Home for seven: Tonight's game with Kansas opens a seven-game homestand for the Fighting Tigers.

- The Tigers open the homestand with a three-game series vs. Kansas this weekend.
- The homestand continues when Smoke Laval's former team, Louisiana-Monroe, comes in on Tuesday. LSU hosts nationally ranked Houston next weekend.
- LSU is coming off a smashing 15-0 victory at Centenary on Tuesday night in the Tigers' first road game of 2003.
- The 15-0 victory was the Tigers' largest margin of victory since a 20-5 win over Auburn at home on May 11, 2001, and the largest in a shutout since blanking UL-Monroe, 21-0, in the 2000 NCAA Baton Rouge regional.
- The Centenary game marked LSU's largest margin of victory away from Baton Rouge since a 15-0 whitewash of Vanderbilt in 1996.

Scouting the Jayhawks: Kansas comes in at 6-3 under first-year coach Ritch Price.

- The Jayhawks opened their season by taking four of six from Hawaii Hilo on the Big Island. KU split two games at Arkansas-Little Rock last weekend and won its home opener over Western
- Price came to KU from Cal Poly-San Luis Obispo, leading the Mustangs to three consecutive 30-win seasons from 2000-2002.
- The Jayhawks have not enjoyed a winning season since 1997. KU has not reached the NCAA regionals since 1994, the year after it reached the College World Series.
- Former coach Bobby Randall resigned after the 2002 season, when KU went 22-29 overall and finished last in the Big 12 at 5-21.
- LSU is the first of three SEC opponents on the Jayhawks' schedule. KU has a home-and-home series slated with Arkansas, and will play in Vanderbilt's tournament at Nashville in two weeks.

About the series: LSU and Kansas have met in only one series, with the Tigers sweeping the Jayhawks in 1990 in Baton Rouge.

- LSU won the series by scores of 10-1, 9-3 and 8-2, part of a nine-game winning streak by the Tigers that season.
- The Jayhawks are the second Big 12 team from Kansas to come to Baton Rouge in the last three years. LSU took two of three from Kansas State, to open the 2001 season
- LSU holds a 20-12 record against teams from the state of Kansas, holding a 6-4 record vs. Wichita State and an 11-8 mark vs. K-State.

Recapping Tuesday night: Twelve different Tigers banded out 19 hits in LSU's 15-0 victory over Centenary in Shreveport.

- J.C. Holt went 3-for-4 with 3 RBI, falling just a single short of the cycle.
- Five other LSU players collected two hits, as LSU scored six runs in the first three innings and nine in the final three.
- Justin Meier worked five shutout innings in his LSU debut, and three other pitchers preserved the shutout.

Tonight's Starting Pitcher: #12 RHP Jake Tompkins Sr.-1L, 6-0, 195, Auburn, Calif. (Sacramento City College)

Jake Tompkins looked dominant in his first start of 2003, setting a career high with 11 strikeouts in the season opener. Tompkins goes for his first victory on Friday against Kansas, as the Jayhawks counter with junior left-hander Ryan Knippschild (1-0, 5.56).

2003: No decisions with a 0.00 ERA in one start.

- A 28th-round selection of the Texas Rangers in the 2002 first-year player draft, Tompkins opted to return to LSU for his senior season.
- Is the latest in a long line of LSU players to come from Sacramento City College, joining former Tigers Conan Horton, Brandon Bowe, Jake Esteves and David Raymer.
- Ranked No. 16 in Baseball America's pre-season survey of college baseball's top 50 seniors.
- Also rated by Baseball America as having best breaking ball and second best control among SEC pitchers.
- Struck out a career high 11 batters in just 5.2 innings vs. Northwestern St. (2/7).

2002: Second team All-SEC selection, going 7-1 with a 2.68 ERA in a team high 25 games.

