#### TIGERS HOST NCAA CENTRAL REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

The LSU gymnastics team begins postseason action Friday, April 2, when it hosts the NCAA Central Regional Championships at the Maravich Center ... Competition will begin at 6 p.m. (CT) ... The meet will feature five teams ranked among the top-25, including No. 6 BYU, No. 7 LSU, No. 18 Arizona State, No. 23 Auburn, No. 24 Kent State as well as Michigan State ... Five individual all-arounders as well as three event specialists will also be competing for a spot at the NCAA Championships to be held, April 15-17, in Los Angeles, Calif. ... The field's top-two teams as well as top-two all-arounders not on a qualifying team will advance to the national meet ... In addition, any event winner having not qualified with a team or as an all-arounder will advance to the NCAA Championships in that event only ... Live scoring for the meet can be accessed on the internet at [www.LSUsports.net](http://www.LSUsports.net).

#### LAST TIME OUT

Sophomore April Burkholder was named the SEC Gymnast of the Year in leading the Tigers to a third-place finish at the SEC Championships in Duluth, Ga. The Tigers posted an conference championships all-time best 197.275, but it wasn't enough to knock off Georgia (198.175) and Alabama (197.950) who finished first and second, respectively. Burkholder earned All-SEC honors, finishing third in the all-round with a 39.600. Other top finishes for the Tigers included Lisa Rennie on the beam and Burkholder and Lindsay Beddow on the bars. Rennie notched a career-high 9.950 to finish third on the beam, while Beddow and Burkholder posted identical 9.900s to finish tied for third on the bars.

#### LSU AT THE NCAA REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

LSU has finished in the top-three at the NCAA Regional meet 18 of the last 19 years ... The one exception came during the 1992 season when the Tigers finished seventh overall ... LSU has won two regional championships (1986 and 2002), winning both at home in Baton Rouge ... LSU has finished second at the regional meet three of the last five years ... The Tigers have advanced to the NCAA Championships five of the last seven seasons.

#### LAST YEAR AT THE REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

A 49.225 on the floor in the final rotation secured a second-place finish and a berth to the national championships for the Tigers at the NCAA West Regional Championships in Seattle. The Tigers finished with a 195.700 to edge host-Washington (195.675). Nebraska won the team title with a score of 196.650. Burkholder won the regional floor title (9.925) and finished third in the all-around with a 39.450. Other top finishes for the Tigers included Annie Gagnon and Katherine Hilton, who finished tied for third on the bars, Brittany Brown and Terin Martinjak who tied for third on the floor and Burkholder who placed third on the beam.

#### BURKHOLDER NAMED SEC GYMNAST OF THE YEAR

All-rounder April Burkholder was named the SEC Gymnast of the Year in a vote by league coaches. The 2004 All-SEC selection if the first LSU athlete to ever receive the honor. Ranked fourth nationally in the all-around, Burkholder has won seven all-around titles and 18 individual event titles this season. She has "hit" 43 of her 45 routines and has scored a 9.900 or better on 29 separate occasions.

#### TIGERS SLIPS TO NO. 7 IN NATIONAL RANKINGS

Despite scoring a 197.275 at the SEC Championships, the Tigers dropped two spots to No. 7 in the latest national rankings. Defending national champion UCLA tops the standings once again. The Bruins are the only team in the country to have surpassed the 198-barrier with their regional qualifying score (RQS). They top the field with a 198.055. Stanford jumped four spots to No. 2 in the rankings with an RQS of 197.645, while Alabama (197.625) and Georgia (197.620) held steady at No. 3 and No. 4, respectively. Utah dropped three positions in the standings and rounds out the top-five with an RQS of 197.575. LSU will enter the regional meet ranked among the top 15 on each of the four events. The Tigers are fifth on the beam (49.365), seventh on the vault (49.365), 10th on the bars (49.340) and 12th on the floor (49.435).

#### BURKHOLDER RANKED NO. 4 NATIONALLY

April Burkholder is ranked fourth nationally in the all-around with a RQS of 39.660. The top ranked all-rounder in the Central region, Burkholder sits behind UCLA's Jeanette Antolin (39.790) and Kate Richardson (39.740) who are No. 1 and No. 2, respectively, and Arizona State's Ashley Kelly (39.665). Burkholder is also ranked among the nation's top-10 on three of the four individual events. She is fourth on the floor (9.965), sixth on the vault (9.945) and seventh on the beam (9.940).

#### GAGNON SWINGS INTO THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

All-American Annie Gagnon has been sensational on the bars for the Tigers this season. The junior from Montreal, Quebec, Canada has inched her way up bar standings throughout the season and currently stands at No. 4 in the country with an RQS of 9.940. She has won the bars title at seven of the last nine meets and has scored a 9.900 or better on eight of her last 10 routines.

#### BUTLER VAULTS TO SUCCESS

A solid three-event competitor for the Tigers, freshman Nicki Butler has excelled particularly on the vault this season. The Virginia Beach, Va., native currently ranks 11th in the nation on the event with an RQS of 9.940. Butler, who is averaging a 9.896 this season, has scored 9.900 or better at seven of the last nine meets and has notched a career-best 9.975 twice this season. She has won four meet titles on the vault to date, claiming top honors against Centenary and TWU (1/30), Auburn (2/27), Ohio State (3/5) and Centenary (3/12).

