## FLORIDA VS. LSU POST-GAME NOTES

### SERIES NOTES

- With Florida's win in the 37th meeting between the two schools, LSU lead in the all-time series now stands at 18-16-3, including a 8-7-3 margin in Gainesville. In annual meetings since 1971, the series now stands even at 9-9-2.
- LSU's Mike Archer is now 1-3 vs. Florida.
- Florida has now won three consecutive games vs. LSU

### TV NOTES

- After being 0-5 on national TV in 1989 (0-2 WTBS Sports, 0-2 ESPN and 0-1 NBC), Florida is now 3-0 on national TV. Earlier, UF defeated Alabama and Mississippi State on WTBS Sports.
- With today's appearance on ESPN, Florida has 22 national TV appearances in its last 41 games, including three of five games in 1990.
- Also with today's TV appearance, Florida has appeared on national TV in 19 of its last 34 games.
- Today was only the second win for the Gators in nine appearances on the ESPN network
- As announced earlier, the Florida-Tennessee game next week will also be televised nationally by ESPN. Game time is set for 7:30 pm EST.

### TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Florida's 5-0 start is their best since their 1988 mark of 5-0. Incidentally, their fifth win that year was also a victory against LSU (19-6). The last time a Gator team got off to a 6-0 start was in 1969
- The Florida special teams blocked their fourth kick of the year when Jerry Odom got his hands on a Brian Griffith punt in the first quarter. The Gators have blocked three punts (Oklahoma State, Alabama and LSU) and one field goal (Oklahoma State). The special teams pressured Griffith to fumble on another punt attempt in the second quarter that led to a Florida TD.
- Kirk Kirkpatrick's 10-yard TD reception in the first quarter broke a string of 14-straight quarters without a TD pass by a Gator offense against the LSU defense. The previous TD by UF against the Tigers came in the second quarter of the 1986 game when Anthony Williams was on the receiving end of an 8-yard Kerwin Bell TD toss.
- Kirkpatrick finished the day with five catches, giving him 24 catches on the year after having just 18 a year ago. He has also surpassed the top receiver totals from the 1989 season as Emmitt Smith had just 21 catches for the 1989 season. His 42-yard reception was a new career long.
- Both defensive squads dominated the first quarter of action. The Gators' D allowed just one first down and 45 yards in total offense (23 rushing, 22 passing). The Gators defense has not surrendered a first quarter TD all season. The Tigers' defense shut down the Gators offense, allowing just three first downs and 49 total yards (eight yards rushing, 41 passing).
- The Gator defense did not allow a TD in the game and have now given up just three TDs in the first five games of the season (none on the ground). On the year, the Gator defense has surrendered just 38 points for an average of 7.6 ppg. Mississippi State scored twice on fumble recoveries and LSU scored two points after returning a blocked PAT for a conversion of their own.
- With Scott Wharton's blocked PAT in the first quarter, UF kicker Arden Czyzewski snapped his perfect PAT streak. He had hit his first 24 in his career.

\* With his 0.5 QBS today, defensive end Huey Richardson now has 25.5 QBS for his career, a total that is second only to Alonzo Johnson's 27. He also has 45.5 career tackles for lost yardage in his career, the fourth top total in that category in school history. Wilber Marshall ranks atop the chart with 58. Clifford Charlton is third with 49.

\* The Florida offense scored a total of five TDs today against the LSU defense today. LSU had allowed just two TDs to Florida's offense in the last three years (both were rushing TDs by former All-America Emmit Smith - the Gators scored on other TD on a 1988 int return by Richard Fain).

\* With its three TD passes today, Florida has now thrown for 11 TDs in the first five games of the season. During the entire 1989 season, it threw for 10.

\* Prior to UF's three TD passes today, LSU had surrendered only two total passing TDs on the year in four previous games.

\* Richard Fain's interception in the second quarter was the fifth of his career against the Tigers and the ninth overall, the fourth highest total in Gator history. The int was also the first LSU errant throw in 79 passes this year and 83 dating back to last season.

\* Florida has outscored its opponents 85-23 in the second half this season.

\* Florida has won 42 of its last 47 regular season games in which a Gator running back has gained over 100 yards.

\* Emmitt Rhett's 100-yard performance was the second of the year for the freshman. He finished the day with 15 carries and 105 yards. He has lead the Gators in rushing in each of the first five games. His 49-yard dash in the fourth quarter was the longest run from scrimmage by a Gator this year.

\* Ernie Mills' two TDs marked the first time in his career his collected two TD receptions in one game.

\* In the first five games, opponents have penetrated Florida's 20-yard line just nine times, yielding just five scores (2 TD, 3 FG).

\* Florida has held four of its five opponents under 100 yards rushing this season.

#### ATTENDANCE NOTES

\* The attendance of 75,039 is the fourth highest total at Florida Field. 75,428 attended the season opener vs. Oklahoma State to kick off the Steve Spurrier era.

\* Florida has now drawn home crowds of more than 70,000 in 34 of the past 37 games at Florida Field. Crowds of over 73,000-plus have been present in 23 of the last 34 home games.

#### BEN HILL GRIFFIN STADIUM AT FLORIDA FIELD NOTES

\* The Gators have now posted a 47-9-2 record at Florida Field since the start of the 1981 season (.828).

\* The Gators are 38-8-2 at home over the past 48 games (.830)

\* The Gators are 19-5-1 vs. SEC opponents at Florida Field since the start of the 1981 season.