- Allowed two of 20 inherited runners to score in 19 relief outings.
- Held opponents to a .198 batting average with runners in scoring position, and posted 32 of his 96 strikeouts (exactly one-third) in those situations.
- Yielded only 14 extra base hits in 317 at-bats.
- Gave up only one hit in 13 at-bats with the bases loaded.
- Was named the Most Outstanding Player of the NCAA Baton Rouge regional, when he went 2-0 with a 1.59 ERA.
- Earned a win in relief vs. Southern (5/31) in the regional opener by striking out eight in five innings of work as LSU won 6-5 in the bottom of the 9th.
- Came back with one day of rest to pitch 6.1 innings vs. UL-Lafayette (6/2, Game 1), allowing just one un-earned run and striking out five to keep the Tigers alive in the regional.
- Closed out SEC Tournament victory over South Carolina (5/23) by striking out four in 2.0 innings of scoreless relief.
- Struck out 10 in 4.2 innings in spot start at New Orleans (4/30), combining with Clay Harris and Brad David on a 13-0 shutout.
- Earned win in relief vs. Arkansas (4/28), allowing one earned run in 3.2 innings to help complete sweep of Razorbacks.
- Had spectacular weekend in series at Auburn (4/5, 4/7) allowing just four hits in 5.1 scoreless innings of work. Earned save in series finale to give Tigers their first SEC series victory of the season.
- Earned save in his relief debut vs. Mississippi St. (3/30), striking out four in 2.2 hitless innings of work.
- Struck out six in 6.0 shutout innings vs. UL-Lafayette (3/12).
- Pitched 8.0 strong innings in no decision vs. Long Beach St. (3/3) on sub-freezing day, walking none and striking out eight.
- Missed start at Houston (2/24) due to strained pectoral muscle.
- Gave up only one earned run and struck out six in 6.0 innings in victory over Mercer (2/17).
- Struck out seven in first career start, picking up win vs. Birmingham-Southern (2/10).

Sunflowers on the Bayou

Kansas is making its first visit to Baton Rouge since 1990 this weekend, but visitors from the Sunflower State are no strangers to Alex Box Stadium.

Kansas State was at The Box for the season opening series in 2001, with the Wildcats taking a 9-8 victory in the opener before LSU won the last two games, 4-0 and 14-8. The Wildcats also opened the 1967 season in Baton Rouge and shut out the Tigers twice, 1-0 and 2-0. LSU and K-State have met 19 times, all at The Box, with the Tigers holding an 11-8 edge.

As for Kansas' most successful college baseball program, all Tiger fans know the history between LSU and Wichita State. The Tigers have beaten the Shockers three times in the College World Series, twice in the national championship game, winning 6-3 in 1991 and 8-0 in 1993. LSU's third victory over Wichita in the CWS, a 9-8 triumph in the opening round in 1996, started the Tigers on the road to their third national title.

In the regular season, LSU swept a three-game series in 1987 at The Box, but the Shockers responded with a three-game sweep in Wichita in 1988. The Shockers took a 13-6 decision in the 1990 ABCA Hall of Fame Classic in Orlando.

Early road trip

LSU's game on Tuesday night at Centenary marked the Tigers' earliest road game since opening the 1985 season at Central Florida, which was the last time LSU opened a season on enemy turf. LSU had played earlier games away from Baton Rouge in the intervening years, but those games were played at neutral sites, most commonly at the Winn-Dixie Showdown at the Superdome.

LSU and Kansas share history, good and bad

Only two Division I schools in NCAA history have played in a football bowl game, the men's basketball Final Four and baseball's College World Series in the same academic year. Those two schools meet this weekend at Alex Box Stadium.

LSU became the first school to pull off this triple crown in the 1985-86 school year. The Tigers' football team lost to Baylor in the Liberty Bowl, the men's basketball team won the Southeast regional and lost to Louisville in the Final Four in Dallas, while Skip Bertman's baseball team reached LSU's first CWS, where the Tigers were 1-2 and finished fifth.

