Played in all 11 games in 2004 with 9 starts ... Started first 9 games of season ... Caught 31 passes for 475 yards and a team-best 5 TDs ... The 5 receiving touchdowns ranks among the top 10 in the SEC ... Opened season with 5 receptions for 103 yards and 1 score in overtime win over Oregon State ... His 38-yard TD reception vs. Oregon State came with just over a minute left in the fourth quarter and helped send the contest into overtime ... Followed that with 2 TD receptions vs. Arkansas State and then added another scoring reception against Auburn ... Scored fifth TD of season vs. Georgia ... Hass't had a receiving TD since the Georgia game on Oct. 2 ... Caught at least 1 pass in each game in 2004 except for the Vanderbilt game.



A four-time NCAA Champion and 10-time All-America in track and field, he finished eighth in the 400-meters at the Olympics back in August with a clocking of 49.51 seconds ... Returned the gridiron a week later and saw action against Oregon State in a backup role ... Played in 9 games for the Tigers ... Caught only pass of season vs. Mississippi State, a 20-yard reception ... Had 5 tackles on special teams kick coverage for

the Tigers ... In three years as a member of the LSU track and field team, has been a part of three national champion relay teams - the 4x400 in 2003 and the 4x100 in 2002 and 2003 ... Runner-up in the 400-meter hurdles at the NCAA Outdoor Meet in 2004 ... Placed fourth in the 400-meter hurdles at the 2003 NCAA meet to help the Tigers to a fourth place national finish at the event ... Member of LSU's national champion outdoor track and field team in 2002 and LSU's national champion indoor team in 2004.


2004 SEC Offensive Player of the Week (vs. Ole Miss)

LSU's starting running back ... Powerful runner who also has breakup speed ... Played in all 11 games with 7 starts ... Leads the team in rushing with 758 yards and 9 TDs on 129 carries ... Rushed for a school-record 250 yards and 3 TDs in win over Ole Miss on Nov. 20 ... Named SEC Offensive Player of the Week for his performance against Ole Miss ... In addition, Collegefootballnews.com called his 250 rushing yards against the Rebels as the performance of the year in the SEC ... Assumed the starting role at running back against Georgia and never relinquished the role ... Rushed for at least 80 yards five times, including the final 4 games of the regular season Had 80 yards and 1 TD vs. Vanderbilt, 84 yards vs. Alabama and capped the regular-season with 81 yards against Arkansas ... Added an 84-yard effort in road loss to Auburn ... Rushed for 73 yards and 3 scores in win over Mississippi State ... The 9 TDs ranks as third-highest total in SEC in 2004, trailing only Auburn's Cadillac Williams (12) and Florida's Ciatrick Fason (10).
