Tigers Play Regular-Season Home Finale Versus Southeastern Louisiana

Fourth-ranked LSU plays its final regular-season home game at 6:30 p.m. Wednesday as the Tigers face Southeastern Louisiana in Alex Box Stadium.

The game can be heard on the LSU Sports Radio Network, including flagship WDGL-FM 98.1 in Baton Rouge. The radio broadcast and live stats may be also be accessed at www.LSUsports.net.

Wednesday's LSU-SLU matchup is a make-up game for the March 14 contest between the clubs that was rained out.

LSU and SLU have met three times this season, with the Tigers winning all three games. LSU defeated the Lions by scores of 7-1 and 5-1 on March 12-13 in Alex Box Stadium, and the Tigers posted a 9-3 victory over SLU on April 14 at Zephyr Field in Metairie, La.

LSU coach Smoke Laval will send freshman right-hander Michael Bonura (3-0, 4.71 ERA) to the mound Wednesday. Bonura will make his first start since he faced SLU at Zephyr Field on April 14. He worked four innings in that contest, allowing three runs on four hits with three walks and three strikeouts.

SLU coach Dan Canevari will counter with senior left-hander Mark Weinmunson (2-4, 8.05 ERA) on Wednesday. Canevari, a member of the LSU staff from 1991-2002, helped lead the Tigers to all five of their NCAA championships under former coach Skip Bertman.

LSU concludes the regular season this weekend with a three-game SEC series at Ole Miss. The Tigers enter the final weekend of regular season play one game behind the first-place Rebels (17-10) and Arkansas (17-10) in the SEC Western Division. Arkansas plays host this weekend to Auburn (11-16).

Georgia (17-10), the first-place team in the SEC Eastern Division, holds a one-game lead over South Carolina (16-11) and Florida (16-11), and the Bulldogs are tied with Ole Miss and Arkansas in the overall league standings. Georgia plays host to South Carolina this weekend, while Florida travels to Tennessee (12-15).

The LSU-Southeastern Louisiana Series

LSU leads the all-time series with SLU, 52-16, and the Tigers have won 25 of the 27 meetings between the clubs since 1990; SLU's only wins in that span came in 1991 (15-2) and 2002 (4-3), both in Alex Box Stadium.

Laval is 16-5 against the Lions during his 10-year collegiate coaching career, including a 6-1 mark as LSU's coach.

The Tigers enter the Wednesday's game with a 12-1 mark this season against Louisiana schools. LSU has won 15 of 16 games versus its in-state foes over the past two seasons.

LSU has a 40-9 record against Louisiana schools during Laval's three-year tenure as head coach.

Highlights from LSU's Series Win vs. Vanderbilt Last Weekend

- LSU recorded its eighth SEC series victory in nine attempts last weekend as the Tigers won two of three games versus Vanderbilt. LSU has won 11 of its last 12 conference series, dating back to last season.

- Right fielder Jon Zeringue enjoyed another productive weekend at the plate, batting .462 (6-for-13) against Vanderbilt with two doubles, two RBI and one run. Zeringue is hitting .536 (15-for-28) in his last six SEC games with two doubles, five RBI and five runs. The junior from Thibodaux, La., is now hitting .462 (48-for-127) in conference games, and he has raised his cumulative average to .422 (84-for-199) with 18 doubles, 11 homers and 47 RBI.

- Zeringue has an opportunity to set the LSU single-season record for highest batting average, a mark established by Russ Johnson, who hit .410 in 1994.

- Left-hander Jason Determann was magnificent in relief in Saturday's Game 2 victory, limiting Vanderbilt to two runs on five hits in seven innings with two walks and three strikeouts, as LSU posted a 7-6, 11-inning victory.

- Left-hander Lane Mestepey, making his first weekend start since March 20 at South Carolina, pitched very effectively in Game 1, allowing just one run on seven hits in 6.1 innings with three walks and one strikeout.

- Right-hander Jordan Faircloth relieved Mestepey in the seventh and pitched the final 3.2 innings to win the 3-2, 10-inning contest. Faircloth allowed one run on three hits with no walks and three strikeouts.

- LSU has won six of its nine extra-inning games this season, and the Tigers improved their record to 7-4 in one-run contests.

Jon Zeringue Named to Golden Spikes Award Watch List

LSU outfielder Jon Zeringue is one of 30 players appearing on the 2004 Golden Spikes Award "Watch List." The Golden Spikes Award is presented annually by USA Baseball to the nation's outstanding amateur player.

USA Baseball will announce its five finalists for the award in June. Former LSU pitcher Ben McDonald was the 1989 Golden Spikes Award recipient.

Zeringue is also one of 30 semifinalists for the DickHowser Trophy, given to the top player in collegiate baseball by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association and the St. Petersburg (Fla.) Area Chamber of Commerce. The 2004 winner will be announced on June 18 at the College World Series in Omaha, Neb.

Former LSU first baseman Eddy Furniss received the Dick Howser Trophy in 1998.

