



It was a basketball season all about coming together.

It took going on the road and experiencing a bit of hurt to get the Tigers to understand that they had to battle together as a group to have success.

It took a double overtime battle with Ohio State at the Maravich Center to show the Tigers that they could play with anyone in the country.

It took a rallying loss to Arkansas in Fayetteville to make the Tigers understand that playing on the road wasn't such a bad thing.

Put them all together and LSU ran off seven straight wins following the Arkansas game, including three important road wins to give LSU its second Western Division crown with a 12-4 record, 20 wins for the season and a spot in the NCAA Tournament.

In the process, LSU would equal one of the best seasons ever in the history of the Maravich Center and advance to within seconds in overtime of playing for the SEC Tournament championship.

It was a season with great individual and team highlights that LSU fans were excited to be a part of.

#### BRANDON BASS

Coming on the heels of earning SEC Freshman of the Year honors in 2004, Bass came back with an even better sophomore season and earned SEC Player of the Year honors in 2005.

Bass averaged 17.3 points per game, 9.1 rebounds a game while making 56.7 percent of his field goals, including 12-of-26 treys and 77.7 percent of free throws (146-of-188). Bass failed to score in double figures in just three games and had 12 double-doubles. Bass scored 30 points in earning LSU Louisiana Classic MVP honors against Louisiana-Lafayette (11-21), 29 in the double-overtime win over Ohio State (1-15) and 27 in the win over Florida (2-19). In a big road win at Mississippi State (2-16), Bass had 21 points and 17 rebounds.

Bass was third in the league in scoring average, second in rebounds and first in field goal percentage.

Bass elected to throw his name in the NBA draft following the 2005 season and was chosen early in the second round by the New Orleans Hornets.

#### GLEN DAVIS

For the second straight year and for the third time in the John Brady era, the Tigers had the SEC Freshman of the Year in Glen Davis. The 6-9 forward showed he could be a force in the league with his strong rebounding ability and his soft shooting touch.

He was not only the Freshman of the Year, but Dick Vitale chose him as his SEC Diaper Dandy of the Year. Davis started 29 games a season ago, averaging 13.5 points per game, 8.8

rebounds a game with 1.0 assists and 1.4 blocks. The big man averaged over 29 minutes a game in his inaugural college campaign.

Davis scored in double figures in 22 games with highs of 28 versus South Carolina (1-12), 27 points versus Southern Miss (12-18), 26 versus Arkansas (1-19) and 24 versus Auburn (3-11). Against Arkansas, Davis also had 18 rebounds.

Davis made 51.3 percent of his field goal attempts and 69.8 percent of his free throws.

The Baton Rouge product finished 13th in the league in scoring and fourth in rebounding.

#### DARREL MITCHELL

Mitchell continued his three-point shooting prowess, making 67 three-pointers last season, averaging 13.1 points per game with 2.6 rebounds and 2.9 assists. The junior started all 30 games with 21 contests in double figures, including 32 points in the double-overtime win against Ohio State (1-15) and 20 point games against UNO (11-24), Northwestern State (12-11) and Mississippi State (1-29).

Mitchell's 67 treys marked the second straight year Mitchell has made 67 three-pointers, tied for eighth best in a single season at LSU. In his first three years, Mitchell has made 176 treys, third best all time and he enters his senior season needing just 35 points to join the 1,000 point club and another 60-trey season to pass Torris Bright as the school's top three-point field goal maker.

**TACK MINOR, ANTONIO HUDSON**

The pair completed LSU's guard trio and Minor played LSU's point guard for 30 games, averaging 10.8 points and 4.6 assists per game, fourth best in the league. Minor had 23 points in the Sugar Bowl Classic win over Florida State (12-30).

Hudson finished his LSU career, joining the prestigious LSU 1,000-point club, while scoring in double figures in 21 games. He scored 21 points in both SEC Tournament games, earning SEC All-Tournament honors for the second time in his career. Hudson finished with 174 three-pointers, fifth all-time at LSU.

**STREAKS**

While LSU lost in regular season non-conference play at home for the first time in 56 games, the Tigers did continue an impressive streak of victories at home over Louisiana schools that dates back close to 16 years, Dec. 8, 1988.

In 2004-05, LSU won games against Tulane, Louisiana-Lafayette, UNO, Northwestern State and McNeese State to run the win streak to 52 home games.

**HOME WINNING HABITS**

LSU won all eight of its Southeastern Conference contests at the Pete Maravich Assembly Center, the first time an LSU team has won all its home SEC games since the 1981 NCAA Final Four team won nine conference games in the 18-game schedule. Along the way, LSU also defeated Ohio State in double overtime and was 14-1 for the year at home. LSU enters the 2005-06 season with an 11-game home winning streak.

**PAID ATTENDANCE**

The Tigers paid attendance last season was 9,409, giving LSU its fourth consecutive year with an increase in paid attendance at the Maravich Center. The Tigers drew a paid average of 8,106 in 2001, 8,534 in 2002, 8,687 in 2003, 9,355 in 2004 and 9,409 in 2005.

**GRADUATION**

Tiger players continue to make strong progress off the floor as student-athletes as former Tiger Paul Wolfert received his diploma to make 12 players who played for coach Brady to receive their diploma from LSU. Also since, 1997 the Tigers have had 27 members on the Southeastern Conference Academic Honor Roll.

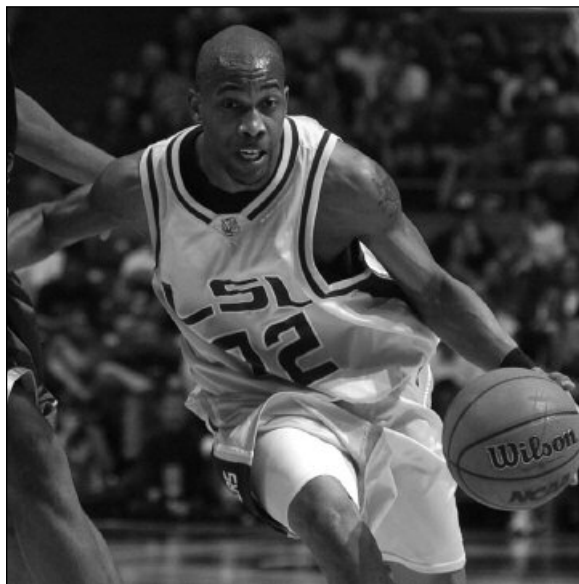

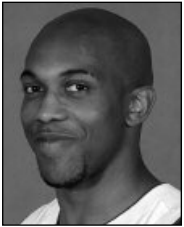
