

"I am impressed with his accomplishments as well as his enthusiasm and vision for the program."

Conference titles and a nationally prominent program are nothing new for the Cheltenham, England native, who after starting the Furman program from scratch in 1994 led the Lady Paladins to six Southern Conference Championships and four NCAA College Cup appearances during his tenure.

In 11 seasons, Lee's teams accumulated a 144-80-10 overall record, including a 76-16-3 mark in conference action. Three times his team went undefeated in conference play (1999, 2000, 2002) and were just shy of perfection in 2003, going 10-0-1.

Also a proven recruiter, Lee produced four top 50 recruiting classes, including the nation's 12th-ranked class in 2002, in his last five seasons at Furman. That tradition continued upon Lee's arrival at LSU where he landed the Tigers' their first-ever top 50 recruiting class to comprise quite possibly the most talented soccer team in LSU history. His 26th-ranked recruiting class is also listed as the best among SEC West teams in 2005.

Individually, Lee has been responsible for two NCAA All-Americans, one National Soccer Coaches Association of America All-American, two Freshman All-Americans, 22 All-Southeast Region players, four Southern Conference Players of the Year, five conference Freshmen of the Year and 54 all-league selections.

Lee's athletes have proven to be just as successful in the classroom where he owns a 100% graduation rate. His teams have earned four NSCAA Team Academic

Awards and 122 of his athletes have been selected to the Southern Conference Academic Honor Roll.

For his accomplishments, Lee has been selected as the Southern Conference Coach of the Year five times and was named the NSCAA and SoccerBuzz Southeast Region Coach of the Year in 1999, the same year he was selected as a finalist for NSCAA National Coach of the Year honors. In addition to his collegiate experience, Lee has served on the Region III Olympic Developmental Program staff since 1999.

A successful athlete in his own right, Lee played for the Paladin soccer team from 1989-92 where he was part of three Southern Conference titles and was selected as a team captain and the Most Valuable Player. He also led his team to three Southern Conference Championships and its first ever NCAA appearance, and a berth in the Sweet 16 in 1991.

Lee, 34, earned his bachelors degree in political science from Furman in 1993. Lee and his wife, the former Nancy Repsher, also a 1993 graduate of Furman, have two children Aidan (2) and Abby (1).

ebbie Hensley enters her first season as an assistant at LSU after six years as the head coach of the Western Carolina Catamounts. Hensley made an immediate impact as she was instrumental in the highest ranked recruiting class in LSU history. Hiring Hensley as an assistant coach was an easy decision for Brian Lee, as the two had coached together at Furman.

"Debbie is not only one of the top coaches in soccer, she is one of the best people," said LSU head coach Brian Lee. "She is a tremendous coach, recruiter and leader."

Hensley had a 60-52-9 record in six years at WCU after starting the program from scratch in 1999. In her inaugural season she led the Catamounts to a 10-9-1 record and a Southern Conference Tournament appearance.

In 2000, WCU's record improved to 11-8-2 and the following year the Catamounts won the Southern Conference regular season title with a 16-6 overall record and an 8-2 league mark. For her team's success Hensley was named the league's Coach of the Year.

At WCU, Hensley coached seven players to 11 All-Southern Conference honors, a total that includes three first-team selections.

Hensley also served as the Assistant Athletics Director/Senior Woman administrator.

Prior to her time at Western Carolina, Hensley spent three seasons as an assistant coach under Lee at Furman University where she recruited eight players that went on to earn all-conference accolades.

Along with her coaching achievement Hensley also had several accomplishments as a player. The Georgia Southern soccer and softball standout was a three-time first-team All-SoCon selection that also led the conference in scoring during both her junior and senior seasons. A NSCAA Regional All-American and NSCAA All-Region honoree, Hensley was also selected to play in the prestigious Umbro Select College All-Star Classic. Hensley was named the Georgia Female College Athlete of the Year by the Georgia Hall of Fame in 1995.

The two-sport standout for the Eagles was also a first-team all-conference selection in softball, setting Georgia Southern's career records for both runs scored and bases stolen.

Hensley received her bachelor of science degree in education from Georgia Southern in 1996 and a master's of arts degree in health and exercise science from Furman in 1998.
