



**College Team Entries**

1. Entries are unlimited.
2. All entries **MUST** be done through [www.DirectAthletics.com](http://www.DirectAthletics.com) by the deadline. If you do not have an account, you should set up your account and roster before the entry deadline. No Phone, Email or Faxed entries will be accepted.
3. Entry Deadline is noon, Tuesday, September 24.

**Individual Entries**

1. Enter online at [www.DirectAthletics.com](http://www.DirectAthletics.com) by the deadline. You will need an individual account; please set this up in advance of the entry deadline as it takes several days to process. NO PHONE or EMAIL entries will be accepted.
2. Entry deadline is noon, Tuesday, September 24. There will be no walk up entries on the day of the meet.
2. A \$20 entry fee must be paid online with a credit card at the time of entry.

**Unattached College Student Entries**

1. Email Andrea Tepe at [tepeal@lsu.edu](mailto:tepeal@lsu.edu) before noon on Tuesday, September 24 to enter.
2. A \$5 entry fee will be collected at packet pickup with a student ID. An entry fee of \$20 will be charged if no student ID is shown. Online entry fees will not be refunded.

**Team Entry Fee**

The USTFCCCA Preferred Cross Country Entry Fee guidelines will be followed. The regular entry fee will be \$125 per team per gender and the preferred entry fee for USTFCCCA members will be \$75 per team per gender. Checks should be made out to: **LSU Athletic Department**. **Entry fees are to be paid at packet pickup.**

**Packet Pickup**

Available at the pavilion on Saturday between 3:00 PM and 5:30 PM. Team and college student entry fees are payable at this time. **There will be no walk up registration available.** If a coach has a scratch, they can return the bib of the non-competing athlete during packet pickup. Scratches can also be done with the clerk at the race start line.

**Meet Site**

The Highland Road Park is located in Baton Rouge on Highland Road, approximately 8 miles south of the LSU Campus and approximately 4 miles from Interstate 10. Course maps will be available at [www.LSUports.net/meetinfo](http://www.LSUports.net/meetinfo).

**Directions to Highland Road Park**

**Approaching on I-10 from the West:** Take the Siegen Lane exit, turning right onto Siegen Lane. Proceed approximately 2 miles to the intersection of Siegen and Highland Road. Turn left onto Highland Road, and proceed approximately ¼ mile. The park will be on the left at the intersection of Highland Road and Amiss Road.

**Approaching on I-10 from the East:** Take the Highland Road exit, then turn left back underneath the overpass. Turn right onto Highland Road, and proceed approximately 4 miles. The park will be on the right at the intersection of Highland Road and Amiss Road.

**From LSU:** Take Nicholson Drive South approximately ¼ mile. Turn left onto Burbank Drive, and proceed approximately 8 miles until it intersects with Highland Road. Turn right onto Highland Road, and proceed approximately ¼ miles. The park will be on the left at the intersection of Highland Road and Amiss Road.

**Declarations**

Coaches must declare their athletes with the clerk at the start line prior to competing by returning the bibs of any runner that is a scratch. Any bibs that are not returned will be considered to be competing runners.
