

#### FLORY RECORDS 100TH VICTORY AS A TIGER

With a 3-0 win over Georgia on Sept. 24, head coach Fran Flory recorded her 100th win at the helm of the Tiger volleyball program. With a 3-0 win over Louisiana Tech on Sept. 11, Flory passed Gerry Owens to become the third winningest head coach in LSU history behind only Scott Luster and Ruth Nelson.

## MIJATOVIC LED SEC, FOURTH IN NCAA IN ACES PER GAME

Jelena Mijatovic led the SEC and ranked fourth in the NCAA in service aces per game. She averaged 0.77 service aces per game, while Jana Milin of Maryland-Eastern Shore led the nation with 0.94 aces per game. Mijatovic's mark would have ranked second in LSU history if she had reached 75 aces for the year (she had 71). Wendy Stammer holds the Tiger record with 0.95 aces per game in 1986.

#### **KUZMIC LED SEC, 16TH IN NCAA IN BLOCKS PER GAME**

Ivana Kuzmic led the SEC and ranked 16th in the NCAA in blocks per game. She averaged 1.59 blocks per game, behind Melissa Elmer of Nebraska, who led the nation with 1.89 blocks per game. As a freshman at Arkansas-Little Rock, Kuzmic led the NCAA in blocks per game and she led the Sunbelt Conference each of the last two years. Kuzmic's mark ranks third in the LSU blocks per game record book. Angie Miller holds the school record with a 1.67 blocks per game average in 1991.

## **HOOD HITS 1,000 CAREER KILLS**

With her first kill against No. 10 Florida on Oct. 15, Regan Hood became the 13th player in LSU history with 1,000 career kills. With 1,172 total kills for her career, she ranks 11th in LSU history.

#### PITTMAN POSTS 700 CAREER/300 SEASON DIGS

With her third dig against Arkansas on Nov. 12, Rachel Pittman recorded her 700th career dig, becoming just the 23rd player in LSU history to record 700 career digs. She finished her career with 785 digs and a 2.36 career digs per game average. For the season, she led the team with 348 digs and 3.19 digs per game. She was the first player since Jennifer Hampton in 2002 to post 300 digs in a season.

## PITTMAN NAMED SEC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Rachel Pittman was named the SEC Defensive Player of the Week on Nov. 15 after leading the team with a 4.43 digs per game average as LSU went 2-0 on the week, knocking off the SEC West Champion Lady'Backs and Ole Miss. Against Arkansas, she led the match with her third 20-plus dig performance of the season as the Tigers recorded only their third win over the Lady'Backs in the programs' 24 meetings. She also posted double-figures with 11 digs against Ole Miss as LSU swept the Lady Rebels on the road for the first time since 2001.

#### **KUZMIC NAMED SEC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

Ivana Kuzmic was named the SEC Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 20 after leading the Tigers with 2.00 blocks per game as LSU went 3-0 for the weekend, defeating three teams that posted 20-win seasons last year. Against Miami, Kuzmic recorded her first double-double of the season with 10 blocks, including four block solos, and 12 kills. It marked just the fourth time in three seasons a Tiger has recorded double-figure block numbers. Two matches later, she came one block shy of repeating the feat, recording nine total blocks against SMU. Additionally, she led the team with 18 kills against the Mustangs.

#### **KUZMIC POSTS QUARTET OF 10+ BLOCK MATCHES**

With 14 blocks against Houston to close out the season, back-to-back double-figure block performances against Mississippi State and Ole Miss, and 10 blocks against Miami earlier in the year, Ivana Kuzmic became the first player at LSU to post four double-figure block matches since Stacey Samuels recorded five double-figure performances in 1986. Kuzmic posted 10 blocks against Miami on Sept. 17, 10 vs. Mississippi State on Oct. 1, 11 vs. Ole Miss on Oct. 3 and a season-best 14 against Houston on Nov. 27. She was one of only two players in the SEC with four double-figure block performances.

## **KUZMIC RECORDS MEMORABLE FIVE-GAME MATCH**

Against Houston on Nov. 27, Ivana Kuzmic recorded a season-best 14 total blocks, including six solo blocks, tying her for the sixth most total blocks and second most solo blocks in a five-game match in school history. Her total block mark was 11 behind the school record of 25 recorded by Lisa Smith against Wyoming on Sept. 11, 1987. Her solo block mark was three behind the school record of nine recorded by Lisa Smith against Wyoming on Sept. 11, 1987. It also marked the most total blocks in an LSU match since Miranda Cantu recorded 15 against Auburn in 1994.

#### MIJATOVIC POSTS THIRD MOST SERVICE ACES

Against South Carolina on Nov. 5, Jelena Mijatovic recorded eight service aces, tying her for the third most service aces in a five-game match in LSU history. The mark is only one behind the school record of nine aces by Sibel Gurkan against Tulane on Sept. 22, 1987 and Lisa Sulatycki against Auburn on Oct. 9, 1988. It also marks the first time since Tonya Johnson on Sept. 1, 1990, that a player recorded eight service aces in a match.

#### PITTMAN TIED FOR SIXTH MOST DIGS

Against Kentucky on Oct. 24, Rachel Pittman recorded 25 digs in the match, tying her for the sixth most digs in a four-game match in school history. It marked the third match in 2004 that Pittman posted top 10 marks in school history in digs after she recorded the 10th most digs in a three-game match against Wisconsin-Milwaukee and the fourth most digs in a five-game match against Miami. The 25 digs is tied with Luciana Reis and is six behind the school record of 31 by Reis against Kansas in 1993. It also marked the most digs in a fourgame match since 1994.

