RICE DRESSING ROOM....at LSU on Oct 2, 1971

COACH BILL PETERSON -- "It was too much LSU and not enough Rice. They had a better football team than we did, a fine team that executes well and has great running backs...Our kids learned a lot tonight...We just have to get our program in and know what it is to win...The LSU defense had quickness....We could never get anything established, and you have to do that to get something going. We'd fumble or get intercepted or get a penalty....Our punt coverage had been good until tonight when it was terrible, but credit LSU backs for fine speed and ability on their returns.

(asked to compare this LSU team to last one when he was an aide here)
"I guess ~~about~~ about the same in overall ability as that one in 1959, but that club had a great defense, and this one has a better offense...those are strong running backs....LSU could go well against anybody... No doubt the absence of Barnes hurt us because he's bigger and stronger and more experienced than the soph (Hollas) we had in there...But Hollas did a good job and played hard.

Rice lost senior fullback Mike Phillips for the season with a broken arm... his ~~par~~ parents now live in Baton Rouge, though he went to high school at Wichita Falls, Texas....Grounds and Lee had minor hurts, but nothing believed serious.

LSU DRESSING ROOM....COACH MCCLENDON

We tried to play both quarterbacks split down the middle more than we have and I think we did it. With Nagle and Casanova out of there our young defensive backs did a fine job. They really rose to the occasion. 2

Shoemaker ~~was~~ ran with quite a bit of class. Miller also ran with authority. I was happy I had a chance to play some of these boys who hadn't really been able to get in much playing time. And we might not get too many chances the rest of the season, so this was timely for us.

I felt the Tigers really came to play tonight and I was particularly impressed with our defense. We had the best coverage of the year on kickoffs. In fact we looked like LSU of old.

I tried to play everybody since you have to have depth to win and we needed to give these youngsters game experience.

Norm Hodgins sprained an ankle Wednesday and it was almost a miracle that he was able to play, but he really did have a game.

We were able to have lots of success with our quick dive plays. Rice missed Rodrigo Barnes, their great middle linebacker and we were able to have success up the middle.
