Is the Tigers' leading scorer, with 139 points to his credit (25 FG, 58 PATs, one TD) ... His 139 total points are an LSU single-season record and his 133 points through kicks are both LSU and SEC single-season records ... Has connected on five-straight field goals of 40 yards or longer ... Was successful on a career-long 49-yard attempt as well as a 43 yarder versus Alabama ... Matched that 49-yard effort versus Arkansas ... Was perfect on kicks of 48 and 43 yards against Ole Miss ... **2007:** The Tigers' "go to" receiver, he was sidelined for five weeks with an injury ... Was hurt in practice during the week of Middle Tennessee game and sat out next four games ... Returned to action for one play - final play of game - against Kentucky ... Widely considered one of the most athletic receivers in college football and a player who makes the entire LSU offense, in particular QB Matt Flynn, better ... Returned to full-time action against Auburn where he made an immediate impact, leading the team with seven catches for a season-high 93 yards ... Against Auburn, caught a 33-yard pass on a third-and-nine situation early in the third quarter ... LSU eventually kicked a field goal on that drive to pull to within 17-10 ... Caught six of his seven passes against Auburn in the second half and all 93 of his receiving yards came after halftime ... Despite seeing significant action in just eight games, he still ranks as the team's leading receiver with 50 catches for 474 yards and four touchdowns ... Pulled in a career-high tying two TDs in the win over Alabama ... Began the year with a career-high nine receptions



for 78 yards and a score in the Tigers' victory over Mississippi State ... Also caught a TD pass against Virginia Tech.

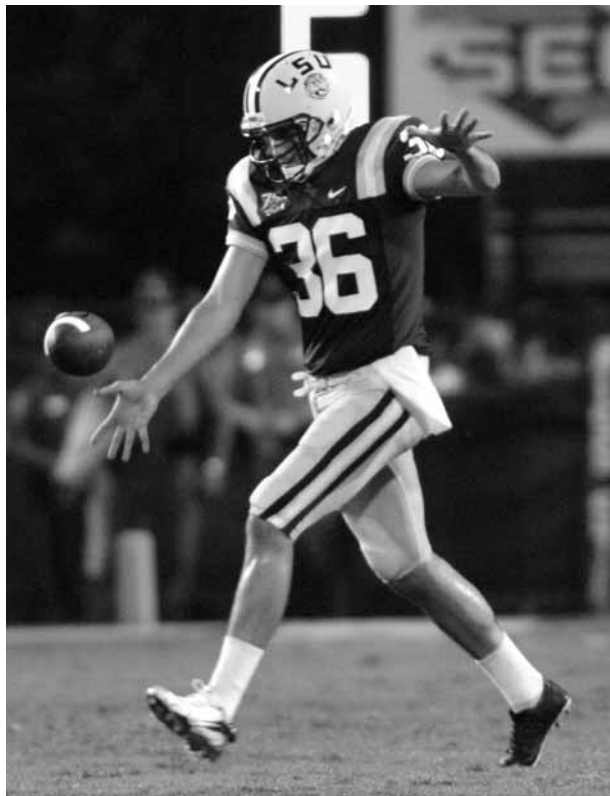