#### **HOOD/MIJATOVIC POST 20-20 MATCHES**

Against Arkansas on Nov. 19, Regan Hood recorded 24 kills and 20 digs, giving her the second 20-20 performance of the season. Her 24 kills was a season high, while her 20 digs was a career high.

Against Kentucky on Oct. 24, Jelena Mijatovic recorded 26 kills and 21 digs, giving her the first 20-20 performance of 2004 and the first at LSU since 2002. Her 26 kills is tied for 12th place in LSU history in a four-game match, while the 21 digs is tied for 15th place all-time in a four-game match.

The last time a player recorded 20 kills and 20 digs in the same match was Jennifer Hampton with 24 kills and 24 digs against Ole Miss on Nov. 10, 2002.

#### TIGERS TIED FOR EIGHTH MOST SERVICE ACES

Against Ole Miss on Oct. 3, the LSU volleyball team recorded 16 service aces, tying them for the eighth most team service aces in a five-game match in school history. The school record for service aces in a five-game match is 20 recorded against Kentucky in 1987. The 16 aces by the 2004 Tiger team marks the eighth time LSU has posted 16 service aces in a five-game match in the program's history.

#### MIJATOVIC TIED FOR THIRD MOST SERVICE ACES

Against Ole Miss on Oct. 3, Jelena Mijatovic recorded seven service aces, tying her for the third most service aces in a five-game match in LSU history. The mark is only two behind the school record of 10 aces by Wendy Stammer against Texas Tech on Sept. 14, 1986 and one behind Monica Freitas against Texas-Arlington on Nov. 27, 1987. It was the second time this season that Mijatovic recorded seven aces in a match. Against UCF on Sept. 5, she recorded seven aces in the three-game match, which tied for the ninth most in school history.

#### **KUZMIC POSTS SEVENTH MOST BLOCK ASSISTS**

Against Ole Miss on Oct. 3, Ivana Kuzmic recorded 11 block assists, tying her for the seventh most block assists in a five-game match in school history. It marked the third of four double-figure blocking performances on the season for Kuzmic and the second in a row. Her mark was five behind the school record of 16 recorded by Lisa Smith against Wyoming on Sept. 11, 1987. It also marked the most block assists in a five-game match since Meagan Davis recorded 11 against San Jose State in 1999.



Rachel Pittman led the Tigers in digs and digs per game in 2004 and became just the 23rd player to record 700 career digs in LSU history.

#### **KUZMIC RECORDS 500 CAREER BLOCKS**



Against Arkansas on Nov. 12, transfer Ivana Kuzmic recorded the 500th block of her career and finished the season with 534 career blocks. If she had competed at LSU her entire career, she would rank fourth in career blocks in school history. In 2004, she led the Tigers with 1.59 blocks per game, a mark which ranked third in LSU history. As a freshman at Arkansas-Little Rock, she led the NCAA with 2.16 blocks per game while setting the UALR single-season record for block assists with 180. In 2004, she ranked 38th in the nation with 1.33 blocks per game. For her career, she is averaging 1.68 blocks per game, a mark that would break the current LSU record.

#### PITTMAN DIGS THE RECORDS

Against Wisconsin-Milwaukee on Sept. 17, Rachel Pittman recorded 19 digs in a match, tying her for the 10th most digs in a three-game match in school history. It marked the second-straight match that Pittman posted top 10 marks in school history in digs after she recorded the fourth most digs in school history in a five-game match against Miami earlier in the day.

The 19 digs is tied with five other players for 10th place in school history and is 11 behind the school record of 30 by Luciana Reis against Arkansas State in 1993. The last time a player recorded 19 digs in a three-game match was setter Daniela Romero against Nebraska in 2003.

Against Miami, Pittman recorded 26 digs in the five-game match. With her career best, the senior became the first player since Jennifer Hampton on No. 7, 2001, to record over 25 digs in a match. Pittman's performance ranked second in a five-game match behind the school record of 28 digs recorded on by Wendy Stammer, Monica Freitas, Daniela Reis and Meg Norwood. It was also tied for the 10th best dig performance overall in school history.

#### PAIR NAMED TO TEXAS INVITATIONAL ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

Ivana Kuzmic and Regan Hood were named to the Time-Warner Cable Texas Invitational All-Tournament team. Kuzmic led the team in kills in all three matches and led the team in blocks against Texas and Liberty. She also led the team in hitting percentage in the tournament. Hood ranked second on the team in kills against Texas and Liberty and was third against La. Tech.

#### HOOD NAMED MVP; THREE ON ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

Regan Hood was named the Hurricane France Invitational Most Valuable Player after leading the Tigers to a 3-0 record and the tournament title. Hood led LSU with a 3.25 kills per game average a .310 hitting percentage. In addition, she recorded 13 blocks and 28 digs. Against Rice, she recorded her first double-double of the season with 17 kills and 14 digs. She also led the match in kills in the first match against Central Florida and tied for the team lead in blocks.

Junior Ivana Kuzmic, sophomore Melody Clark and sophomore Daniela Romero were also named to the All-Tournament team. Kuzmic led the team in blocking in all three matches and led the team in kills in the second match against Central Florida. Clark recorded the third most kills and the third-most blocks on the team, while hitting at a .250 clip. Romero recorded 122 assists, while picking up a career-high 22 digs against Rice along with a career-best 54 assists.


