Harris is hitting .392 (58-for-148) on the year with 13 doubles, one triple, seven homers and 38 RBI.

Nominee for Pitcher of the Week

Greg Smith, LHP, Jr., Alexandria, La.

Smith delivered the best performance of his career Sunday against Ole Miss, firing a complete-game four-hitter in a 5-1 victory over the Rebels . . . he limited the Rebels to just one run on four hits with no walks and seven strikeouts . . . Smith is 5-2 on the season with the best ERA (2.95) among the Tigers' starting pitchers . . . in 61 innings, he has recorded 17 walks and a team-best 55 strikeouts.

Notes on the Tigers

LSU was very productive at the plate in its four games last week, hitting .374 (55-for-147) as a team with 39 runs, 11 doubles, three triples and eight homers . . . in the Ole Miss series, the Tigers batted .343 (36-for-105) with 20 runs, six doubles, one triple and five homers . . . LSU raised its cumulative batting average last week from .291 to .300 . . .