#### LSU SHATTERS VAULT RECORD

LSU shattered the school record on the vault in the regular season finale at Centenary (3/12). The Tigers scored an impressive 49.625 to better the previous record of 49.475 set against Illinois-Chicago in 1997. LSU was led by a pair of near perfect 9.975s by April Burkholder and Nicki Butler. Kelly Phelan and Lindsey Thompson followed with identical 9.900s and Rikki L'Heureux rounded out the Tigers' scoring with a 9.875.

#### TIGERS POST SCHOOL RECORD FLOOR MARK AGAINST OSU

Behind five scores of 9.900 or better the Tigers established a new school record on the floor against Ohio State (3/5), scoring a 49.675. April Burkholder led all Tigers with a meet-winning mark of 9.975. She was followed by Brittany Brown, who earned runner-up honors with a career-high 9.950, and Kelly Phelan and Terin Martinjak who posted identical scores of 9.925. Lisa Rennie rounded out the Tigers' scoring on the event, recording a career-high 9.900. The previous school record mark of 49.600 was set at Centenary on March 21, 2003.

## 2004 LSU GYMNASTICS

### RENNIE ON A ROLL

Freshman Lisa Rennie has proven to be a sensational three-event competitor for the Tigers in her debut campaign. She is ranked 20th nationally on the beam with an RQS of 9.915 and owns LSU's second-best season average on the uneven bars (9.861). In 34 competitive routines this year, the Las Vegas native has scored 9.800 or better on 31 of those routines, including 14 marks of 9.900 or higher. Against Ohio State (3/5), Rennie notched marks of 9.900 or higher on each of her three events for the first time in her career. She posted identical scores of 9.900 on the bars and floor and a 9.925 on the beam.

### TIGERS' 197-PLUS BECOMING A HABIT

Prior to the 2004 season, LSU had only scored above a 197.000 four times in school history. This year, the Tigers have notched seven marks of 197-plus. In addition, LSU has scored consecutive 197s for the first time in school history, posting seven straight scores of 197.100 or better in each of the last seven meets.

### PERFECT 10.00S BY THE PAIR

Prior to the 2004 season no two LSU athletes had ever recorded 10.00s in the same rotation during a single meet. The Tigers have accomplished the feat twice this season. Sophomore Terin Martinjak and freshman Nicki Butler became the first duo to notch a pair of perfect marks, doing so on the floor at Texas Woman's (2/23). Martinjak and April Burkholder later matched that feat at Centenary (3/12), notching identical 10.00s on the beam.

### BURKHOLDER PERFECT ON THE VAULT

April Burkholder scored LSU's first 10.00 on the vault since the 1997 season in the Tigers' tri-meet victory over TWU and Arizona (2/23). She is just the third athlete in LSU history to ever score a 10.00 on the event.

### BURKHOLDER PERFECT ON THE FLOOR EXERCISE

Sophomore April Burkholder's two perfect 10.00s on the floor exercise this season (Alabama-1/23, Kentucky-2/20) have set her apart in the LSU record books. One of just five athletes in school history to have ever posted a perfect mark on the event, she is the only to have done it on three separate occasions.

### BURKHOLDER GARNERS SEC GYMNAST OF THE WEEK HONORS

Twice this season sophomore April Burkholder has been named the SEC's Gymnast of the Week. She was first honored during the week of Feb. 9, following wins on the vault (9.925), beam (9.975), floor (9.975) and in the all-around (39.775) at Arkansas (2/6). Just two weeks later (2/23) the Houston native was recognized after again winning the vault (9.950), beam (9.975), floor (10.00) and all-around (39.800) titles against Kentucky (2/20).

### LSU RECORDS BEST SEASON-OPENING SCORE IN SCHOOL HISTORY

For the second straight season the Tigers started the year with the best season-opening score in school history. LSU's 194.875 at the Michigan State quad meet bettered the previous best season-opening mark of 194.600 set last year at the Bahama Breeze Invitational.

### RETURNING ALL-AMERICANS

The Tigers return two All-Americans, in juniors Annie Gagnon and Lauren Companioni, to their 2004 squad. Gagnon was an All-America selection on the bars in 2003 after scoring a 9.825 on the event at the NCAA Championships, while Companioni was honored during her freshman season after posting a 9.875 on the floor exercise at the 2002 NCAA meet. LSU has had at least one All-American on its team each of the last 11 seasons.

### HEAD COACH D-D BREAUX

The "Dean" of LSU coaches, D-D Breaux is in her 27th season as head coach of the LSU gymnastics program. Breaux owns an all-time regular season record of 309-170-5, as well as a 129-104-2 postseason mark. Breaux eclipsed the 400 win plateau with the Lady Tigers' victory over Kentucky in 2002. For her stellar accomplishments throughout the years Breaux has been named the NCAA Regional Coach of the Year twice (1999 and 2002), the SEC Coach of the Year four times (1993, 1994, 1995 and 2000) and was a finalist for National Coach of the Year Award in 1988 after guiding her team to a fourth-place finish at the NCAA Championships.

