Bradford returned to the mound as a starter on May 6, throwing 85 pitches in five innings of work . . . he limited Arkansas to two runs on six hits with no walks and two strikeouts . . . Bradford threw a total of I24 pitches in the two victories as Arkansas as he improved to 7-I in SEC games ... fired his first complete game in an LSU uniform April 29 vs. Tennessee, limiting the Vols to two runs on eight hits with no BB and 8 Ks ... named a Collegiate Baseball National Player of the Week after a 13-strikeout outing against Lipscomb; worked 7.1 innings, allowing two runs on three hits with one walk.