Kansas turned the trick in 1992-93, with the football team defeating BYU in the Aloha Bowl, the men's basketball team winning the Midwest regional before losing to North Carolina in the Final Four at the Superdome in New Orleans, while the baseball team reached KU's first CWS, but the Jayhawks were two and out after losses to Texas A&M and Long Beach St. The fourth team in the bracket that year? None other than LSU, which went on to win its second national championship.

Sadly, recent history between LSU and KU is anything but pleasant. Kansas' top-ranked basketball team defatted LSU in the 1996 Maui Invitational, and two months later, Lester Earl transferred from Baton Rouge to Lawrence, sparking the investigation that eventually landed the Tigers' basketball program on NCAA probation.

LSU vs. the Big 12

Since the Big 12 played its first baseball season in 1997, the Tigers are 9-5 vs. teams from the conference heading into the weekend series with Kansas, the first between the schools since 1990.

LSU helped open the Big 12 era in baseball in 1997 by opening against Baylor at Alex Box Stadium, as the Tigers swept the Bears to run out to a 19-0 start. The Tigers would eliminate Oklahoma from the 1997 South I Regional at The Box with the help of a triple play, LSU's first in 16 years at the time.

The Tigers would go on to drop two of three to Texas in each of the next two seasons, first at Austin in 1998 and again in Baton Rouge in 1999 before defeating the Longhorns in the 2000 College World Series. LSU took two of three from Kansas St. to open the 2001 season.

The Tigers have not faced Missouri, Oklahoma St. or Texas A&M since the formation of the Big 12, but LSU faced Mizzou and OSU while the schools were in the Big 8, and played the Aggies while A&M was in the Southwest Conference. LSU has never played Texas Tech, and did not play Colorado and Iowa St. before those schools dropped their baseball programs.



Balance goes to new extreme

LSU entered Tuesday's game at Centenary with extraordinary balance at the plate, as all 13 players who had an at-bat had at least one hit.

In the 15-0 victory in Shreveport, LSU continued to show incredible balance, as 12 of the 14 players who made a plate appearance collected a hit to contribute to the Tigers' 19-hit barrage. The only players to not get a hit were starting catcher Matt Liuzza, who was 0-for-4, and pinch-hitter Clay Harris, who walked in the ninth for Aaron Hill.

The hitting bug became so contagious that third string catcher Shawn French even collected an RBI single in the ninth in his first career LSU plate appearance. French extends to 14 the number of Tigers with a hit this season.

Six different LSU players had at least two hits, with J.C. Holt leading the way with three hits. Quinn Stewart, Ivan Naccarata, Aaron Hill, Blake Gill and Jon Zeringue all had two hits, leaving seven Tiger regulars with batting averages of .308 or better heading into the weekend series with Kansas.

The Tigers 1-through-5 hitters set the table in the blowout, going 13-for-28 (.464), scoring nine runs and collecting 10 RBI.

No broken clutch here

To score runs, a team has to be able to get the hits with runners in scoring position, an art the Tigers have been quite proficient at early in the 2003 season.

Of the Tigers' 19 hits on Tuesday in Shreveport, 11 of them came in 22 at-bats with runners in scoring position, a .500 average that is outstanding, no matter who the competition might be. LSU was also 14-for-28 in all situations with runners on base, and with two outs, the Tigers were a sizzling 11-for-19, helping the Tigers score eight runs with the end of the inning looming.

For the season, LSU hitters are tearing the cover off the ball in RISP situations, sporting a lofty .451 average (23-for-51), and of the 14 players who have had a plate appearance this year, 12 have collected at least one hit in those situations. Bruce Sprowl and Blake Gill are both 3-for-5 with RISP, while Aaron Hill is 3-for-6.

LSU has also been pretty good with two out this year, as 15 of the Tigers' 30 RBI on the year have come with two out, part of LSU's .360 (18-for-50) average in those situations. Gill and Jon Zeringue are the Tigers' top two-out hitters, going 3-for-5 each.

