### SOPHOMORE SEASON (2001)

Served as LSU's punter for the second straight season ... Averaged 43.7 yards on 47 punts during the regular season ... Has great hang time, one of the key reasons the Tigers ranked third in the SEC in net punting with a 39.6 average ... Had 13 of 47 punts downed inside the 20-yard line ... Had a long punt of 68 yards vs. Kentucky ... Career average of 40.6 yards on 104 punts ... Averaged 39.4 yards on 8 punts vs. Illinois in the Sugar Bowl ... Had 3-of-8 punts vs. the Illini downed inside the 20-yard line, including one on the 6-yard line ... Set a pair of SEC Championship game records in LSU's 31-20 win over Tennessee ... Had a 58-yard punt vs. the Vols, the longest punt in SEC Championship game history and also averaged 45.2 yards per punt, another championship game mark.

### REDSHIRT FRESHMAN SEASON (2000)

LSU's starting punter for every game of the season ... The top-rated freshman punter in the SEC with a 38.1 average on 57 punts ... Credited with 17 punts inside the 20 as well as nine fair catches and three touchbacks ... Named LSU's Special Teams Player of the Week against Kentucky after punting four times for a 43.0 average with a long kick of 51 yards ... Also credited with two punts inside the 20 vs. Kentucky and also had a pair of his punts fumbled vs. the Wildcats ... Boomed a career-long punt of 69 yards against UAB ... Had five punts inside the 20 against Houston.