## A LOOK AT THE TIGERS

**LINDSAY BEDDOW** - Senior from Tampa, Fla. ... Specializes on the bars and beam for the Tigers ... Has twice scored a career-high 9.900 on the bars, first at TWU (2.23) and then at the SEC Championships (3/20) ... Recorded marks of 9.825 on the bars at Kentucky (2/20) and against Auburn (2/27) ... Recorded a season-best 9.875 on the beam against Auburn ... Notched a 9.825 against Kentucky (2/20) ... Owns season averages of 9.628 on the bars and 9.673 on the beam.

**BRITTANY BROWN** - Sophomore from Wheaton, Md. ... A dynamic performer on the vault and floor for the Tigers ... Posted a career-high 9.950 to place second on the floor against Ohio State (3/5) ... Has scored a 9.900 or better on the event five times this season ... Is averaging a 9.870 this year ... Average ranks second among the Tigers ... Scored a season-best 9.850 on the vault at Centenary (3/12) ... Is averaging a 9.775 this season.

**APRIL BURKHOLDER** - Sophomore from Houston, Texas ... 2004 SEC Gymnast of the Year ... School record holder in the all-around (39.875) ... Has won a team-leading 45 individual titles during her brief career at LSU, including 25 during the 2004 season (seven in the all-around, six each on the vault, beam and floor) ... The top-ranked all-arounder in the Central region, she is ranked fourth nationally with an RQS of 39.660 ... Is also ranked fourth on the floor, sixth on the vault and seventh on the beam ... Has twice been named the SEC's Gymnast of the Week (Feb. 9 and Feb. 23) ... Won a string of seven straight all-around titles during the regular season ... Has "hit" 43 of her 45 competitive routines this season and has scored 9.900 or higher of 29 of them ... Has recorded four perfect 10.00s this year ... Notched perfect marks of the floor against Alabama (1/23) and Kentucky (2/20) ... Is the only athlete in LSU history to have ever recorded three perfect 10.00s on the floor during her career ... Notched her first career 10.00 on the vault at TWU (2/23) ... Just the third Tiger in school history to score a 10.00 on the event and the first to do so since the 1997 season ... Scored the first 10.00 of her career on the beam at Centenary (3/12) ... Recorded the second-best all-around score in school history, Feb. 20, against Kentucky (39.800) ... Total was second only to her own school record mark of 39.875 ... Score also ranks as the best in the SEC this season ... Also won the vault (9.950), beam (9.975) and floor (10.00) against the Wildcats ... Scored a 39.775 to win the all-around title at Arkansas (2/6) ... Also finished first on the vault (9.925), beam (9.975) and floor (9.975) against the Gym Backs ... Has won additional all-around titles vs. Ohio State (3/5), Auburn (2/27), Georgia (2/13), Alabama (1/23) and Centenary and TWU (1/30) ... Her season averages of 9.929 on the vault, 9.950 on the floor, 9.888 on the beam and 39.573 in the all-around rank first among the Tigers.

**NICKI BUTLER** - Freshman from Virginia Beach, Va. ... A solid competitor on the vault, bars and floor for the Tigers ... Is ranked nationally on the vault ... Currently sits at No. 11 with an RQS of 9.940 ... Is averaging a 9.896 on the event this year ... Average ranks second among the Tigers ... Has won four vault titles this season ... Has either won outright or shared top honors on the vault in three of the last four meets ... Has twice scored a career-high 9.975 ... Has scored a 9.900 or higher on the vault in seven of the last nine meets ... Scored a perfect 10.00 on the floor at TWU (2/23) ... Is averaging a 9.729 on the event this season ... Notched a career-best 9.875 on the bars against Ohio State (3/5) ... Has not scored below a 9.800 on the bars in the last six meets.

**LAUREN COMPANIONI** - Junior from Tampa, Fla. ... Made her season debut for the Tigers at Centenary (3/12) ... Scored a 9.850 on the floor.

**MEGAN DURNING** - Sophomore from Roswell, Ga. ... Has seen limited action on the beam for the Tigers this season ... Scored a season-best 9.850 at TWU (2/23) ... Is averaging a 9.600.

**ANNIE GAGNON** - Junior from Montreal, Quebec, Canada ... 2003 All-American on the uneven bars ... Is ranked fourth nationally on the event with an RQS of 9.940 ... Has won seven bars titles in the last nine meets, and has scored a 9.900 or higher on eight of her last 10 routines ... Scored a career-high 9.975 on the bars at Georgia (2/13) ... Is averaging a team-best 9.865 on the event this season ... Made her collegiate debut on the vault against Ohio State (3/5), winning a share of the event title with a 9.950 ... Scored a 9.775 at the SEC Championships (3/20) ... Has seen action on the beam three times for LSU this season ... Scored a career-high 9.900 at the SEC Championships (3/20) ... Is averaging a 9.842.

**KATHERINE HILTON** - Junior from New Orleans, La. ... A bar specialist for the Tigers, she has competed in six meets this season ...