Holt falls just short of cycle

J.C. Holt fell just short of making LSU history on Tuesday night, as his ninth inning ground out left him only a single short of hitting for the cycle. Even the ground out wasn't all that bad, as it scored a run in the Tigers' five-run final inning.

The last LSU player to hit for the cycle, ironically, was a center fielder, as Mike Koerner pulled off the feat on March 1, 1997 against Virginia Commonwealth.

Holt had himself quite a night nonetheless, driving in a run with a triple in the second, launching a solo home run in the seventh and adding an RBI double in the eighth to highlight a 3-for-6 night, Holt's sixth game of three hits or more in his LSU career. The three extra base hits raised Holt's slugging percentage to a team best .917.

Like a good leadoff hitter, Holt continues to find ways to get on base. Holt was hit by a pitch for the third time this season in the first inning, and he enters the Kansas series as the Tigers' leader in on-base percentage at .533.

Gill reaches .500

Blake Gill's 0-for-17 slump to start 2002 must seem like it happened 10 years ago, not just last year, as Gill continues to make a strong case for All-America consideration.

The sophomore from Florida continued to show the consistency that marked his effort in the three-game sweep of Northwestern St. last weekend, going 2-for-3 with an RBI triple and a walk against Centenary on Tuesday, giving him two hits in all four games this season.

Gill enters the weekend as the Tigers' leading hitter at .500 (8-for-16), and his three extra base hits (2 doubles, 1 triple) and five runs scored are also the top marks on the team.

Gill has also been steady with the leather, committing no errors in 37 chances in the field.

Triple pleasure

LSU tied a school record for triples in a game on Tuesday at Centenary, as Aaron Hill, J.C. Holt and Blake Gill all tripled in the first three innings.

LSU has recorded 3 triples in a game on 10 previous occasions, most recently in the 1999 regular season finale against Kentucky. The Tigers had a total of 20 triples in 2002, the SEC's second highest total behind Florida's 26.



LSU continues strong finishing kick
In a trend that has continued from 2002, the Fighting Tigers continue to be able to put up runs in the late innings.

So far this year, LSU has scored 14 of its 32 runs in the final three innings, including nine in the last three innings on Tuesday night at Centenary, scoring five in the ninth after putting up two runs each in the seventh and eighth innings. The 14 runs in those late innings are more than the total number of runs (nine) allowed by Tiger pitching in the first four games of 2003.

Last year, the Tigers scored 177 of their 441 runs, or 40.1 percent, in the seventh inning or later. LSU's top scoring inning was the seventh with 75 runs, followed closely by the 63 runs scored in the eighth.

LSU hurlers choke off opposing rallies

The Tigers pitchers have been just as impressive as the hitters with runners in scoring position, as LSU hurlers have been more than up to the task of choking off opposing rallies.

By holding Centenary to just one hit in nine at-bats with runners in scoring position on Tuesday, LSU pitchers are now holding opposing batters to a .116 average (5-for-43) in RISP situations. No Tiger pitcher has allowed more than one hit in those situations.

With the bases loaded, the Tigers have allowed just one walk and one sacrifice fly, giving up no hits in five official at-bats.

Two-out hits have also been nearly impossible to come by for opponents, with LSU limiting foes to a .108 clip (4-for-37) with the end of the inning looming and a .111 mark (2-for-18) with RISP and two out.

Twenty of the 31 hits allowed by LSU pitching have come with the bases empty, as Tiger pitchers are giving up a .196 average in all situations with runners on base. Tiger pitchers have also allowed only three extra base hits in 36 innings pitched.

Determann makes sharp return

Jason Determann made the return to the scene of his season ending injury in 2002 a successful one, throwing two scoreless innings on Tuesday at Centenary, recording three strikeouts while walking none.

In last year's game in Shreveport, Determann injured his elbow and underwent season-ending Tommy John surgery to repair the damage. The Baton Rouge native is 1-0 for his career, earning a victory in relief in extra innings last February 9 vs. Birmingham-Southern.

Meier makes most of debut

Lost in the barrage of hits on Tuesday night was the outstanding debut of freshman right-hander Justin Meier on the mound.

