QUARTERBACK DON SMITH---I'm the same Don Smith. We just haven't been able to get anything going offensively. Situations came up tonight where their defense shut our offense down.

No, I'm not pressing. I've just got to go out and do the things that will help our team win. I didn't think we played with the same intensity level that we should have been playing with in order to have won those six games. We haven't played with a lot of intensity and the killer instinct that we play with during those six games.

About the record: It's a great honor, but the goal I wanted to reach we still haven't reached yet. Hopefully we can bounce back next week and redeem ourselves against Ole Miss. That's the only goal I have for this team and for myself--to go to a bowl game.

Cornerback Bruce Plummer--- We stopped them on occasion and held them to field goals. But on the other side of the football we couldn't get anything going and get any points out of it.

About LSU: They've got a good football team. They're not as good as Auburn or Alabama, but they were a helluva football team tonight.

LSU HEAD COACH BILL AKENSTADT --

"It's great to be a champion. Now, I have been a champion in every league I have been in.

"Offensively, defensively and in the kicking game...we played a complete game. By us kicking our field goals, we put pressure on Mississippi State.

"Mississippi State led the league in kickoff returns and we were able to keep the pressure on them.

"Mississippi State has a great football team. We are glad to win. (Don) Smith is a great player. It is a credit to our defensive coaches and outside linebackers. We could have easily contained the guy by putting someone next to the sidelines. But we contained with pressure.

"We put all the marbles on the table tonight.

"This is the most satisfying game that I've ever had since I've been here. Why...the championships.

"Tommy Hodson was played well all season for us and he did his same tonight. We moved the ball around a little bit (commenting on using seven different receivers). It is always good when you do that."

MSU HEAD COACH ROCKY FELKER --

"I think LSU had a lot to do with our performance tonight. We didn't do anything very well. We wanted to get an early lead and stay away from the things that really hurt us so much the past two games, but we weren't able to do that. It seemed like everything we did went wrong.

"I thought the defense didn't play that badly at times. The offense put us in a hole on a couple of occasions and we never could get anything going offensively. I thought holding them to a field goal ~~XXXXXX~~ on a few possessions was really our only positive note.

"I don't think we were tired mentally. LSU was just a lot better team than we were tonight. We're playing like a much different team than the one that started the season 6-1. Everything we were doing was clicking then, now everything backfires. We just don't have the confidence we need to play well now.

"But I think our losses have been more a lack of execution than a lack of confidence. There was a time when we thought we could put the ball in the endzone against anyone, now we have trouble getting a first down."