Zeringue, a junior from Thibodaux, La., leads the Southeastern Conference in hitting with a .422 (84-for-199) batting average. He is also ranked No. 1 in the SEC in on-base percentage (.479), No. 2 in slugging percentage (.704), No. 2 in total bases (131), No. 2 in hits (78), No. 6 in doubles (16), No. 7 in runs scored (49), No. 10 in home runs (11) and No. 12 in RBI (45).

Zeringue is batting a remarkable .462 (48-for-104) in SEC games only with five doubles, one triple, seven homers, 25 RBI and 27 runs.

LSU has had one Golden Spikes Award winner in his history -- right-handed pitcher Ben McDonald captured the award in 1989, the year he was the nation's No. 1 overall draft pick by the Baltimore Orioles.

Nick Stavinocha Named LSWA Player of the Week May 11

Designated hitter Nick Stavinocha was named Louisiana Sportswriters Player of the Week on May 11, as he helped lead the Tigers to a series win at Kentucky. Stavinocha hit .583 (7-for-12) in three games with one double, one homer, four runs and four RBI. He recorded a .917 slugging percentage and a .643 on-base percentage in the series.

Stavinocha's two-run homer on May 8 at UK highlighted a three-run eighth inning to break an 8-8 tie and propel the Tigers to an 11-8 win.

Stavinocha has been one of LSU's hottest hitter in recent games, batting .476 (10-for-21) in his last five contests with two doubles, one homer, three RBI and six runs.

Clay Harris Named SEC Player of the Week April 5

LSU first baseman Clay Harris, who led LSU to a series victory at Auburn April 2-4, was named SEC Player of the Week by the league office on April 5.

Harris enjoyed a superb week, batting .467 (7-for-15) in four games with three homers, one double, eight RBI, six runs, a 1.133 slugging percentage and a .500 on-base percentage. Harris hit .455 (5-for-11) in the Auburn series with two homers, one double, seven RBI, three runs, a 1.091 slugging percentage and a .462 on-base percentage.

Harris, who led LSU in home runs last season with 16, entered the week with just one this season; however, he homered in three straight games to raise his total to four.

His solo shot at UNO on March 30 broke a 23-game drought without a homer. Harris hit a two-out, two-run blast in the top of the ninth inning April 2 at Auburn to send the game to extra innings, and his eighth-inning solo homer April 3 at Auburn tied the contest at 3-3 as LSU went on to a 5-3 win.

Harris broke a scoreless tie on April 4 at Auburn with a seventh-inning RBI single, sparking the Tigers to a 3-2 victory.

Matt Liuzza Named to Johnny Bench Award Watch List

LSU catcher **Matt Liuzza**, a sophomore from Metairie, La., was named March 22 as the SEC Player of the Week after leading the Tigers to a series victory at South Carolina.

Liuzza hit three homers and one double in the series, collecting five RBI and posting a .933 slugging percentage. He hit two homers in Game 3 (a 12-7 victory), becoming the first LSU player to have a multi-homer game this season.

Liuzza's two homers came against USC ace Matt Campbell, who had not allowed run in 27.2 innings entering the game. Liuzza hit a solo shot in the second inning to tie the game at 1-1, and his three-run blast in the fourth gave the Tigers a 4-1 lead they would never relinquish.

Liuzza was 6-for-15 (.353) at the plate in LSU's four games from March 16-21 -- including a 14-0 victory over UNO -- with one double, four homers, seven RBI and five runs.

Liuzza compiled a 14-game streak -- the longest of his career -- from Feb. 14-March 12, exceeding the 12-game streak he compiled during the 2003 season. During the 2004 streak, Liuzza batted .407 (22-for-54) with five doubles, two homers, 13 RBI and 10 runs.

Liuzza's name appears on the Johnny Bench Award "Watch List" released in early March. The Johnny Bench Award is given annually to the nation's outstanding collegiate catcher. Former LSU Brad Cresse was the first recipient of the award in 2000.

The 2004 Johnny Bench Award ceremony will take place on June 30, in Wichita, Kan.

Dirks Named To Roger Clemens Award Watch List

Freshman left-hander **Clay Dirks'** name has been added to the "Watch List" for the 2004 Roger Clemens Award, which is given to the nation's outstanding collegiate pitcher. The "Cy Young Award" of college baseball, the Clemens Award ceremony will take place on July 15 in Houston.

In a four-hit shutout of Tulane on March 2, Dirks allowed just two Green Wave runners to reach second base, and he retired 20 of the final 22 batters he faced. For that effort, Dirks was named the SEC Pitcher of the Week by the league office, and he earned National Pitcher of the Week recognition from the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association.

Dirks, a redshirt freshman from Hernando, Miss., allowed just one double and three singles against Tulane, and recorded one walk and seven strikeouts. Dirks, who was making just the third start of his collegiate career, missed the 2003 season after undergoing surgery on his elbow in the summer of 2002.