Meier allowed just two singles in five innings of work to earn his first LSU victory, and along with Jason Determann, Jordan Faircloth and Billy Sadler, the Tigers posted their first shutout of 2003.

Meier, a Florida native, worked his way out of a bases-loaded jam in the bottom of the first to end what effectively Centenary's only scoring threat. In the second through fifth innings, Meier allowed one hit and faced the minimum number of batters as he preserved the Tigers' 6-0 lead when he left the game.

Meier is the third LSU newcomer to earn a victory this season, as Billy Sadler and Nate Bumstead both earned victories in the Northwestern St. series last weekend. Brandon Nall, another new Tiger hurler, earned saves in the victories by Sadler and Bumstead.

Bullpen getting the job done

LSU came into the 2003 season with a known strength in its starting rotation, but questions remained about the bullpen, given the fact there would be a new closer and several new faces in middle relief.

So far, the Tigers' relief corps is passing all tests with flying colors, posting an 0.71 ERA in four games and allowing just one run in 12 2/3 innings pitched. The total of 12 hits and 4 walks might be a little high, but the relievers have been able to choke off any and all rallies that have come its way.

Smoke can be fastest to 50

By taking two of three games this weekend vs. Kansas, Smoke Laval will notch his 50th victory as the Tigers' coach, and even if he doesn't do it this weekend, he still has plenty of time to become the fastest LSU coach to 50 victories.

Laval's predecessor, Skip Bertman, holds the current record for the fastest LSU coach to 50 wins, as Bertman won his 50th in his 80th game, and went on to an 870-330-3 career record with five national championships. Laval is 48-22 in one year plus four games at LSU.

The week ahead

The Tigers remain at home through the upcoming week as the seven-game homestand continues with a pair of familiar foes coming to Alex Box Stadium.

First in on Tuesday night are the Louisiana-Monroe Indians, the team that Smoke Laval coached to three NCAA regional berths from 1994-2000. Laval was 4-0 against his former team in 2000, sweeping the Indians in a three-game set in Baton Rouge in March, then winning at Monroe in April. Two other members of LSU's coaching staff, pitching coach Brady Wiederhold and administrative assistant Ted White, were with Laval in Monroe; Wiederhold in his same capacity in 2000 and 2001 under Brad Holland, and White as a player. ULM's last victory in the series was a 7-6, 11-inning triumph in 2001 at The Box.

The Tigers face their first serious test of 2003 next weekend when the Houston Cougars return to Baton Rouge, led by All-American pitcher Brad Sullivan. Last year, the Cougars won two of three from the Tigers in a madcap series at Houston, a set that was highlighted by LSU's eight-run sixth inning in the second game that helped tie the series, then the Tigers' collapse on Sunday in a game that saw LSU commit seven errors and blow an 11-7 lead in a 12-11 loss. Houston swept the Tigers in 2000 at The Box, but LSU returned the favor in 2001.



LSU Coach Smoke Laval

Smoke Laval had a very successful first year as LSU's coach, leading the Tigers to the NCAA Super Regional round for the fourth consecutive year and posting a 44-22 record. For his efforts, Laval was named the Louisiana Sportswriters' Association Louisiana coach of the year.

Laval was named Skip Bertman's successor on July 18, 2000, and spent the 2001 season as the LSU administrative assistant. From 1994-2000, Laval coached for seven years at Louisiana-Monroe, guiding the Indians to three NCAA regional berths (1995, 1999, 2000) and a 241-159 mark. Among Laval's pupils at ULM was Ben Sheets, a 2000 member of the United States Olympic gold medal team and a 2001 major league all-star with the Milwaukee Brewers.

Laval was Bertman's top assistant at LSU from 1984-1993, helping the Tigers reach the College World series six times and win the national championship in 1991 and 1993. Laval was also a graduate assistant at LSU under Jack Lamabe in 1979 and an assistant at Florida in 1982 and 1983.
