A young but talented LSU men's team is poised to qualify several individuals for the NCAA Championships in head coach Adam Schmitt's second season. Schmitt established his philosophy of achieving success in his first season and now looks to build results with eight returning letter-winners and his first recruiting class. When the Tigers enter the championship season, a good majority of those who will earn postseason berths will be freshmen. Though the team may be small in numbers, it's the quality of the individuals that give LSU a tremendous shot at a top-20 finish at NCAAs. Furthermore, the nine freshmen who earn experience this season will be back for three more successful campaigns.

"We realize we have a small squad but quality is what we have stressed here," said Schmitt. "It doesn't matter how many individuals are on your team. What counts is the number who qualify for NCAAs. We feel we have a solid group to do that now and in the future."

To be ready for the championship season, Schmitt compiled one of the most challenging schedules in school history. Defending national champion Auburn visits the LSU Natatorium to start the season. Home meets with Florida and Texas A&M highlight the January slate. The Tigers also make trips to Florida State, Alabama and Kentucky, which leads up to the SEC Championships in Knoxville. Those individuals who do qualify for NCAAs close the season March 23-25 in Atlanta.

"In order to be the type of program will are striving for, we have to face quality opponents," said Schmitt. "That is what I have had in mind since we first got here, and that is the only way to get where we need to be."

Rekindling Success

Malberg, Braud, Dalman form talented Tiger Team

If there was one freshman in the SEC who stood out in sprint freestyle events last season, Miko Malberg was the one who delivered. Malberg was one of three Tigers who qualified for the NCAA Championships. As a freshman, he left his mark on LSU's all-time top 10 board and became the first Tiger swimmer in eight years to post a swim in the 19-second range of the 50 free. The time of 19.95, the fifth-best mark in school history, gave the Estonian native a berth in the NCAA Championships at the Last Chance Meet. At NCAAs, Malberg took 32nd out of 50 swimmers and gathered experience for the upcoming season.

"Miko has really developed a leadership role since his first meet here at LSU," said Schmitt. "He is really competitive when he races and his teammates feed off of his intensity."

Malberg's competitive drive also fueled the Tigers in the 100 free and all relay events. He looks to continue his climb toward school-record clockings in the 50 and 100 free.

Also returning in sprint freestyle events will be senior co-captain Ryan Ashby. Ashby owned the third-best time in the 100 free last season and proved to be valuable in relays with his leadership abilities. Joining the mix will be three talented freshmen Justin Corvin, Connor Farber and Julius Gloeckner. Corvin was the 50 free state champion in Kentucky as a senior in high school, while Farber was a standout in the Houston-metro area.

Gloeckner enters his first season at LSU with tremendous expectations.

"Julius is a very versatile swimmer," said Schmitt. "He will swim in several events."

Backstroke

While Malberg made an immediate impact in freestyle, his teammate Kevin Braud equaled the task in the backstroke. Braud was flawless as a freshman, posting the third-fastest times in school history in the 100 and 200 back. He added to his resume by qualifying for finals of both backstroke events at the SEC Championships and the U.S. World Championship Trials last April.

"We feel good about our backstroke group, especially knowing that Kevin will be around for a few more seasons," said Schmitt.

Braud took last year's SEC Championship experience in stride, winning the consolation final of the 200 back in 1:45.76.

Braud can be expected to be challenged by Gloeckner, Malberg and Will Bengé during the season.

Butterfly

Numerous Tigers will take part in the butterfly this season, including Malberg, Ashby, Gloeckner and Corvin. Malberg owned the fastest mark of the season in the 100 fly, swimming a time of 49.17 to finish 18th at the SEC Championships. Entering this season, Malberg looks to enter LSU's top 10 record books with an even better clocking.

Schmitt's recruiting class has shown it can deliver quality swims in this event despite its youthfulness. Gloeckner's early season meets indicate the freshman has already gone under the 1:50 range in the 200 fly.

Breaststroke

There will be no harder task on the men's team this season than replacing the breaststroke dominance of Christian Clausen. Clausen, who graduated last spring, earned All-America honors at the NCAA Championships in 2005 and left with all-time top five breaststroke times.

Help could come from seniors Ryan Ashby, Matt Coenen and freshman Chris White. Coenen performed well at the 2005 SEC Championships and entered the all-time top 10 with a 2:02.86 clocking in the prelims of the 200 breaststroke. The time gave him a berth in the finals in which he placed 15th. On the season, he owned the second-fastest times in the 100 and 200 breaststroke, right behind Clausen. White was the South Carolina high school state champion in the 100 breaststroke as a senior. The freshman was also a three-time All-American in the event.

Individual Medley

Gloeckner's most dominating event comes in the individual medley. Senior Joe Veron posted the second-best times of the season in 2005 and returns. Ashby and Braud will also see time in individual medley.

Diving

Doug Shaffer continues to prove that the LSU diving team is one of the premiere programs in the SEC and the nation. Shaffer signed Niko Dalman for last year's team and what transcended was one of the best freshman campaigns in school history. Not only did Dalman receive the SEC's Freshman Diver of the Year award, the Washington native captured his first All-America honor in his first NCAA Championships.

In the 1-meter at NCAAs, Dalman placed 12th at 301.50 to become the highest LSU scorer in the event since 2001. It was also only the fourth All-American performance by a freshman in school history. Dalman certainly proved that his work ethic and ability to perform under pressure situations make him one of the top young and talented divers in the nation. After earning valuable experience in one year, Shaffer has stressed the importance of building on last year's results.

"It was certainly fabulous for the program to do what he did," said Shaffer. "Now he has the chance to move on to bigger and better things as his sophomore season approaches."

Expect a great season from Andrew Keane, who looks to provide a leadership role in 2005-06 as a team co-captain. Keane has quietly built an impressive resume in his two previous seasons, culminating with the U.S. Zone C Midwest Championships last summer. An appearance at NCAAs could be waiting in the balance. Shaffer added another top recruit from the state of Texas when he signed Nathan Schreiber. A native of San Antonio, Schreiber was a six-time Junior Olympic qualifier and the Texas state runner up in 2004.

"Nathan is a strong, powerful diver capable of performing many difficult dives," added Shaffer.

With the return of Dalman, the leadership of Keane and the young talents of Schreiber, LSU is poised for a promising championship diving season in the spring. Training in dual meets and competitive invitationals at Texas A&M and Georgia will provide experience for the Tigers as Shaffer continues the program's recent excellence.

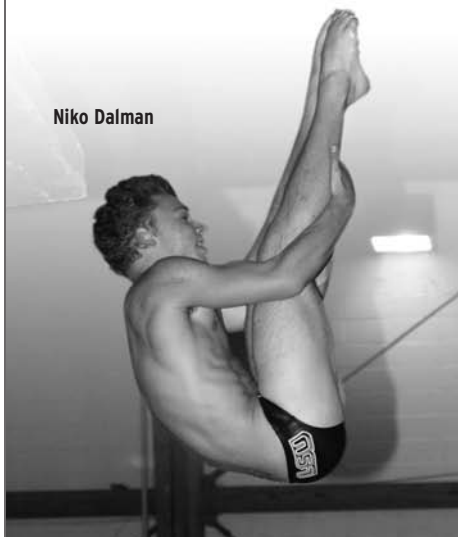