The LSU Injury Report

INF Bryan Harris -- Harris, a transfer from Santa Ana (Calif.) College, was projected to be the Tigers' starter at third base; however, a hernia operation limited his participation during fall practice, and he underwent arthroscopic surgery in January to remove bone chips from his right knee. He is scheduled to receive a medical redshirt this season.

RHP Brandon Nall -- LSU's closer at the beginning of 2003, he pitched in just six games last season before suffering a torn labrum in his shoulder, which required surgery. He could return to the mound at some point this season, depending upon the progress of his rehabilitation.

OF Quinn Stewart -- A starter in 37 games last season, Stewart had the hamate bone in his left wrist removed in early March, and he will receive a redshirt this season. Even without the wrist injury, Stewart likely would have received a redshirt this year due to the tremendous depth LSU has in the outfield. With current starting outfielders Jon Zeringue, J.C. Holt and Ryan Patterson expected to be drafted this June, Stewart should be one of the outfield starters in 2005.

Smoke Laval

HEAD COACH • THIRD YEAR

Raymond "Smoke" Laval enhanced his reputation as one of the country's top college baseball coaches, as, in just his second season at the helm of the LSU program, he guided the 2003 Tigers to the Southeastern Conference title -- LSU's first since 1997 -- and a berth in the College World Series.

Laval, the 2003 SEC Coach of the Year, directed LSU to a 45-22-1 overall record and a 20-9-1 conference mark, as the Tigers finished No. 5 in the final Baseball America rankings.

The magnificent '03 campaign augmented the success Laval enjoyed in his inaugural season as LSU's coach, as he led the 2002 Tigers to a 44-22 overall mark, an appearance in the NCAA Super Regional and a No. 11 final national ranking.

Laval, who served seven seasons (1994-2000) as the head coach at the University of Louisiana-Monroe, assumed control of the LSU program from Bertman, who led the Tigers to five NCAA championships and 11 College World Series appearances during an 18-year (1984-2001) tenure. Laval worked as Bertman's top assistant coach for 10 seasons (1984-93), helping lead LSU to its first two NCAA titles in 1991 and 1993. During Laval's 10 years as assistant coach, LSU posted a 483-182-1 record, won five SEC titles, appeared in six College World Series and captured two national championships.

Laval was known at LSU as one of the nation's best recruiters and brightest assistant coaches, as the Tigers reached the College World Series in only the third season (1986) of the Bertman-Laval regime. LSU followed the '86 CWS appearance with Omaha berths in 1987, 1989 and 1990 before the Tigers claimed the school's first baseball national title in 1991. After LSU captured its second NCAA crown in 1993, Laval departed Baton Rouge to become the head coach at Northeast Louisiana (now Louisiana-Monroe).

During his assistant coaching tenure at LSU, Laval -- who worked as the Tigers' primary recruiter - tutored 24 players who would eventually reach the major leagues. Some of the major leaguers with whom Laval worked include all-stars Albert Belle and Paul Byrd and first-round pick Todd Walker.

Laval compiled a 241-159 (.603) mark as the head coach at ULM, guiding the Indians to NCAA Regional appearances in 1995, 1999 and 2000.

Laval began his coaching career in 1977 as an assistant at Jacksonville University before moving to Wolfson High School in Jacksonville as a baseball and football coach. He served as a graduate assistant at LSU in 1979 under former Tiger head coach Jack Lamabe before working two years as an assistant at Gulf Coast Community College in Panama City, Fla.

Laval served as an assistant coach at Florida for two seasons (1982-83) before returning to LSU to work under Bertman.

Laval holds a bachelor's degree (1977) from Jacksonville in physical education and a master's degree (1979) from LSU in administration. The McDonald, Pa., native played two seasons at Gulf Coast Community College, where he lettered as a catcher. He completed his playing career at Jacksonville, where he led the ninth-ranked Dolphins in hitting at the 1976 NCAA South Regional.

Laval and his wife, Pam, are the parents of two children, Brandon and Jamie.

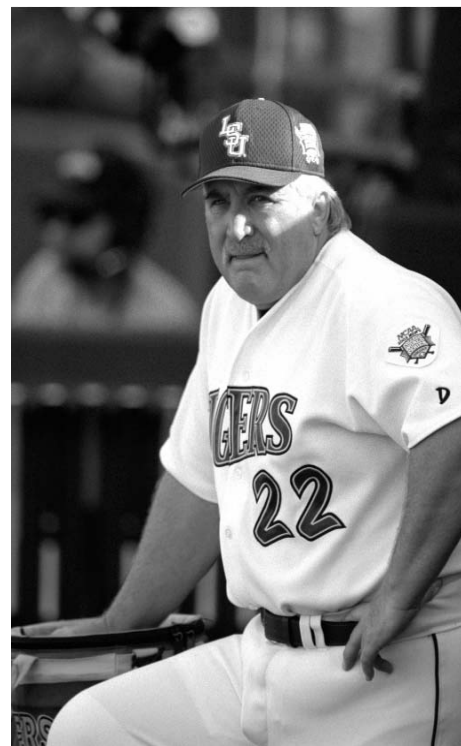
