## LSU FOOTBALL POSTGAME NOTES #5 LSU vs. #7 Florida October 12, 2019 – Tiger Stadium

- 1. The LSU Captains were Joe Burrow, Thaddeus Moss, Patrick Queen and Blake Ferguson.
- 2. Florida won the coin toss and deferred. LSU received the opening kickoff and defended the South end zone to start the game.
- 3. LSU is 65-25-3 in its Homecoming games
  - a. Homecoming queen and king presented at halftime were Sarah LaBorde and Hayden Guidry.
- 4. The Tigers improved to 6-0 on the season and 2-0 in SEC play.
  - a. The last time LSU started 6-0 was 2015 when the Tigers defeated Florida 35-28 in Tiger Stadium.
  - b. LSU has won 11 of its last 13 games against SEC Eastern Division foes.
- 5. The win marked LSU's 30<sup>th</sup> victory against Florida.
  - a. Florida leads the overall series 33-30-3.
  - b. The LSU win evens the series in games played in Baton Rouge, 17-17.
- 6. Coach Orgeron notched his second win over Florida in his time at LSU. He is now 2-2 against the Gators.
  - a. His first win came in 2017 when LSU defeated Florida, 17-16 in Gainsville.
- 7. LSU has won six of its last seven games against Top 10 opponents.
  - a. The 42-28 win over No. 7 Florida is the second Top 10 win of the season for the Tigers after they defeated No. 9 Texas, 45-38 in September.
  - b. LSU is 12-6 in top-10 games since 1958.
- 8. Orgeron's record at LSU improves to 31-9.
  - a. Six of those 31 victories have come against Top 10 opponents.
  - b. Six Top 10 wins ties Paul Dietzel for the third most in LSU history. Les Miles leads with 16 and Charles McClendon has 10.
  - c. LSU is 11-1 in October under Orgeron.
  - d. The Tigers are 29-2 under Orgeron when reaching the 20-point mark.
  - e. LSU is 18-1 under Orgeron when having a 100-yard rusher.
  - f. LSU is now 9-4 in conference games under Orgeron.
  - g. The Tigers are 6-4 under Orgeron in games where LSU allows 25 points or more.
  - h. 24 of Orgeron's 31 wins at LSU have come by double-figures.
- 9. LSU improves to 17-12 in games in which ESPN College GameDay is on hand.
  - a. The Tigers are 14-6 overall when picked by Lee Corso to win the game.
    - i. Corso also picked the Tigers in Austin earlier this season vs. Texas.
  - b. LSU has made an appearance on the show in 16 of the last 17 seasons.
- 10. The Tigers are 259-64-2 in night games at Tiger Stadium.
  - a. Overall, LSU is 299-90-5 in Tiger Stadium.

## Offense

1. 31 touchdown drives this season that have taken under three minutes. LSU had only 23 touchdown drives of under three minutes for the entire 2018 season.

- 2. The Tigers have scored in 36 consecutive quarters dating back to the Rice game last year. It is the longest streak in school history, surpassing the previous mark of 24 in 2011.
- 3. **QB Joe Burrow's** streak of 20+ completions increases to a school record nine games.
  - a. Burrow had a streak of 12 consecutive completed passes. That ties a career high and is 4th on LSU's all-time list of most consecutive passes completed.
  - b. Joe Burrows school record of four straight games with 300+ passing yards is over after throwing for 293 tonight.
- 4. **RB Clyde Edwards-Helaire's** 57-yard run in the first quarter was a career long.
  - a. His previous record was a 47-yard run against Georgia last season.
    - b. Two rushing touchdowns ties his career high.
      - i. He's had two rushing touchdowns in two other games, with the most recent coming this season against Northwestern State.
    - c. Edwards-Helaire finished the game with 134 rushing yards on 13 attempts with two touchdowns.
- 5. **RB Tyrion Davis-Price** recorded a career high 33-yard touchdown run in the third quarter.
  - a. His previous high was an 11-yard rush against Utah State this season.
  - b. Davis-Price finished the game with 40 rushing yards and one touchdown.
- 6. WR Justin Jefferson finished with 123 receiving yards and a touchdown.
- 7. WR Ja'marr Chase led the Tigers in receiving with 127 yards and two touchdowns.
- 8. LSU has scored 30 or more points in a record nine straight games. The streak dates back to the Rice game last season when LSU scored 42.
- 9. LSU's 42 points is the second most ever scored in a game against Florida.
  - a. LSU scored 48 in 1971.
  - b. 42 surpasses 41 points in 2011.
- 10. LSU finished with an average of 10.6 yards per play against Florida.
  - a. It is the most ever in a game against a ranked opponent.
  - b. It is the most ever in a game against an SEC opponent.
  - c. It is the third most ever in a game overall.

## Defense

- 1. S Marcel Brooks recorded his first career sack in the third quarter.
  - a. The sack came on third down and resulted in an eight yard loss for Florida.
- 2. **CB Derek Stingley** intercepted a pass in the fourth quarter to mark his third interception of the season.
  - a. He also had interceptions against Vanderbilt and Utah State this season.
  - b. Stingley finished with six total tackles to go along with the interception.
- 3. S Grant Delpit, OLB Patrick Queen and OLB K'Lavon Chaisson led the defense with eight tackles each.
  - a. Chaisson recorded a sack and three tackles for loss.

## Special Teams

- 1. Placekicker Cade York is 7-for-9 on field goals and 40-for-41 on PATs through six games in 2019.
  - a. York was 0-for-1 on field goals in the game and 6-for-6 on PATs.
